


























































































## THEY HAD THE LAST WORD

#### LEGACY FOR THE LUCKY

Servants in the little English village of Guildford have been tossing dice for 291 years, with the winner receiving one year's income from a trust fund left by a resident, John How, in the year 1664. His will provided that two poor servants be chosen each year to throw the dice for the income from the fund. Since the beginning of the strange custom, everyone from butlers and footmen to pantrymen and scullery girls have partici-



pated. All told, the servants of Guildford have pocketed about \$15,000 in winnings.

A man in Birmingham, England, bequeathed \$450 to his brother-in-law on condition that he have his nose straightened. The curve-beaked legatee for-feited the money left him by refusing to meet the provisions of the will (February, 1943).

#### HOME SWEET HOME




#### HIS LAST HOLE
