"Well, I have more work to do," said Captain Fearless, climbing into the cockpit, "so I will let you boys get some sleep."


"Roger," said McClure, "I was getting tired of being awakened right in the middle of the night by those screaming monkeys. Morpheus, here I come."



"I guess I could use a little sleep myself," said Wilson, yawning.


