Dear Senator Feinstein:

With our ongoing development of Trump Ocean Resort Baja Mexico, a seventeen acre resort in North Baja, we have quickly become part of the community of Southern California, San Diego County and North Baja. As we have settled in, we have become aware of the polluted water issues that plague the coastline.

Through our research and need to completely understand the issues on both sides of the border, it became clear that this issue is something that must be dealt with swiftly, and more importantly, the only way to permanently solve it is with your assistance.

The South Bay International Wastewater Treatment Plant ("SBIWTP") dumps millions of gallons of incompletely treated wastewater off of the US coastline that affect the beaches of San Diego and, subsequently, the corresponding health of the citizens of San Diego County. If the SBIWTP were to treat the incoming sewage to a secondary level, the resultant treated water that would subsequently be pumped into the ocean would no longer pose an environmental threat to the surrounding areas.

We are aware that the Bajagua project does not have the level of support necessary and, moreover, many of the experts feel that it is not the correct solution for the region. We strongly support upgrading the SWIWTP to a point where it can treat all incoming sewage to a secondary level.

We are supportive of you and the efforts of your office to advance the most effective and comprehensive solutions available and look forward to participating with you however possible to achieve our common goals.
