Interview of William SPECTOR

SYNOPSIS:

Information was received from BND Headquarters that Congressman Manely wished assistance be given to a constituent who had knowledge of the narcotic traffic in upper New York. On December 7, 1971, the Regional Intelligence Unit communicated with Mr. William Spector, (315-393-9826) at which time an appointment for an interview was made for December 8, 1971.

DETAILS:

1. On December 8, 1971, Mr. William Spector, was interviewed over a period of seven (7) hours by Special Agents Victor G. Maria (G/S), Robert Clark, and Anthony Mangiaracina. This interview was, on Mr. Spector's insistence, taped. IBM dictation tapes - 15 tapes, each of 20 minutes duration.
2. During this interview Spector consistently discussed his marital troubles and his wife's promiscuous activities. His troubles with his neighbors and former close friends the LANGFORDS who have befriended his wife.
3. The only narcotic traffic known to SPECTOR, is that, which he believes his wife and the LANGFORDS to be conducting together with Maynard LANGFORD, a "hippy". SPECTOR has no specific information relative to the narcotic traffic, but because of his wife's form of living since she left him, feels that she is now under the control of the LANGFORDS who have introduced her to the use of drugs.
4. It should be noted that Larry MANOR, Investigator, New York State Police, Canton, New York, has also been contacted by SPECTOR and is conducting an investigation regarding the allegations made by SPECTOR. Further, SPECTOR has also been in contact with the United States Customs Agency and I&NS regarding this alleged narcotic traffic.
