Good Morning All...

John and I meet on-site and staked out (we had help) the areas where we think slough curb is required. The total is right at 500'. You are correct, our previous guess was 271'. We are having a construction cost estimate prepared based on this new figure.

The stakes are layed out with black paint to the inside, ie where the curbs would extend.

Dennis and I made a site visit today. In the attachments, I took photos of where the first stake starts and the last one ends. I measured the distance between these two areas and came up with 580 LF. During our previous discussion, I recalled that we discussed 170 or 270 lf. So I just want to make sure that this is correct before proceeding with the cost estimate. Also, we will be providing a cost estimate for the construction of the curbs and related irrigation and landscape work.
