Today we received information from LAHSA that the All Saints Episcopal Church in Highland Park was not a suitable site for a Winter Shelter. I wrote a letter to the Executive Director of LAHSA, urging them to reconsider their decision because there is currently no shelter in the Northeast. In addition, I introduced a motion today asking the Department of Recreation and Parks to work with LAHSA to open the Bridewell Armory in Highland Park as a Winter Shelter, to better accommodate our homeless residents.

I will continue to work with LAHSA to approve a Winter Shelter site in Northeast LA.
