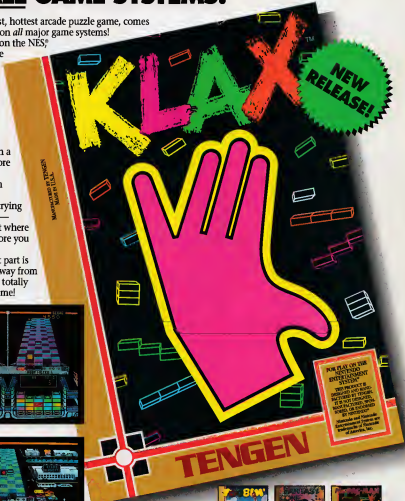

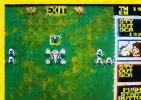

While it's true that Sega has no plans to launch such a product in 1990, the machine is absolutely completed, with nearly 20 games nearing readiness. EGM editor Ed Semrad, along with our foreign correspondent Hideki Shikata, has actually played the unit and observed many of its advanced capabilities firsthand. Stating that it's in a prototype stage is erroneous to say the least (see page 30 for the complete story).

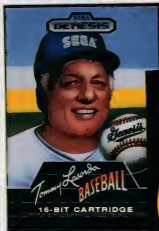

I've heard that they are complex arcade-type movements, but I still can't imagine what they could be. Can you please elaborate?

(ed. Scaling and rotational effects are indeed big-time arcade effects that will have a big impact when they arrive in home systems, such as the Nintendo 16-Bit. Rotation allows the computer to move either part or all of the screen image as if it were a plate spinning. Scaling, which is used on the Atari Lynx, simply lets the system move objects from a far-away background into the foreground smoothly. While some machines can accomplish similar techniques with programming, no system that is out now can do it in hardware. If you want a good example of both of these functions in use, visit your arcade and play Assault.)

Use your special ability of defying gravity, able to jump almost 2 screens up, along with your awesome firepower to rid the planet of some of the most ultimate super-Bosses ever to appear in a video game.

Low G Man is a game that has all the ingredients of a great Mega Man style fighting game. The graphics are good, the sound definition well done and the play mechanic original. Animation, however, is choppy and detracts greatly from overall enjoyment. Not bad, but not outstanding.

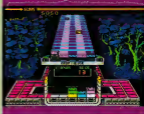
A very unusual yet challenging game. The 'super jumps' are wild but nothing when compared to the end of round bosses which are so huge they extend up to 4 screens high. Very good graphics, multidirectional scrolling, and a wide assortment of different scenarios to add variety.

Slightly above-average action game that could have been a ripper' cart if it wasn't plagued by choppy animation and tiny characters. The main Bosses are big but seem like nothing more than backgrounds with weapons and weakpoints.

This "LOW" gravity man fails to keep his legs on the ground! Smaller than normal while facing GIANT and enemies, this hero also steals their vehicles. Strange color choices and less than smooth animation are distracting, but Low-G-Man's soul was left back in the can, man!

Nintendo - Tengen Klax

Type: Puzzle Release: July
Levels: 50 Difficulty: Avg.



Klax, adapted from the recent Atari Games coin-op hit, is a puzzle game somewhat resembling a cross between Tetris and Columns. Employing a conveyor belt which slowly moves tiles of different colors towards you where they fall off the belt onto a tray. Move the tiles around to get the colors to match up in horizontal, vertical or diagonal lines.

This is Tengen's revenge against Nintendo. Better than Tetris in many ways, Klax introduces more options and strategy into play to produce a game that is just as addictive as Tetris. The graphics and sound are remarkably close to the arcade, but more diversity in play would be nice.

I like puzzle games and Klax is one which is just different enough from Tetris to give it its own identity. Easy enough to learn but difficult to master. It forces you to think in two dimensions which is not the easiest thing to do all the time. The difficulty curve could have been steeper.

A good arcade translation of Klax for NES. Klax has Tetris style action and some addictive quality in its game play, but after 20 rounds it seems all the same and loses its appeal. Cool opening music and sound effects throughout spruce it up. A good game!

This is one great game idea which has gone astray! It starts off with a bang and in later levels it just loses its appeal. Soon you are left waiting and waiting for the tiles to come. Cute at first but it gets old quickly. It just doesn't have the 'progressive' appeal that you get with Tetris.

When the Great War brought our modern civilization as we know it to an end a new era of sorcery and magic began. It was peaceful until one day when an evil wizard started using his powers for conquest. A special weapon to defeat him was constructed but he discovered it, separated it into four parts and hid them. You must make your way through his land, reassemble the weapon and use it to defeat him.

Crystalis, while coming up short in terms of action and intensity, makes up for these ~~down~~ points by wrapping a great quest together with super graphics, terrific execution and enough challenge for most. Not my cup of tea, but pretty good anyway!

A very well constructed adventure game with lots of different shops to buy stronger weapons, armor etc. The quest is long and challenging with the strength of the enemy rising at about the same rate as you. Does not get frustrating or boring this way.

Another Zelda-type game, but this one has promise. Crystalis adds a little more to ~~the~~ non ~~copy~~ theme. A post-apocalyptic storyline with cinema displays mixes with one of the best search, solve and save the world games in recent memory.

Nothing new here. But it's a solid adventure with intensive dialogue which we've seen before. Good control, fast movement and fast game play. It has a conventional theme but it is unique enough to still be worth the trip.

Mechanized Attack lost the look and feel that made it happen in the arcades. I found ~~me to be~~ an Operation Wolf clone that didn't really do anything new. The gun makes the screen flash way too much, and gunners weren't meant to on pads!

One of the cult RPG classics over in Japan and also one of their best selling titles.

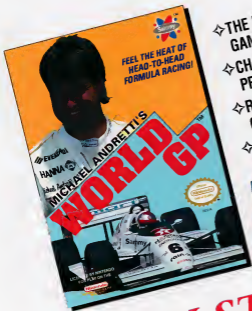

Wizardry is not a game for those with a shoot-em-up mentality. Instead, it is for those who wish to exercise their mind. It raves above any NES cart RPG and is a fabulous game but it's just too hard for the average player's level of patience.

Boring!! While the computer version might have been a hit and spawned five sequels, the NES version is a repetitive session of mazes and monsters. Try the dungeon scenes in Ultima or Phantasy Star and you'll find anything more enjoyable.

I am no Wizard! This game is for members only and no one sent me a key. I just couldn't get it. This game is worse than the Sunset Strip on Saturday night. Banging your head into walls is more fun! It's too hard and too complex.

Involves strategy and planning.

Boulderdash was a great game when it was released for computers many moons ago, but now, in the presence of more sophisticated action puzzlers, it does not wear its age well. A good beginning game for younger gamers, this one left me unmoved.

A decent puzzle game which has you thinking as if you were playing a chess game. You must look at all of the possibilities and guess what will happen when you make each different type of move. Only one path is correct but which one?

A digging game which reminds me of a cross between Dig Dug and Mr. Do! Veteran gamers will know what I'm talking about. Boulderdash has an addictive quality found in games like Solomon's Key. Good game play and cute graphics highlight this cart.

An old computer favorite which now comes to Nintendo. It looks just like the original but it plays much better. The puzzles are challenging and makes you think. For bolder dashers or those who just "dig" games.

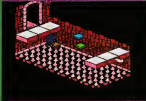

A refreshing change from all of the me-too type puzzle games. Definitely different but hard to control. Great collection, special effects and fantastic music. Has a good difficulty curve which keeps you interested in the game. For all ages!

It's hard to say if Solstice is a puzzler or an adventure game. Whatever the category, Solstice is unique and the perspective and variety of situations will prove most challenging to even the best. The maze is large and the package should prove addictive.

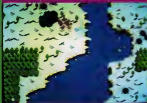

In Dragon Spirit you assume the role of a brave knight who has transformed himself into a giant dragon to combat a ruthless enemy who has stolen your princess. As you fight to reclaim her, you'll come up against monstrous dangers and huge Bosses determined to fight you to the death!

While many will argue that the graphics in the version aren't as good as others, the real joy of Dragon Spirit is the solid shooting action and the new enhancements to uncover in the NES copy. Better than the arcade in many play moves!

The TurboGrafx version was only a bit better than average and the NES copy comes off even worse. Nothing spectacular about the shooter as the graphics are only average at best. Controls OK, but just doesn't capture the excitement of the arcade original.

After playing the Turbo version, this one seems washed out and is not very crisp. The game play stays intact and the controls are there. Dragon Spirit is a good blaster, even if it is less than the advanced versions with better graphics.

About a warrior who transforms into a dragon with a mouth of fire. This version offers more than the TurboGrafx 16 and does nothing graphically as well. Storyline is nicely executed. Dragon spits fire at the flying enemies and bombs below.

Nintendo - Arcadia Spot

The stars of the popular 7-Up TV commercials now have their own video game. Resembling a cross between checkers and Othello Spot's cute character dances and does cartwheels as it makes your move and changes the color of your opponent's captured pieces to yours. Spot is another one of those games that doesn't boast mega-ton cannon fire and ugly aliens, but still comes off as one of the better NES games. Spot is essentially a board game starring the 7-Up stars. Learning the game is easy, mastering it is hard.

Othello is not a terribly exciting game. Who would ever think that by just adding a cute and popular character you would change the way people will look at the game. In the 4 player mode it's a fantastic party game! Multiple skill levels are a plus.

Spot looks like Othello at first, but plays a game all its own. Original methods of changing your opponents chips to your color are what really makes this game shine, along with the dozen-plus animations of the comical spots moving on the board.

A hit effort at recreating Othello now with an animated player piece. Spot is a cool and hip character who moves around the screen with great animated moves. Michael Jackson should move this well. Who says only colas are cool!

Thunderbirds is an unusual shooter that has no score, but rather a quest to beat. I hate the lack of points, but the graphics are well done. The action, while being sparse in some areas, is adequate to move the game along and keep it slightly above-avg. I

Activision has taken a tried-and-true method of designing Thunderbirds. While this conservative method will not make a hog of a game it seldom will make a megahit. As such, this time it came out average. Needs more imagination and creativity.

An unimpressive shooter that has very little new or original. The action is standard blast 'em up fare, with only a few graphic screens in between. Thunderbirds is slow-paced and nothing to get excited about.

The licensed puppet adventure TV show storyline is the best part of this game. Not a very good or challenging shooter, Thunderbirds comes off as only being average at best.

I didn't find E-Swat exciting at all. The colors are bland and washed out, the action is slow and repetitive, and the game itself bears no resemblance to the arcade original in any way at all. Standard side-scrolling action fare with a coin-op name.

A good example of the new generation of Master System 2 games. The spark has gone out of the carts and Sega seems content in bringing out bland generic versions of great arcade games. Could have been much better. Only average.

E-Swat, although it's not too much like the arcade, is a decent Master System shooter, with adequate graphics and challenging game play. Not outstanding, but a nice walk through a terrible neighborhood.

E-SPLAT should have been the real name of the Master System version of this great coin-op. Why do so many games disguise themselves as arcade games when...someone should check in at the door for their proper I.D.!

Genesis - Sega Afterburner 2

Afterburner 2 for the Genesis takes you up into the skies as no other aerial shooter has ever done before. Virtually identical as the arcade version you must take on hundreds of enemy helicopters, jets and aircraft in 23 explosive levels of realistic dogfights. All of the moves including the complex barrel roll are faithfully duplicated and even the scaling of the ground terrain is smooth and realistic.

After Burner 2 is as close as you can get to the real arcade! While the backgrounds are not as detailed, they do animate and scroll very smoothly. The action is chaotic and non-stop, with a stream of planes attacking at all times! Superb!

Spectacular, phenomenal, awesome! Need I say any more? This is the arcade game. Great scaling, the barrel roll is well executed and all of the details are in the home version of the game. The only thing missing is the special XE-TAP controller.

After Burner 2 copies the intense action of the arcade nearly pixel for pixel. Barrel rolls, launching missiles and even firing your after burners are all a part of the action. Plenty of enemy planes in the skies and large cargo planes refuel in mid-air!

A very, very intense, wipe the sweat of your brow type of game! Incredibly addictive gameplay with true 'scaling'. Offers a 3-D type perspective in this flight simulator. Better than the coin-op and certainly MORE fun!

TurboGrafx - NEC Splatterhouse

It's hard to picture a person who wears a leather mask and carries a club as a hero but then Splatterhouse is not your typical side-scrolling shooter either. The enemy you're up against come straight out of the latest horror flick - leeches which come out of corpses, monsters coming out of other monsters you've already killed to double chain saw wielding bosses. It's all there to scare you to death!

Splatterhouse, while tamed down from the little-seen arcade, is another fantastic example of how good Turbo games can be. The game, albeit short, is challenging and graphically outstanding, with vivid blood-reds and puke-green! I love it!!

NEC has another hit on their hands. The special effects and animation of the bosses is excellent and the gameplay increases in intensity right up to the end. The ghouls are so revolting that they deserve to be destroyed so give it your best shot!

From start to finish, Splatterhouse is a visually stunning game. Your hero wields big sticks and butcher knives and finally dunks it out with special Boss characters and rooms. Action games have been around before, but never like this!

Missing are those superb sound effects made when you "splat one" into a wall as in the coin-op. But, that's all that's missing! Looks, plays, and feels like the unreal thing! It's gore-y but good!

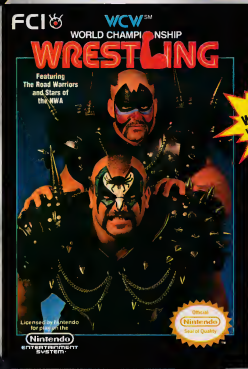

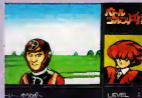
At Last, A Date...

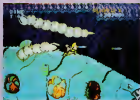

The Game Gear - Sega's version of a color handheld game system!

Sega formally introduced their long awaited color handheld portable game system, called the Game Gear, at Toy Fair in Japan last month and EGM was there for the first U.S. hands-on review!

The GG, essentially the same as we talked about in previous issues, is going to be a little larger than the Game Boy and have a screen which measures 3.2 inches and a resolution

a bit better than the Lynx. Games look very good on the GG partially because it can display 32 on screen colors out of a palette of 4096. The sound will be stereo and like all the other color portables, the 6 "AA" batteries will last about 3-5 hours.

Specs are one thing but the proof is in the gameplay. The built in control pad is precise and very responsive. The backlighting of the screen is

even from corner to corner and produces a bright sharp image. Considerably better than the Lynx but not as good as the Turbo Express. The sound is in stereo and very good. The carts are equal in quality to those out for the SMS but 3 aren't enough to keep players happy for too long. But it's the price which will sell the system. It's low enough to give the Game Boy competition.

Also available for the Game Gear will be a series of options which will greatly expand the versatility of the unit.

A television tuner, which plugs into the cartridge slot, will be available for about \$85. Besides converting the unit into a mini color TV the tuner has a video input terminal which allows it to function as a remote monitor for camcorders or other audio / video equipment.

An optional video link cable, which will sell for about \$5, allows up to 8 players to connect units and play together.

Besides taking 6 "AA" batteries, other optional power sources include a rechargeable battery pack for \$25; an auto cigarette lighter adapter for \$20; and an AC adapter, the same one as used on the Master System, for \$7.

The game cartridges, while designed to run on an 8 bit, Z-80, 3.58 MHz system (the same specs as the SMS), have been completely redesigned and shrunk down in size (and price-\$20) to about the size of a Game Boy cart. This means though, that with very little effort Sega could convert all of their new SMS 2 carts to the Game Gear format!

When the Game Gear comes out in September three carts will be immediately available. After that Sega plans to release about two games per month. Five more titles are finished and scheduled to be issued by third party companies and a total of 20 companies have agreed to produce Game Gear carts!

While no release date has been officially announced for the GG in

Called the "Laser Scope", this NES add on peripheral allows the game player, for the first time, to play the zapper light gun cartridges without the gun. Not only that but it is voice activated.

This sleek, plastic stereo headset utilizes an "eyesight" target locator and voice activated firing sequence allowing players to more easily manipulate the control pad, allowing for greater interaction between the game and the player.

The multi-use headset also offers other features. Remove the "eyesight" option and the headset becomes a stereo headset. This option then allows for silent gameplay. If you select this 'quiet' feature you gain an additional benefit. Built into the unit is a sound enhancer which improves the audio which you normally hear from the

NES. Connect the headset to your Game Boy, Walkman or home stereo system and listen to the sounds in true stereo.

The lightweight Laser Scope works as good as it sounds. With it connected the player can set aside the Zapper and control the firing with his voice. Connect the eyepiece and look through it. Move your head and line up the target through the eyepiece. The firing sequence is then activated by voice commands. Konami compares this technology with that found in today's most sophisticated jet fighters.

Konami also believes that by giving players this type of superior control that the Laser Scope will replace all other forms of out-dated methods of attack.

Konami also plans to support this unique peripheral with a series of new games which will take advantage of the fact that players can now double their fire power by shooting with the controller and helmet simultaneously!

The Laser Scope connects to the Nintendo Entertainment System with just one standard NES cord plug. This cord is 15 feet long and this allows the player more freedom to stand back from the TV.

The Laser Scope is expected to sell for less than \$40 and could be in the stores as early as this Fall.

Nintendo again as in the past had the largest booth in the games section at the Summer Consumer Electronics Show. There were a couple of new games shown - Vermillion, a hot new 6 meg RPG is coming this fall as is a fantastic 6 meg conversion of the arcade game Strider. Other scheduled games like Phantasy Star 3, Shadow Dancer and Power Drift were unfortunately nowhere to be seen. Check our International Column elsewhere in this issue for additional top secret photos.

The big news though, came from the third party people. Phenomenal titles like Thunder Force 3, Fire Shark, Aero Blasters, Phelios, Whip Rush, Final Zone, Shadow Blasters, Hell Fire, Hard Drivin, Dando and Lakers vs Celtics are the ones to watch for. Most were nearly complete and should nicely supplement the new Sega games this Christmas.

Another item not shown at CES but very much a reality was Sega's color portable - Game Gear. Check out our EGM Express for a hands-on review of a production model.

One of the biggest surprises at the CES was the appearance of not just a couple but almost 20 new Master System Games. All indications were that the 8 bit system was to die a quiet death and that the Genesis would be THE system of the 90's but Sega has decided to do an Atari-type move and perpetuate their older system. Keeping the system alive with a reasonable amount of new games is good as there are tons of Master Systems still in use but Sega has gone overboard by redesigning the system shell, removing the ancient card port, reducing the price and calling it the Master System 2.

As for new games most of the titles just don't have the spark that ones like R-Type, Out Run, Phantasy Star or Spellcaster had. There are no new RPG's, the sports games aren't significantly better than the existing ones, and the shooters like E-Swat and Aerial Assault are just OK. Moonwalker, Mickey Mouse and Paperboy were the best of the SMS games at the show. The two which have the best potential of being great though, are Gouhls & Ghosts and Strider. Both, unfortunately were so incomplete as that only title screens were all Sega had to show. One would think, with 4 meg of cart memory possible, and great 16 bit translations already done Sega could do wonders with these two games. Also, many other titles like G-Loc and Maze Syndrome could quickly appear as Sega 'Gears' up with new 8 bit carts (different size and pin configuration) for the Game Gear.

CASTLE OF ILLUSION

Sega

The fabulous Genesis title will be converted to the Master System with surprisingly little loss of detail. In this game, Minnie has been kidnapped and Mickey must save her. Promises to be a great game for the kids.



JOE MONTANA FOOTBALL

Sega

Another big name Sega wants to get a lot of mileage out of is Joe Montana. This new Master System football game adds a couple of new options over the Walter Payton version but don't expect to see all of the great special effects as in the Genesis game.



PAT RILEY BASKETBALL

Sega

Another Master System updated sports game offers closeup views of some of the spectacular slam dunk shots from its 16 bit cousin. Decent graphics for the 8 bit and faster action than its predecessor.



PAPERBOY

Sega

The highly successful arcade and Nintendo game is coming to the Master System this fall. You as a newspaper delivery boy have a job which sounds rather simple - make sure that everybody on your route gets a paper once a day. But it's not that easy as the sidewalks and streets are filled with mad dogs, road obstacles, kids on big wheels and cars who just don't watch where they are going. Three different routes to choose from and lots of challenging action and fun.
