On July 9, 1964, NO T-1, a confidential source abroad, revealed that subject resided at the Grand Hotel, 2 rue Scribe, Paris 9, from May 6-12, 1964. Source advised that since that date he has no longer been present in the Paris, France area. Source added that subject is unknown to the records of the various services of the Prefecture of Police in Paris. During his brief stay in Paris he did not come to the attention of the French authorities. (S)

On July 20, 1964, NO T-2, a confidential source abroad, revealed that subject arrived in Madrid, Spain, on May 12, 1964 at Barajas Airport (Madrid). He took up residence at the Hotel Plaza, Madrid, where he remained until May 22, at which time he departed from the hotel. His destination was unknown but it was believed that he had left Spain at that time. Source advised that subject did not come to security notice during his stay in Spain. Spanish records reflected that he was the bearer of U. S. passport #92577 issued to him in Washington, D. C. on June 25, 1963. He arrived in Spain under the auspices of the American Express Company Travel Agency. (S)

Also on July 20, 1964, NO T-3, a confidential source abroad, revealed substantially the same information supplied by confidential source NO T-2. Instant source added, however, that Spanish records reflected that subject was born August 15, 1923 in the United States and that his permanent place of residence was listed by him as New Orleans, Louisiana. (S)

Confidential informant NO T-4, a confidential source abroad, advised as follows on August 7, 1964:

ORESTES PENA, born August 15, 1923, in Cuba, a United States citizen, arrived at Fiumicino Airport, Rome, Italy, on Trans World Airlines flight number 900 on May 22, 1964, coming from Madrid, Spain. PENA bore passport number D-092577, issued at Washington, D. C., on June 25, 1963. While in Rome, PENA lodged at the Hotel Commodoro.

**RE: REQUEST PERTAINING TO AUTHORIZATION
AND PURPOSE OF ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCES
CONDUCTED BY THE FBI**

Reference is made to the SSC letter of November 21, 1975, requesting delivery of materials pertaining to the authorization and purpose of certain electronic surveillances conducted by the FBI.

The SSC letter of November 21 referenced a summary chart prepared by the FBI showing electronic surveillances conducted by the FBI since 1960. This chart was furnished to the SSC by memorandum of October 23, 1975.

This memorandum effects delivery of documents responsive to Items 5 and 6 of the November 21 SSC letter dealing with microphone surveillances. Those items are as follows:

This memorandum briefly reviews the speech made on the floor of the Senate by Senator Frank Church entitled "Government Adherence to the Law: A Call for a Temporary Special Prosecutor on Intelligence Abuses." The speech (attached) received some press coverage, most of which dealt with Senator Church's proposal that a special prosecutor be designated to look into the so-called intelligence abuses.

In brief, the statement by Senator Church reviews that information which was the subject of testimony by the majority and minority counsels of the Senate Select Committee (SSC) before the full Committee on 11/18/75. No new so-called abuses were identified by Senator Church and the speech was merely a rehash of those activities conducted by the intelligence community over the years which the SSC now describes as abuses. 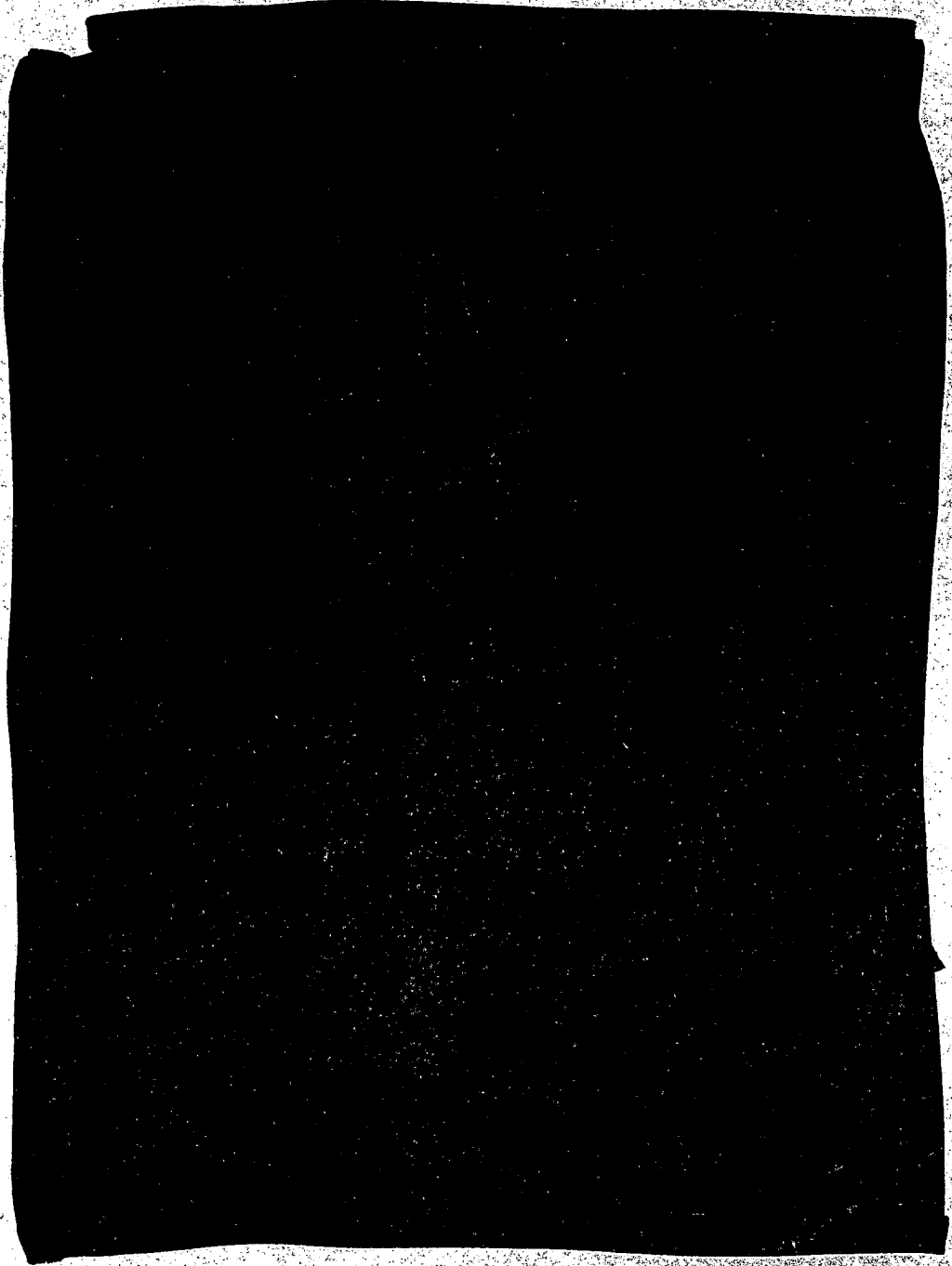
