**U. S. SENATE SELECT COMMITTEE TO
STUDY GOVERNMENTAL OPERATIONS WITH
RESPECT TO INTELLIGENCE ACTIVITIES (SSC)**

Reference is made to the SSC letter dated April 15, 1976, requesting delivery of certain FBI materials.

Because of the large volume of material compiled in response to the referenced SSC letter, SSC Staff Members were given access to the material and made a subsequent request on April 29, 1976, for delivery of certain documents therefrom. Delivery of these documents was effected by memoranda dated May 6 and May 17, 1976.

On May 13, 1976, SSC Staff Member James Johnston orally requested of an FBI representative delivery of the remainder of the material originally compiled in response to Item 1 of referenced letter. This memorandum effects delivery of a portion of the additional documents. The remainder will be delivered upon receipt of third agency clearance.

On June 4, 1962 (MM 761-S) ^{Sovna} advised that infor-
mation concerning CUBELA was received by him from
(LUCY ECHEVARRIA DE ROGER) who resides in the vicinity
of 60th Court and N.W. First Street. The information
is received by her from members of the ECHEVARRIA
family (LUCY's parents) in Cuba, who are in contact
with CUBELA there. CUBELA was a very close friend of
JOSE ANTONIO ECHEVARRIA, one time head of the Directorio
Revolucionario, the original anti-BATISTA organization.

According to information received through
the above sources, CUBELA has not changed his mind
concerning his desire to leave Cuba, and to be done
with all phases of the current Cuban government.

Informant said further that according to the
above sources, CUBELA went to Mexico prior to the time
that Russian official MIKOYAN arrived in Cuba. While
in Mexico, CUBELA contacted one (JACK STEWART) and an
unknown Cuban, and furnished them information concern-
ing the proposed arrival of MIKOYAN in Cuba. Informant
stated that (JACK STEWART) reportedly worked for (the U.S.
Embassy in Havana) and was subsequently transferred to
(the U.S. Embassy in Mexico City)

MM 776-S (Source) advised SA EDWIN L. SWIRET that he was one of the police officers at Humboldt #7 at the time the attempt was made to arrest the young revolutionaries, and that all of them were armed and were firing on the police when they were killed.

This information and memo are submitted to the Bureau at this time because in addition to constant broadcasts from Cuba and news reports appearing in the Cuban newspapers coming out of Cuba, the local Miami papers are offering numerous possible objectives of the trial and the matter of the trial is a main diet of conversation in the Cuban exile colony in Miami. It is felt that an analysis at this time of the possible outcome of the trial, as viewed by three Cuban experts on the matter, may be of interest to the Bureau and to other branches of the United States government.

ReNytel 9/27/65, captioned "Cuban Mission to the UN IS - CUBA." (S)(U)

MM761-S advised on 9/27/65, that on instant date he attempted to see a friend, CARLOS TEPEDINO, a jeweler, 31 West 47th Street, NYC, who, according to the source, is in contact with CIA, but learned that TEPEDINO had departed for Italy on Sunday evening, 9/26/65. TEPEDINO's father told source that MARTA JIMENEZ (a member of the ROA Delegation to the UN) had called and said she had a letter and some cigars for CARLOS from ROLANDO (CUBELA). Source explained that CUBELA was a former "commandante" and a former student leader at the University of Havana who in the past while in Europe had been in contact with CIA. (S)(U)

On 9/28/65, MM 761-S advised that OSCAR GUTIERREZ (U) (3rd Secretary) from the Cuban Mission to the UN and another unidentified male delivered the aforementioned cigars and letter to TEPEDINO, SR on the afternoon of 9/27/65, at which time source was present. He met GUTIERREZ and in casual conversation he "learned" that the Foreign Minister (ROA) was in New York and would address the UN General Assembly. (S)(U)
