Dear Ms. Davis:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 25, 1976, captioned as above.

This is to confirm the conversation on May 26, 1976, between my liaison representative Robert L. Moore and Mr. Steven L. Shancke of the National Security Council (NSC) Staff. Your letter requested the views of the FBI as to whether documents enclosed with your letter, which were classified by or concerned the FBI, could be made available to the Senate Select Committee (SSC) Staff on a classified basis or made available for access on NSC procedures. Mr. Moore advised Mr. Shancke that the following documents could be made available for delivery to the SSC Staff:

1. FBI Current Intelligence Analysis dated November 27, 1963, classified "Secret," (3 pages).
2. John Edgar Hoover letter to Honorable Marvin Watson dated December 2, 1966, classified "Top Secret," (1 page).

2. White House memorandum addressed to "Mr. President" signed "Marvin" dated November 6, 1967, unclassified (1 page). The words "18 Cuban-trained double agents against the Cubans" appearing in the second sentence of the last paragraph to be deleted. (S)
3. FBI LHM captioned "Training of Negroes in Cuba" dated November 3, 1967, classified "Secret," (2 pages). The words "18 Cuban-trained intelligence agents as double agents or potential double agents against the Cubans" appearing in the third sentence of the last paragraph, page 2, to be deleted. (S)
4. FBI LHM captioned "Plans to Assassinate Cuban Leaders," classified "Secret," (2 pages), dated June 4, 1965, with the word "Williamson" appearing on lines 3, 6 and 9 in the first full paragraph on page 2 to be deleted.

Mr. Skancke was also advised that the FBI LHM captioned "Reaction of Soviet and Communist Party Officials to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy" dated December 1, 1966, classified "Top Secret," (6 pages), should not be delivered but could be made available to the SSC Staff for review on NSC premises. The White House memorandum prepared by "WJ:yb" dated November 24, 1963, was classified "Secret" on May 25, 1976,

PURPOSE:

To advise the National Security Council (NSC) of FBI views relating to SSC request for FBI related documents in the Lyndon Baines Johnson (LBJ) Library.

SYNOPSIS:

On 5/25/76, the NSC advised that the SSC Staff had been allowed to review documents in the LBJ Library relating to the Kennedy assassination and alleged assassination attempts against Fidel Castro. The SSC Staff has now requested copies of these documents and the NSC requested the views of the FBI by close of business 5/26/76 as to whether the enclosed documents, which were classified by or concerned the FBI may be made available for delivery to or access by the SSC. The documents were reviewed by Intelligence Division and were approved with some deletions for delivery to SSC. One documents relating to extremely sensitive live informants (SOLO and FEDORA) will be approved for access only. Also approved for access only is a document reporting information furnished by J. Edgar Hoover on 11/24/63 to the White House with reference to Oswald. This document reports that Mr. Hoover advised that Oswald wrote a letter to the Soviet Embassy, Washington, D. C. which ~~was~~ intercepted, read and resealed.

Memorandum Kolombatovic to Leavitt  
 Re: Senate Select Committee (SSC)  
 Request for Lyndon Baines  
 Johnson Library Documents

DETAILS CONTINUED:

A document captioned "Reaction of Soviet and Communist Party Officials to the Assassination of President John F. Kennedy," dated 1/1/66 contains information from highly sensitive live sources [SOLO] (S)(u) and [FEDORA] and it was decided that the "Top Secret" classification should continue and this document not be released for delivery to SSC; however, SSC Staff could be allowed to review the document at the NSC. Another document dated 11/24/63, dictated by "WJ" reports information furnished by Mr. J. Edgar Hoover. Mr. Hoover furnished information with reference to the Oswald murder and, among other things, advised that Oswald had made a telephone call to the Cuban Embassy in Mexico City which [we] "FBI intercepted and that Oswald also wrote a letter to the Soviet Embassy, Washington, D. C. [which] [we] "FBI (S) intercepted, read and resealed. [ ] This document at the present time is not classified and it was the conclusion of the Intelligence Division that the document should be classified "Secret" and should not be made available for delivery to the SSC. However, it could be made available for review by the SSC at the NSC. The document was prepared at the White House and "WJ" is believed to be Walter Jenkins.
