 left to consummate this training period."

2. One "Battle Plan," or schedule, hand written, which source described as a schedule for a night military drill.

3. One memorandum, dated 10/6/83, from "New Brunswick National Cadre Cowhey," to "MF ADC" (Military Fraction Aide de Camp). This document states an objective, to "elevate military role, responsibility in Bolshevizing the Party." It refers to weekly "MF session tactic."

For information of New York, [redacted] had previously stated that the Military Fraction (MF) members in New Brunswick, hold regular weekly drills in the vicinity of Princeton, New Jersey. These drills were reportedly held frequently on Wednesday or Thursday. To date, surveillances have failed to locate these drills. Source advised that on one of these drills, [redacted]

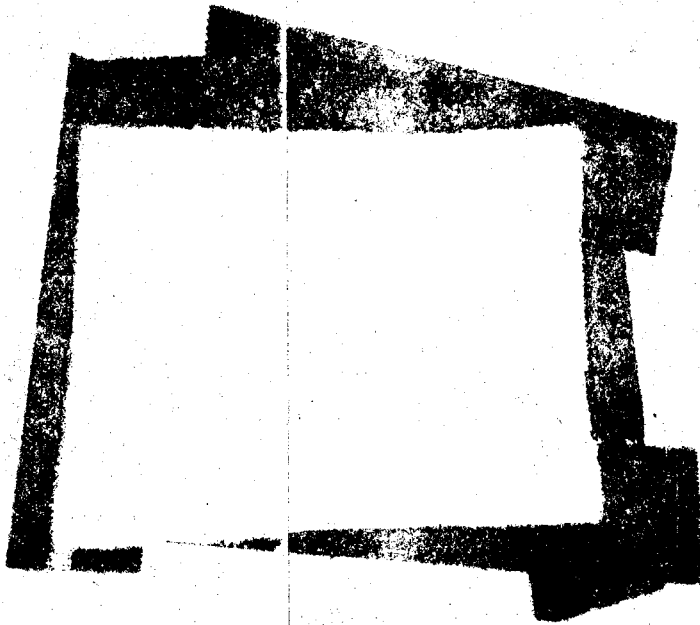

On 1/8/84, above asset contacted SA [redacted] and advised that the National Office Center (NOC) has instructed the three locations in New Jersey, to conduct a fund drive. The purpose of this fund drive is to raise \$300,000 (\$100,000 per location) for the Proscenium tactic. Source is not aware of the purpose of this need, other than above.

On January 5, 1984, [redacted] provided the following information:

Source stated that during source's last visit to the National Office Center (NOC), of the Provisional Party of Communists (PPC), [redacted] was present for the entire duration of source's visit.

Source knows that [redacted] normally occupies one room of the law firm located at NOC as his usual business office. His office is the room in the law office, facing the street. This is referred to as the Field Command (FC) Office. [redacted]

[redacted] A citizens band radio base station is maintained in the FC Office.

Source stated that [redacted] has no established pattern of travel to and from NOC, but usually is present, to the best of source's knowledge, when away from NOC. [redacted] will probably be at a horse farm, operated by Foxfire Realty at a location on Long Island, which is not known to source, or at an apartment operated by Additional-Arenas (AD-AR), or one of the other known metropolitan arena locations.

Source advised that a "make-up" call is usually made at NOC between 9:15 a.m. and 10:00 a.m. This is followed by late morning arrivals by interior cadre members who sleep in remote locations. Between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m., most members coming to NOC have arrived. On source's last visit to NOC, approximately fifty members slept at that location, the law office and the doctor's office. Approximately 85 attended a staff meeting, with some people present from the West Coast Regional Headquarters. Approximately 70 members were present during working hours. One

cadre member is usually present in the third floor, right side apartment. This apartment is rented to

[redacted] Source is not aware of PPC associates, but believes this apartment may be used in some way, by cadre, as someone from NOC is always present to care for the tenants.

In source's estimation, the above numbers of members are typical of those usually present.

Source learned that Foxfire Realty has recently occupied office space at 120 Wall Street, New York City. This office is apparently so new that telephone service is not yet present. No additional details are known to source.

Source stated further that a list of almost all coin operated telephones in the vicinity of New Brunswick, New Jersey, has been compiled by that entity. This list shows telephone numbers, locations and walking time to those locations from the New Brunswick Office. Individual code names have been assigned to the telephones.

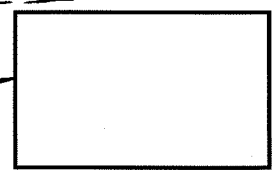

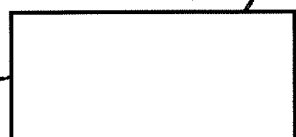

JANUARY 12, 1984, AT APPROXIMATELY 3:00 P.M., HE HAD OVERHEARD TWO TRUCKERS ON THE C.B., EAST BOUND ON INTERSTATE-43, AT SANTA ROSA, NEW MEXICO, (TRUCKERS UNIDENTIFIED); AND THAT TRUCKER NO. 1 WAS INQUIRING WHAT TRUCKER NO. 2 THOUGHT OF THE UNITED STATES POLITICAL RELATIONS WITH THE VATICAN WAS AND THAT TRUCKER NO. 2 HAD ADVISED THAT THERE WAS MUCH CONTROVERSY, AT WHICH TIME NO. 1 TOLD NO. 2 TO GO TO CHANNEL 17, AND AFTER DOING SO, TRUCKER NO. 1 ADVISED NO. 2 AS FOLLOWS:

NO. 1 TOLD NO. 2 THAT THIS GROUP (NO NAME) EITHER WAS IN POSSESSION OF, OR HAD CONTACT WITH ANOTHER GROUP THAT HAD A NUCLEAR DEVICE AND THAT THIS DEVICE WOULD BE SET OFF IN NEW YORK CITY ON EITHER THE 16TH OR 18TH OF JANUARY, 1984.

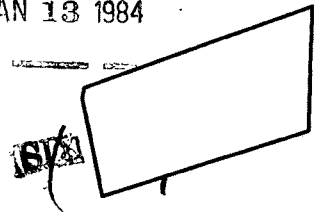

During a general discussion of CWP target and tactics, the following points were brought forth by this source:

Members are encouraged to seek employment as blue collar skilled employees of large plants. They are usually academically over qualified for the positions sought and/or held. They attempt to become active in union affairs virtually immediately upon obtaining employment.

Prior employment references are arranged through listing a firm out of state. The address provided by the CWP member will actually be that of a CWP associate. For example, [redacted]

[redacted] is a CWP member. [redacted] also of CWP, applies for a position with Confidential Industries in SF as a machinist. He lists Smith Associates, Inc., of 146 Main St., Hartford, Conn., as his prior employment as a machinist. Confidential Industries forwards their standard background and qualifications questionnaire to the Hartford address. [redacted] then provides a glowing report for his CWP buddy, [redacted]. It would be unusual for Confidential Industries to explore this alleged employment in further depth without some indication that such an extended investigation would prove useful. Most CWP members seeking employment in this manner are young, in their 20's, single and as mentioned above, may likely be college graduates but seeking employment in a blue collar area.

A second standard procedure of the CWP is to identify existing points of frustration and/or friction within the inner city or minority groups in the area in which the CWP is attempting to make inroads or establish a new base of operations. Support for minority group leaders will then be provided and sympathy

shown for their problems. When this relationship is firmly established, recruitment can then begin by the CWP.

The following is a potential technique to identify CWP members who may have successfully infiltrated sensitive or cleared facilities:

Identify young aggressive (usually single and academically over qualified) union leaders or shop stewards who are advocating political positions which are beyond usual union concerns. (Examples would be advocating restriction of trade with South Africa or the usual anti-defense establishment themes.)

This "profile" might be discussed with security officers with whom a relationship has been established under the DECA program.

A correlation of any individuals who appear to fit the "profile" and their vacation or off-duty time with the scheduled national conventions or other annual gatherings of the CWP would be an indicator of affiliation in the event that these times coincide.

In the event a suspected CWP member is identified, then a reexamination of the employment background and history provided by that individual through [redacted] the Better Business Bureau might prove interesting.

Source stated that in a meeting on approximately December 7, 1983, he heard members of the Provisional Party of Communists (PPC), discussing a letter which reportedly warns of Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) intention to "raid" the National Office Central (NOC). Source was told that the letter was sent from [redacted] [redacted] New Brunswick, New Jersey. Source did not observe the letter at that time, but heard the conversation. Source noted no one seemed alarmed by this information.

On December 27, 1983, source advised that he had seen the letter in the New Brunswick Office and saw no reference to an FBI "raid." Only one reference stated that "the opposition is always aware of our activities."

Source stated further that NOC, at 1115 Carroll Street, has three or four citizens band (CB) radio base stations and hand held units, which operate on CB channel seven. In radio communications, individual members, other than [redacted] are referred by a code name, i.e. "C-2, C-3, etcetera." [redacted] however, he is referred to by name.
