



The NH Division has no background material concerning this particular investigation and is forwarding this info merely to mention the connection between and the CWP and the CWP and the CWP and the SD Division has questions that this asset might be able to answer, then that Division is requested to so advise NH. (NH notes that it has been over 2 years since this source was involved in CWP activity on the west coast.)

With regard to the request set forth in referenced SFairtel re the identities of any individuals in the SF area who might be willing to discuss CWP activities with Special Agents of the FBI, this source could provide the identities of no potential assets. She was unaware of any connection between

with the Democratic Peoples Republic of Korea (DPRK) or any location in North Africa.

During a general discussion of CWP target and tactics, the following points were brought forth by this source:

Members are encouraged to seek employment as blue collar skilled employees of large plants. They are usually academically over qualified for the positions sought and/or held. They attempt to become active in union affairs virtually immediately upon obtaining employment.

Prior employment references are arranged through listing a firm out of state. The address provided by the CWP member will actually be that of a CWP associate. For example, also of CWP, applies for a position with Confidential Industries in SF as a machinist. He lists Smith Associates, Inc., of 146 Main St., Hartford, Conn., as his prior employment as a machinist. Confidential Industries forwards their standard background and qualifica-_then pro- b7C tions questionnaire to the Hartford address. vides a glowing report for his CWP buddy, It would be unusual for Confidential Industries to explore this alleged em-It would ployment in further depth without some indication that such an extended investigation would prove useful. Most CWP members seeking employment in this manner are young, in their 20's, single and as mentioned above, may likely be college graduates but seeking employment in a blue collar area.

A second standard procedure of the CWP is to identify existing points of frustration and/or friction within the inner city or minority groups in the area in which the CWP is attempting to make inroads or establish a new base of operations. Support for minority group leaders will then be provided and sympathy

shown for their problems. When this relationship is firmly established, recruitment can then begin by the CWP.

The following is a potential technique to identify CWP members who may have successfully infiltrated sensitive or cleared facilities:

Identify young aggressive (usually single and academically over qualified) union leaders or shop stewards who are advocating political positions which are beyond usual union concerns. (Examples would be advocating restriction of trade with South Africa or the usual anti-defense establishment themes.)

This "profile" might be discussed with security officers with whom a relationship has been established under the DECA program.

A correlation of any individuals who appear to fit the "profile" and their vacation or off-duty time with the scheduled national conventions or other annual gatherings of the CWP would be an indicator of affiliation in the event that these times coincide.

In the event a suspected CWP member is identified, then a reexamination of the employment background and history provided by that individual through the Better Business Bureau might prove interesting.

The NH Division is unaware of the extent of the full field investigation of the CWP currently being directed by the Bureau and coordinated by the NY Division as 00. The points set forth above which were raised during the conversation with this source are being set out for whatever action is deemed necessary and/or appropriate by the Bureau and the 00.

THE PROVISIONAL PARTY OF COMMUNISTS, USA IS REFERRED TO BY MEMBERS AS THE PROVISIONAL PARTY AND THE CPUSA PROVISIONAL; IT HAS NO CONNECTION WITH THE COMMUNIST PARTY, USA {CPUSA}.

THE PARTY IS DIVIDED INTO SEVERAL "FRACTIONS" WHICH ARE OPENED TO ALL PARTY MEMBERS {CADRES}, AND ONE CLOSED FRACTION WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE MILITARY FRACTION.

THE MILITARY FRACTION REQUIRES A MINIMUM OF ONE-YEAR, FULL-TIME PARTY MEMBERSHIP COMPLETE WITH "POLITICAL EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EVALUATION." THIS MILITARY FRACTION IS ARMED AND PARTICIPATES IN REGULAR MILITARY DRILLS. ALTHOUGH THE SOURCE WAS NOT A MEMBER OF THE MILITARY FRACTION, THE SOURCE GAINED KNOWLEDGE REGARDING THE MILITARY FRACTION WHILE WORKING AT THE NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS OF THE CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION LOCATED IN NY CITY, NY.

WHILE WORKING IN THE NATIONAL OFFICE, THE SOURCE OBSERVED FIREARMS ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS. THE SOURCE LEARNED THAT ONE ROOM IN THE HEADQUARTERS IS REFERRED TO AS "THE CAVE" AND IS KEPT GUARDED ON A 24-HOUR BASIS. ON ONE OCCASION, THE SOURCE OBSERVED THE DOOR OPENED AND BRIEFLY SAW A LARGE SUPPLY OF FIREARMS. THE ROOM CONTAINED THREE RACKS OF SHOULDER WEAPONS AND A NUMBER OF OLIVE DRAB DUFFLE BAGS WHICH APPEARED TO BE FILLED WITH FIREARMS. ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS, THE SOURCE OBSERVED FIREARMS BEING CARRIED INTO THE BUILDING, AND HAS IDENTIFIED THESE FIREARMS AS APPEARING TO BE .30 CALIBER CARBINES, AK 47'S, AND VARIOUS WEAPONS WITH SCOPES.

DURING THE SOURCE'S TENURE WITH THE CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION,
THE SOURCE LEARNED THAT THE PROVISIONAL PARTY OF COMMUNISTS, USA IS
A REVOLUTIONARY COMMUNIST PARTY, TOTALLY DEDICATED TO REVOLUTION
IN THE UNITED STATES. THE U.S. GOVERNMENT AND ALL OF ITS
AGENCIES ARE CONSIDERED MORTAL ENEMIES. PLANS ARE WELL UNDERWAY
FOR AN ARMED "TAKEOVER" OF THE U.S. GOVERNMENT. THE TAKEOVER
IS REPORTEDLY SCHEDULED FOR FEBRUARY 19, 1984. ON THIS DATE,


