SUBJECT: ITR Compliance Review 10J-1026 (Mavis Georgalis)

At your request, we conducted a review of Mavis Georgalis's computer hard-drive and 62 diskettes from her work area. We also conducted an E-mail archive search of the Lotus Notes files for Mavis Georgalis and Clint Curtis. Computer files from December 11, 1998 and E-mails from March 3, 2000 were recovered.

The specific results to your request are as follows:

- The dates on the files recovered appear to indicate that Ms. Georgalis was using the computer we examined since December 11, 1998.
- Spreadsheets and documents relating to purchase orders are provided as Attachment 1.
- E-mails recovered are provided as Attachment 2.
- "HMR, Inc.," is mentioned in an E-mail from Mavis Georgalis to Vicki Bradford on September 18, 2001. (See Attachment 2)
- No specific documents relating to Syll Camateros, Carey Mann or Steve Sims were found.
- No memorandum from Ernestine Briscoe and copied to Ms. Georgalis was found on any of the electronic media recovered.

Other files recovered pertain to planning of the EDMS project and projected (not actual) expenditures of funds were recovered. These additional files are available for your review.

Attachment I

Spreadsheets and Word documents concerning Yang invoices recovered from Mavis Georgalis's computer are provided in this attachment. The Excel spreadsheet filenames are Yang Invoices 00-01, 0001-BalSheet1, and Yang. One document is a letter from Yang Enterprises to Mavis Georgalis concerning purchase orders for software maintenance. The other document is a text fragment, so the complete document with headings, dates, etc., is not available.

I have requested the new license file for District One. The NIC address in the license file is the one we were originally provided last year (when the license files were requested from Germany).

I'm including the developer's license which you can use for District One until the new one arrives (in case it doesn't come back today). I'm also including the license for the test server (TLIMCS4 00a0c9d5b5c7). We never requested a license for 00a0c9d5e00a. I believe that is the server testing Arcis 7.2, which doesn't require the license file.

I understand how you guys are trying to get the clustering to work for you. Unfortunately, Arcis 7.0 was not designed to support it (hence, the license tied to the NIC, much the way a dongle is tied to a machine). If the "second node" is not the right NIC, we need to know ASAP to get the licenses corrected. The information below gives you information on obtaining a

The Modified By and the QC Operator are added after the import through reattribution. That was Bill/Verns end of the migration. They also have to clean up the spec sect number. This field is where we placed our verification numbers so that we can compare our import database to the actual import into Arcis. Those changes are made after the verification process. Otherwise you will not know which records have been checked and which have not. As to the speed it might be due to the fact that you are a zillion miles away. The batch importer verifies each image before transmission to make sure that the image exists. Install the importer in Pompano, send them the import database, copy the files to a directory in Pompano, and have them push the button there. The batch importer hasn't changed other than our LanceBreak that we added in Pompano. Vern should have the batch importer on several machines in Tallahassee. You could grab the exe off one of them and replace yours if you want to test it without the LanceBreak but since we set that to filter at one document per second I seriously doubt that it will improve your time output. You may have to run the import from Pompano.

Here are some things we have learned during our testing of this system.

Pre-attibuting: Our CEI offices have done an excellent job of establishing attribtutes for their files. I have difficulty keeping up with the two of them. I envision a residency with three or more "PROJECTS" sending files to the FTP site having to dedicate an employee to the downloading-uploading task.

An employee should probably be assigned to perform QC on both the imported images and the images that are scanned in from the online CEI's. This person would need attribution rights but since they would only be verifying image content and orientation. All attribtutes would already have been assigned by the CEI either in the CEI import package or in the Scanner Client.

FTP site: The seven day rule almost caught me. Files were saved to the FTP site while I was off from work for a long weekend. Each residency will have to establish a fail safe method of file retrieval from the FTP site to ensure no file is removed due to the 7 day rule.

This problem will be overcome once the secure FTP site is in place.

Are my files actually going to CDMS? We had a scare last Wednesday, The EDMS servers had been or were being worked on. I sent six files up early that morning. When I checked behind myself an hour later the files were NOT in CDMS. I had erased the files from the FPT site and the exporter erased them from my PC. I am 99% certain today those files made it into CDMS. I had 54 packets of files downloaded at that time and I wasn't completely certain which ones I had sent up to the server. When you are doing this volume of file transfer you need some kind of verification that your files are actually going to the server.

Verification of transfer can only be accomplished by opening the Arcis retrieval client and doing a search for that days import. This is fairly easy since we have now changed the store date to be the FDOT date rather than the CEI date.

Connectivity: Your ability to plan your day now depends on the file transfer rate you get from your system. Mine has run from 5K to 1050K. We've had a T1 line all along and learned all about routers, ICI, and BellSouth's poor wiring grids. My D-5 Data center folks keep telling me to transfer during off-peak hours. I still haven't seen a difference related to time of day. I just checked and I am running 914K @ 9:00 am. Maybe it will be an issue once the bandwidth is saturated.

If connectivity does become a problem and they go to a verification system where a single employee verifies the import. That employee could be scheduled so that imports were done after regular FDOT hours.

The viewer provided by Yang could be made more user friendly. It has no multi-page viewing capability and seems to be a lower resolution than the pixel viewer.

The viewer does have a lower resolution but it is the best that we can find at this time. It does have multi-page functionality. They just need to right click on the image and select next page, etc.

Double clicking on the image to make it full size will also tell the user how many pages exist within that document.

Watch for old copies of Yang software. One consultant was given old software generated prior to our latest revision of the doc types and groups.

The Yang software is still out of date. Our newest version of Batch importer, alerts the user if they are importing an old version.

Our consultant has chosen to use 'Vortex v1.1' software to move their files to the FTP site. All concerned there say it is a superior product to the Yang software.

Vortex is Yang's software. They might be saying that they prefer yang's software (which forms an actual archive) is preferred over the FDOT Batch Exporter (which does not), but I'm not sure. We can build this type of functionality but is fraught with a multitude of possible problems.

Lance,

I will be receiving a written confirmation letter that will state the following: ARCIS-web 2.1A10 is tested and released with ARCIS (NT) V7.2. The official release have been available since 10/2000. I will mail this confirmation letter to you as soon as I receive it.

I have several responses to your questions concerning ARCIS Web Server:

1. Retrieving a hitlist of 290 records takes about 9 seconds using the fat client and about 12 seconds using the Java Applet through the web server. However, it takes the web server 82 seconds to retrieve the same list using the Javascript client and results in 100% CPU utilization on the web server during the retrieve. Why is there such a performance difference?

Answer #1

ARCIS technical support has not found such discrepancies. One possible issue is the lookup of the annotations. Even if there are no annotations per document, the Javascript client will look for one. On Javascript, this could be slower. Make the same query using the HTML client and compare. Please let me know the result. I've found that the HTML client seems to be the most responsive.

2. Are there going to be performance issues related to complicated select statements from a web browser. In other words, what performance differences should we expect to see in a query on a single attribute compared to a query on many attributes?

Answer #2

Arcis does no optimization in querying data from the database. A complex query issued through the web client will be as fast as the fat client. But, the refresh on the web client will always be slower than the fat client.

3. Are there performance benchmarks available for the Arcis Web Server? FDOT is interested in comparisons among archive sizes, number of users, and complexity of queries.

Answer #3

No performance benchmarks are available. Performance will depend on the tuning of the database itself and the type of queries the user performs.

4. FDOT's testing to date seems to indicate that creating a hitlist is more resource intensive than returning images, at least as far as CPU time goes. Is this a safe assumption?

Answer #4

This assumption is correct. Building up a query requires database resources. The database is always the bottleneck in any query. Very little CPU time is required to retrieve a document from the archive.

5. Does Arcis have any suggestions on hardware configurations for the Arcis Web Server and optimizing the Arcis Web Server and Microsoft IIS for performance? Based on the testing mentioned above, FDOT is looking at purchasing servers for maximum CPU performance over other considerations. Should this be what FDOT focuses on in selecting web servers for running the Arcis Web Server?

Answer #5

I've submitted a request to Arcis technical support in Germany for recommended Web Server configurations and optimizations that would be more specific to FDOT's proposed deployment. The Arcis Web Server installation and Administration guide gives information on server and client hardware requirements and performance monitoring. You should have a soft copy of this document on the install CD of Arcis Web Server.

Rather than ask for clarification again and wait on an email response, this note is to document the information you provided me on the phone last week and confirmed again yesterday. I am also restating again several issues that have been discussed in various meetings:

The following is my understanding:

Yang submitted invoices for services to DOT in April (dated April 13) for the months of Sept 2000 through March 2001. Nelson Hill, and perhaps Mavis, discussed with representatives from Yang, DOT's concern about some of the items that were billed, in particular those that appeared to be maintenance work that should have been covered under our maintenance agreement. A list was provided with the line items in question in May 2001, and clarification was requested in email and in the discussion. Nelson Hill pointed out that all billable services must be clearly authorized in writing before beginning work. All parties agreed this would greatly reduce the confusion on the billing for services.

Another meeting was held with the Yangs, Steve Ferst of DOT Legal, myself, and an attorney for Yang in August. Several topics were covered, but Nelson and I reiterated the need for a prompt response to our inquiry on the unpaid invoices so that payment processing could be completed before the December deadline for certifying forward funds for last fiscal year. Nelson again stated that all services work would be specifically authorized in email to avoid potential confusion, and at this meeting named me (Vicki) the point of contact for all communication for the contracts, including the authorization in writing for services work. Mr. Yang mentioned commitments for the following 3 weeks, and said a response would be sent to us shortly after that.

On December 3, I received a copy of the response to our billing inquiries (Sept 2000 only) signed by Mike Cohen (I think, signature is not clear) for Tyn-Lin Yang. Nelson and I both were confused by language used throughout the document pertaining to the maintenance agreement. For example, "FDOT had not paid the maintenance fee; thus, it did not receive the upgrade software, which would have supported the FDOT's scanner...." I spoke with you during the week of Dec 3 to clarify if Yang billed for the work because the maintenance had not been paid, or if the work was not covered by the maintenance agreement. You said that you believed the work was not covered by maintenance regardless of whether the

maintenance agreement had been paid, and you agreed to confirm this with the Yangs and let me know. In addition, you asked if the response for September's invoice was an acceptable approach before continuing with the other invoices. I said that I would confirm that it was satisfactory with Nelson and let you know because additional responses may not be required. I also asked if there were any outstanding charges that had not been submitted to DOT (not the first time this has been asked). You stated that you believed that we had all of the outstanding invoices.

On Dec 11, Nelson and I called you so that Nelson could get clarification on the billing concerns and make a final decision on paying the outstanding invoices. We asked for email confirmation on the earlier discussion pertaining to the maintenance agreement (previous paragraph) and that there are no outstanding invoices. You said you were going to speak to Mrs. Yang and get back to me. About an hour later, you called to say that I needed to send you a request in email asking for clarification about the Sept response in regard to maintenance. You also said there may be additional invoices after all, but seemed unclear.

In case there is any confusion, I am using this note to reiterate the following:

Any communication between DOT and Yang will be done through me (Vicki), except help support for work covered under our maintenance agreement, which will come from Windy, Lance, or Dale.

Any billable services will be authorized in email by me (Vicki) with an agreed upon number of hours.

For authorized services, please send a copy of the email authorization with the invoice. Invoices must be submitted in a timely manner, no more than 30 days after the completion of the work. If there are any invoices still outstanding from last fiscal year (Before July 1), I need to be notified immediately.

Unless I hear back from you on any of this information, I will assume confirmation.

Yes, we have developed an EDMS system, which is designed for small businesses/workgroups. The system uses third party software (not ARCIS) for scanning, indexing and viewing. The most significant points are that YEL's EDMS does not provide a sophisticated storage management like ARCIS does, and it is not designed for enterprise wide implementation due to time constraints for development and testing. This program is available to everyone and is not limited to FDOT CEI consultants. If Mavis has no problem using time on the week of 11/13, we can have Bill demonstrate our EDMS to you.

Lance,

I will be receiving a written confirmation letter that will state the following: Arcis-Web 2.1A10 is tested and released with Arcis (NT) V7.2. The official release have been available since 10/2000. I will mail this confirmation letter to you as soon as I receive it.

I have several responses to your questions concerning Arcis Web Server:

1. Retrieving a hitlist of 290 records takes about 9 seconds using the fat client and about 12 seconds using the Java Applet through the web server. However, it takes the web server 82 seconds to retrieve the same list using the JavaScript client and results in 100% CPU utilization on the web server during the retrieve. Why is there such a performance difference?

Answer #1

Arcis technical support has not found such discrepancies. One possible issue is the lookup of the annotations. Even if there are no annotations per

document, the JavaScript client will look for one. On JavaScript, this could be slower. Make the same query using the HTML client and compare. Please let me know the result. I've found that the HTML client seems to be the most responsive.

2. Are there going to be performance issues related to complicated select statements from a web browser. In other words, what performance differences should we expect to see in a query on a single attribute compared to a query on many attributes?

Answer #2
Arcis does no optimization in querying data from the database. A complex query issued through the web client will be as fast as the fat client. But, the refresh on the web client will always be slower than the fat client.

3. Are there performance benchmarks available for the Arcis Web Server? FDOT is interested in comparisons among archive sizes, number of users, and complexity of queries.

Answer #3
No performance benchmarks are available. Performance will depend on the tuning of the database itself and the type of queries the user performs.

4. FDOT's testing to date seems to indicate that creating a hitlist is more resource intensive than returning images, at least as far as CPU time goes. Is this a safe assumption?

Answer #4
This assumption is correct. Building up a query requires database resources. The database is always the bottleneck in any query. Very little CPU time is required to retrieve a document from the archive.

5. Does Arcis have any suggestions on hardware configurations for the Arcis Web Server and optimizing the Arcis Web Server and Microsoft IIS for performance? Based on the testing mentioned above, FDOT is looking at purchasing servers for maximum CPU performance over other considerations. Should this be what FDOT focuses on in selecting web servers for running the Arcis Web Server?

Answer #5
I've submitted a request to Arcis technical support in Germany for recommended Web Server configurations and optimizations that would be more specific to FDOT's proposed deployment. The Arcis Web Server installation and Administration guide gives information on server and client hardware requirements and performance monitoring. You should have a soft copy of this document on the install CD of Arcis Web Server.

Please let me know how I can help you with any other issue you have concerning your Arcis upgrade plans.

The markups are not showing up when displayed in an external viewer - in my case, the Alternative browser plugin.

For the markups and redactions to show up in an external viewer, a new image would have to be created, either by the Arcis Webserver or the Java Client, with the markups superimposed over the document image. When the external viewer option is selected, the Arcis Web cache does have a duplicate of the document image that should be marked-up, but the two images are the same. When using the Java viewer, there is no duplicate. It looks like a second document is being created but it is not getting the markups super-imposed on it.

We will be using the Java client because it provides most of the functionality of the fat client. In particular, the Java document viewer displays redactions when the user views a document.

The problem I have identified is that the Java hitlist has a checkbox "Show document in external viewer". This option will allow a user to view an redacted NCI document in some other viewer, without the redactions. Since we will be using Arcis Web as the client for Arcis 7.2, we have to be able to insure that redactions are preserved when a document is viewed.

Using the Arcis Web Administration tool you can set this option to be checked or unchecked by default, but I cannot determine any way to disable this option.

The Importer/Exporter is a single component with two working modules. The Exporter Module compacts images that already exist on a user's machine along with a database that contains the FDOT required attribute information. The information is then transferred via FTP to FDOT's FTP site. The transferred file is manually copied from the FTP site to the person's machine doing importation into Arcis users. The Importer Module unzips this package so the images and database are no longer compacted and then sends the images and attribute information into the FDOT archive. BZip is used to compact and uncompact the image/database package. A third executable existed that allowed the users to view images. This executable, YEIViewAll.exe, used LeadTools to do the image manipulation. This Importer/Exporter code (including the executable but not the source code for YEIViewAll) was delivered to FDOT and demonstrated to Jim Johnson, Windy Marshall, and Mavis Georgalis at the very beginning of the EDMS project. The Importer/Exporter code was later altered to provide viewing using a viewer developed by Lance Peterson. This was necessary since Yang failed to provide source code for the YEIViewAll Viewer.

The Importer/Exporter was fully developed within a period of a couple of weeks and has not changed substantially since its initial development. It was always intended as a mechanism that FDOT could provide to their outside consultants free of charge.

Later Yang (I actually did the programming along with assistance from Bill Dean) began work on a fully functional EDMS system that incorporated the compact and send technology built for the Importer/Exporter modules. This program, called Vortex, provided full scanning, indexing, ordering, backup recovery, searching and packaging ability. It allowed the user to not only use the FDOT required indexes but also gave the users the ability to set up their own index values. I have since found out that FDOT was billed for all the hours (and more) for when I was working on the Vortex program even though Yang had full intention of marketing this program for their own gain and had no intention of distributing this product free to the FBI users. It also used the BZip compression utility to compact the collection of documents and databases (it would have to in order to be fully compatible with the importer program) even though Yang had included the unlocked BZip.dll

when they transferred the source code on the Importer/Exporter modules. LeadTools is heavily used in the Vortex program even though Yang had already expended its single license in the original Importer/Exporter viewer product developed for FDOT. A toolkit is required for each product developed. Yang is very bad about proper licensing; at one time they had the entire office (over 20 people were using the same copy of Office 97). They had 15 engineers working on a single copy of Microstation.

Both the Importer/Exporter program and the Vortex program was demonstrated to hundreds of CE's at the FDOT CHI Conference held in Orlando.

There appears to a discrepancy in Line Item 2, which lists a Software Maintenance Fee for a four (4) month period totaling \$15,000.

You will remember that on March 27th, of this year, Mr. Ralph Thompson of Yang Enterprises, Inc. hand delivered to you personally YEI Invoice Number CI-01-03-0010. This invoice listed \$270,000 for the ARCIS Software Maintenance Fees, due for FY 2001.

Mr. Nelson Hill emailed to Yang Enterprises, Inc. on March 30, 2001 (on which you were cc:) and requested the \$270,000, be re-submitted on an invoice for payment after July 1, 2001, to accommodate FDOT Budget constraints for FY2001. Yang Enterprises, Inc. agreed to Mr. Hill's request and Dr. Yang emailed acceptance of this request back to Mr. Hill on April 2, 2001.

Based upon YEI's compliance to Mr. Hill's invoicing instructions, we assume that Line Item 2 of subject Purchase Order is an error and should be corrected to comply with Mr. Hill's instructions.
