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PORTFOLIO OF HOME DESIGNS

The home designs illustrated in this portfolio are approved for use under the Federal Home Building Service Plan. They have been selected by responsible architects cooperating under the Plan as appropriate for small house building in this locality. Complete working drawings and detailed specifications necessary to sound building of any of these homes under the Plan are available.

Plan Approved by the Federal Home Loan Bank Board:-

The Federal Home Building Service Plan is sponsored by the Federal Home Loan Bank Board. Its facilities equip members of the regional Federal Home Loan Banks to offer home builders a complete home building service. Its purpose is to provide better housing at lower cost through technical control of construction and through control of credit. It is for the benefit both of the home owner and the lending institution which holds the mortgage.

The Plan offers the home builder:

- (1) Efficient architectural design and detailed specifications furnished only in conjunction with
 - (2) An architectural advisory and construction supervisory service,
- and as evidence of such protective procedure
 (3) A Certificate of Registration
- also, and very importantly
 - (4) Financial advice and counsel

Pleasing and Economical Design:-


The intention is to provide a suitable variety of designs for various price ranges for houses costing not over \$7500. The prospective home builder should be able ordinarily to fit his requirements into one of these prepared designs. Minor revisions of a prepared plan will be possible in some cases.

Designs other than those illustrated in this portfolio meeting the requirements of the Plan will be approved. One of the objects of the Federal Home Building Service Plan is to encourage and stimulate the preparation and use of small house designs that promote efficient and economical home building.

Arrangements may be made to have original designs prepared for clients to meet individual requirements. Such separate design is necessary when the house will exceed the maximum cost for which prepared designs are provided.

Also working drawings and specifications brought in by prospective home builders may be reviewed for adequacy and suitability by the approved architects or technicians cooperating under the Plan. If approved as meeting the requirements of the Plan, and no arrangements have been made for competent technical supervision, they may be built under the architectural advisory and construction supervisory services of the Plan.

These designs are not sold separately and will be furnished only in conjunction with architectural advisory and construction supervisory services by competent architects and other technicians cooperating under the Service Plan who have been approved by the Federal Home Loan Bank Board. A list of such approved architects and technicians is available; others qualified to perform such services and meeting the eligibility requirements of the Plan will be approved.



The Architectural Advisory and Construction Supervisory Service:-

This service assists the home builder in:

- (1) Securing an efficient architectural plan and lasting value in design.
- (2) Selecting a design suitable to the neighborhood.
- (3) Adapting the design properly to the building site.
- (4) Selecting of qualified contractors (on owner-built projects)
- (5) Taking competitive bids and providing for the customary contract documents (on owner-built projects)
- (6) Providing for sound construction through inspection of materials and periodic supervision of workmanship.

Certificate of Registration:-

Evidence that the home has been built under the Plan will be furnished the home builder on satisfactory completion of construction, in the form of a Certificate of Registration signed by the technical supervisor of construction, issued by the lending institution and registered on the records of the Federal Home Loan Bank at Washington, D. C.

Financial Advice and Counsel:-

The Plan provides for the lending institution to advise the prospective home builder with regard to the financial phases of the home building project. It will pass judgment upon the ability of the home builder to finance the project and meet the monthly payments to amortize the mortgage. It will determine the amount of the loan which it is willing to make for building a particular house for a particular borrower.

Federal Home Building Service Plan Available at Nominal Fees:-

Through cooperation of the architectural profession, it is possible to introduce this technical service into small home building at fees so nominal that home builders are able to secure technical safeguards on even the lowest price houses. The established fees vary generally in accordance with the cost of the house.

The minimum fee is based on use of prepared working drawings without changes, complete and detailed specifications, inspection of building site, several consultations for the selection of the most suitable design and for adapting the plan to the site, qualifying of contractors and securing of bids (on owner-built projects) and a specified number of supervisions of the construction work. Additional consultations and inspections may be arranged at specified nominal fees each. Revisions of prepared plans, or creating original design for the client, add to the minimum fee. Discounts from fees charged on the individual project, may be granted home builders who construct a number of houses simultaneously under the Plan.

These technical fees are considered a legitimate part of the construction cost as adding value to the improvements; hence they are added to the investment upon which the loan is computed and may be included and paid from the construction fund.


Protection of the Public Under the Plan:-


The public can identify the Federal Home Building Service Plan as the complete home building service sponsored and offered through the facilities of the Federal Home Loan Bank Board by the name, official insignia, Certificate of Registration and other elements comprising the Plan.

Protection of the Federal Home Building Service Plan against Infringement:

The use of the name Federal Home Building Service Plan, the use of the approved insignia, the Certificate of Registration, and the other parts and elements comprising the Plan will be protected against infringement by the Federal Home Loan Bank Board so that no person, firm or Corporation shall represent to the public any service, plan, or product as being the Federal Home Building Service Plan unless the same is in accord with the Plan's requirements.







THREE ROOM FRAME BUNGALOW

Construction: Wood frame.

Exterior finish: Wide siding or shingles.

Ceiling height: 8'6".

This plan provides extra sleeping accommodations in the living room, where there is a bed closet. A dining alcove is arranged between the living room and kitchen. A rear entry leads to the basement. The porch at the front and the terrace at the rear add somewhat additional expense, but the terrace may be omitted. The fireplace also may be omitted.







FOUR ROOM, TWO STORY HOUSE




Construction: Wood frame.

Ceiling height: First story 8'6", second story 8'.





LIVING AND DINING ROOM COMBINED

Construction: Wood frame.

Exterior finish: Stucco to second story level, siding or shingles above.

Ceiling height: First story 8'6", second story 8'.





In this plan living and dining space are combined into one generous area. Stairs to the second floor are directly accessible to the kitchen by way of the hall. Alternate locations of porches are indicated. A different exterior, with identical plans, is provided in design 4-A-36.



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

Construction: Hollow tile walls.

Exterior finish: Stucco. Tile roof.

Ceiling height: 8'4".

Although designated a four-room bungalow, this design has practically a full size dining room, thus giving five-room accommodations. In addition, there is a breakfast nook in the kitchen. The fireplace may be omitted, and a shingle roof may be substituted to reduce costs.



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

Construction: Wood frame.

Exterior finish: Wide siding or shingles.

Ceiling height: 8'6".

The plans do not provide a separate dining room, but there is formal space for dining in a nook arranged in an alcove off the kitchen. There is attic space but not sufficient for rooms, and a stairway is not provided. Adjustment of the kitchen furniture may be necessary to meet individual requirements. The fireplace may be omitted to reduce costs.





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

FOUR BEDROOM COLONIAL BUNGALOW




Construction: Wood frame.

Exterior finish: Narrow siding or shingles; corner boards.

Ceiling height: 7'6".

There is a space under the roof for an additional bedroom, hall, and storage. The alternate sketch for the first floor hall indicates the stairway to the second floor if one is desired. A porch may be included at the left side of the living room.




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

TWO BEDROOM CONCRETE MASONRY HOUSE



Construction: Concrete blocks.

Exterior finish: Stucco.

Ceiling height: 8'6".

There is an attic stairway and some space in the attic, but not sufficient headroom for rooms. This design is contemplated to be principally of concrete. The working drawings provide a concrete slab at the first floor, for which, if necessary, other types of construction may be substituted. The terrace at the side of the living room may be omitted in the interests of economy.



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

The dining space in this plan is provided in a bay window off the living room near the kitchen. There is attic space with stairway but not sufficient head room for rooms.





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

Ceiling height: 8'6".



The fireplace may be omitted to reduce costs. There is no available space in the attic for rooms. Some simplification of the exterior wood trim would reduce costs.

There is no space for rooms in the attic and no stairway is provided. A number of similar plans providing for different materials and differences in architectural style are available.




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

FIVE ROOM SPANISH BUNGALOW



CAPE COD COLONIAL FIVE ROOM HOUSE






FIVE ROOM CAPE COD COLONIAL HOUSE




DINING ROOM IIXI3 ENTRY WOOD BN IZXZI GARAGE 9'5 x 16 FIRST FLOOR PLAN

Adapted to the inside lot, this plan provides a living room across the front. The porch may be omitted or placed at the rear. A stairway to the attic is provided in the upper hall. A breakfast nook may be substituted for the pantry if desired and the kitchen in any case rearranged to suit individual needs. The second story overhang in front is six inches deep.
