HOW LONG HAS THE BAND BEEN GOING ?. The band started about a year and a half ago (It's AUGUST 83), but has had two changes since then (Drums & Bass).At first we found it really hard to get gigs and practices but we got a lot of help from Total Chaos and The Reptiles and a few other people. They also introduced us to the Gateshead Music Collective. We had no gear except for a drum kit,& if it wasn't for the Gateshead Music Collective, we and about thirty other bands would have no gear to practice or play gigs with.

WHATS THE REACTION LIKE AT GIGS ?. Great ! Lately over the past couple of months weve had a gig nearly every week. Sometimes you cant get a gig anywhere and it really pisses you



WHATS THE SONGS MOSTLY ABOUT ?. The songs are getting tighter & changing all the time. They deal with a lot of things like everyday people in everyday circumstances. Were not a strong political band but it has influences on us obviously. Take the song 'No War', it's not just another song about people dieing etc, but about how ignorant people are to those who suffer on both sides. Not the soldier but the people working in the fields who tries to carry on their normal lives, it must be really hard. The warmongers don't really give a shit about village or city life during a war. The Bus To London' is pretty easy, it's about hitching up and down the motorway which Trev does a lot of.


Lately a lot of people to the gigs sometimes up to 40 or 50. Some are new faces, some are ones that come regularly, and that means a hell of a lot to us. So when someone pays 30 or 40p to see the gig we give them everything !







Portland has three major hardcore bands who are...Lockjaw,Sado-Nation,and Poison Idea.We have all been around for a few years now.New bands here are...Final Waning,Civil Defence,SLA,and Red Badge.We

don't have a club but we hire halls. Theres a lot of punks here, and it's a cool scene. I have the only zine.... White Trash. (Details at the end of this interview OK for those interested.

WHAT INSPIRES YOUR SONGS ?. Violence, Sex, Drugs, and Punks. We write what we feel and we don't want to preach to people... just say how we feel.

WHAT DO YOU ALL DO WITH YOURSELVES WHEN NOT WITH THE BAND ?.

Me and Tony work, Eric is at College and Rob drinks. I like poking young girls & getting fucked up. We raise a lot of heall with hippies and rockers. I love going to hardcore shows and reading porn.

WHERE DOES THE NAME COME FROM ?.


Well Lockjaw means 'Just before death'. When you get Lockjaw your gonna die and Tony broke his Jaw once and he had it all wired up Lockjaw !




Another one of Newcastles many punk bands is 'No Remorse'; Hebby their Bassist sent me the following peice on the bandWe first started back in 1981 under the name 'Anemic Bodies' and basicly the band was just a good excuse to make some noise and annoy the neighbours. The line up then was Eggy-Guitar, Hebby-Bass, Ken-Drums, and Col-Vocals and guitar. This line up lasted about as long as Kens penis (Not long). Eggy left because he couldn't stretch his fingers across the fret board and Ken left soon afterwards to join a Clash rip off band who wore extremely wide flares. This just left me (Hebby) and Col but we got in a kid called Hodgie on Vocals. This line up didn't include a drummer so not suprisingly it didn't last very long, as Col left to play bass for another Newcastle band ... The Abductors. 



As promised in the last issue of Final Curtain heres an article on the French punk scene, as written by Hans Burger. Hans does a radio show and he would be more than glad to give your record/tape/zine some air space so get writing. His address will be at the end of this report OK.....

First of all, let me tell you that there are more and more punks, certainly and happily more than yesterday. In 1977 there were some good punk bands, perhaps you may have heard of The Stinky Toys, Metal Urbane, Asphalt Jungle, but to my knowledge the best were Gazoline and The Guilty Razors, they've all done great records. Unfortunately they were not the better known, (They being Gazoline & Guilty Razors ... Plebb) . A great evolution has taken place sinse then, like in other countries, punk has become more of a way of life than a fashion, happily in countries like England there are lots of bands, punks and fanzines that carry on the good work, because they ve got a brain and because they do care about what other people are doing. In France. the punks are quite young, and as there areint too many bands in the country, they listen to British bands, they don't understand their lyrics and so they don't care about the subjects like anti-war, animal exploitation etc etc. Now there are also some bands that go into the studios to record their own material. Theres one interesting label that helps a lot of young bands and they're called 'Chaos Produstions'. They've done two compilations with bands like Komintern Sect, Kidnap, Blank SS and No Put, but it's not very original even if the best part of them sing in French. Their lyrics are about being drunk, pissed off and having lots and lots of fun, thats all.

Anyway, I'm optimistic about the future because some bands like Crass, Conflct, Dirt, and Rudimentary Peni, sell more and more records in this country and i know that there are some bands who have lots to say about our mad society, and they'll go out soon with records i hope There are also some people who do their best to make others think. Theres an anarcho punk collective called 'O.M.G.' and theyve put out a good tape. They also put out a fanzine called 'La Bible and it's great. There was also a great band called Blank SS but they ve now split.Blank SS did two tapes on a good cassette label called 'Kronchiadt Tapes

One good band is Camera Silens, I'll write an article about them soon, because they are very big here, even if they have only released one tape and one track on a compilation. They are based in Bordeaux, in the south and west of France (See map opposite) and they have done






