Out on the edge walking by faith, no longer hiding in safe places

Only to find, You've been waiting on me all this time

You cannot stay in safe places and serve others with your God given gifts and talents. It will take RISK. It will take FAITH.

"Just as each of you have received a special gift (a spirtual talent, an ability graciously given by God), use it in serving one another as good stewards of God's mult-faceted grace (faithfully using the diverse, varied gifts and abilities granted to Christians by God's unmerited favor)."- 1Peter 4:10 (AMP)

The Greek word for "multifaceted" is Poikilos. The definition is various, of different colors, and diverse. What a beautiful way to express God's grace. Did you see the relationship between our gift and talents and reaching the world with Gods grace?

A primary way God is extending his grace to the world is through your unique gifts and talents. That grace is not just about forgiveness of sins. It is about so much more! God's grace revels beauty, releases hope, replaces sorrow with laughter, and so much more.

TIME for ACTION

Tomorrow when you awake start a new ritual. Out loud come in agreement with 1 peter 4:10. There is a spritiual principle when we verbalize something

out loud it has power. Paul set up a pattern not only for salvation but for establishing God's truth in your life in Romans 10:10. If you confess with your mouth and believe in your heart then you will transform.

Every Morning confess with you mouth and believe in your heart:

- I received the special gift of <name the gifts, talents> from God
- I will serve others with my <name the gift, talent>
- When I <do the verb of my gift, talent > God will extend his grace to one person
- I will experience God's JOY as I step out even more in my <the Verb of my gift, talent>

Expect oposition when you start to step out in your gifts and talents!

I sinned. I don't exactly remember what I did but I remember how I felt. Church was ending and they called us up front if we wanted to pray. I rushed to the front of the church, hit my knees and buried my face on the floor. I was groveling. I was sincere but I was a mess. Then I heard the Lord speak, "Stand Up". Then I heard it again and again "Stand Up, Stand Up, Stand Up."

In disbelief, I hobbled my way up to a standing position. As soon as I was standing, it was as if God took his right hand and put it on the side of my head covering my ear and pulled me into His chest in a hug. I felt the forgiving embrace of my Father. It was tangible. I felt like a son vs a subject fearfully approaching an anger king with bad news. I felt dignity and acceptance. It was a amazing contrast. Convicted yet hopeful and sorrowful yet deeply loved.

Then he went on to say to me, "Ive made you to stand out". And so it was. Everyone else kneeing at the church altar and there I was standing. Much of my life, I have been the odd one out. The one that stands out from the crowd. As the chinese proverb goes, "the tallest blade of grass gets cut first". As I stood out from the crowd people have called me rebellious, not a team player, a cheat, anti-authority, unqualified, undeserving, antagonist and the list goes on. I have had to overcome these labels to be who God made me to be, one who stands out. The pressure to sink into my chair, shut up and disappear is always with me. It is one of Satan's strategies against how God made me to be. But I fight back with his truth:

WE ARE NOT OF THEM THAT SHRINK BACK-PAUL HEB. 10:39 (ASV)

As the Bible says, 'Don't be surprised by trials of many kinds.' —James. When you start to make forward progress on the dreams God put into you, expect opposition. Expect attacks. Expect trouble at work, at home, in finances, with friends, etc... Especially when you first start out and your commitment to change only has weak roots. The Bible talks about the 'enemy coming in like a flood'. The devil will try to overwhelm you "like a flood" in hopes you will give up and quit. Quit on these lofty unrealistic dreams. Quit on God. Believe "if it's God then why is this so hard?" Quit on believing God is for you and loves you deeply.

TIME for ACTION

God warns us not to be ignorant of the Devils schemes (Plans, Tatics, Approaches). You combat ignorance with study.

- Study New Testament keywords: Warfare, Battle, Authroity, Satan, and Overcome. This will arm you and prepare for the next round. Take the time, don't rush.
- Study Old Testament keywords Fight, War, Battle. Read the full stories of how the Israelites engaged in Battle. Read how God delivered them in different ways in different battle. This will give insight for when the enemy come at you.
- Read my <u>BLOG</u>: Playing Hurt. Seek to learn where Satan started the attack on your life when you were young. Go back to go forward.

You need a community who will champion God in you!

If I did not have my band of brother's community, I would have quit by now. Community is not easy but you have to push through the obsticles as mentioned above to take part. It is worth it! As my Friend Rob says, "Must be present to win". I apparently don't leave good first impressions. One guy told me "When I first met you I thought your were a know-it-all a-hole." We went on to become close friends as he continued to say "Now that Ive gotten to know you, I like you". I liked him because I do have the tendency to be a "know-it-all" but he did not write me off. As I continued to hang around God

in my life to start to shine. He noticed and spoke up. Community lets you live honestly. You DON"T have to put your best face on. We all have ugly sides, heck you think God didn't know that. Yet a Godly community will see you from God's perspective and pursue that.
