(Note: Background of David Ferrie: Trained Cuban exile pilot, prior to the Bay of Pigs, in Guatemala. By the summer of 1963 was giving guerrilla training to the anti-Castro Cubans and adventurers in the camp north of Lake Pontchartrain.
