MEMORANDUM

A: Statement of <u>Jules Ricco Kimble</u> meeting Ferrie at the Golden Lantern and re subsequent flight to Canada with Shaw and Ferrie in late 1961 or early 1962.

- B: Information sheet about ownership of the Golden Lantern.
- C: U.S. District Court pleadings in which certain witnesses are referred to as well as the circumstances under which they saw Shaw and Ferrie together: Betty Rubio who saw them together at Lakefront Airport; Mr. and Mrs. Nicholas Tadin, who saw them together at Lakefront Airport; Herbert Wagner, who apparently saw them together at Ferrie's service station; Jim Louviere, who saw them together at Ferrie's service station and at Ferrie's house and James Laurent who saw them together at Ferrie's service station in 1964 (also mentioned in the pleadings are William Dunn, who saw Shaw and Ferrie with Lee Oswald at Clinton, Town Marshal John Manchester who identified Shaw and Ferrie as the occupants of the International Trade Mart's limousine at Clinton, Henry Earl Palmer who saw Lee Oswald at the Clinton and registration office and who identified Shaw and Ferrie as similar to the two men in the black I.T.M. Cadillac parked there and Corey Collins who saw Shaw, Ferrie and Oswald drive up together in the car. The latter group are among others whose testimony about seeing Shaw and Ferrie together is a matter of record at the Shaw trial).
- $\underline{\text{D}}$: Statement by $\underline{\text{Nicholas Tadin}}$ regarding seeing Shaw and Ferrie coming out of a hangar together at New Orleans Airport in the summer of 1964.
- E: Statement by Mrs. Nicholas Tadin concerning seeing Ferrie and Shaw together at New Orleans Airport in the summer of 1964.
- F. G. H and I: Statements and memos re Shaw being flown with White or Wight of Freeport Nickel Company (a subsidiary of Freeport Sulphur to Cuba at an unspecified time. The lead indicates that the plane, owned by Freeport Sulphur, was flown by Dave Ferrie. The purpose of the flight, allegedly, was to set up import of Cuba's nickle ore to a Canadian front which would in turn ship it to a plant to be constructed at Braithewaite (in Louisiana, near New Orleans).
- J: Statement of <u>Barbara Messina</u>, Monroe, Louisiana, re having met Jack Ruby several times in 1963, in which she describes having been picked up on those occasions by "an elderly gray haired man in a Cadillac." (Obviously a lead in need of a thorough followup before being accepted or rejected).
- K: Edward Girnius told of being involved in 1963 with individuals in Dallas (including Jack Ruby) who were engaged in buying guns. According to his statement, his activity in buying and selling guns and ammunition led him into Louisiana where, in May or June of 1963, he was introduced to Clay Shaw. Shaw, Girnius stated, informed him that he knew some men who wanted

to buy guns. Afterwards he introduced him to a young man whom he called "Lee" and a man in a business suit. Girnius identified the young man as Lee Harvey Oswald. Girnius spoke of attending several parties where Shaw was present, at least one of which took place in Hammond (Shaw's home town) where Oswald also was present. Curiously, Girnius describes driving Oswald to "Catulla, Texas", in September, 1963, and then on into Mexico through Laredo.

L: Typewritten item in 5haw's address book (obtained by court order from his apartment on his arrest) concerning <u>Layten Martens</u>.

M: Police report concerning the November 24, 1963 arrest of Layten Martens and Alvin Beaubouef in connection with the investigation of David Ferrie by police investigators of the New Orleans District Attorney's office. This arrest was made in connection with the inquiry into Ferrie's strange trip into Texas on November 22, 1963 (to Houston, then down to Galveston). Martens and Beaubouef were found in Ferrie's apartment, waiting for his return from Texas. Martens and Beaubouef subsequently were released and the D.A.'s office arrested Ferrie on his return from Texas and ordered him held for the F.B.I. for questioning.

ED DWYER of St. Francisville, Louisiana, phone number 635-3724, gave us the following information during our meeting at the New Orleans Athletic Club:

ED DWYER said he is familiar with the farm that LLOYD J. COBB owns in St. Francisville, Louisiana. He said he knows for sure that SHAW has been to the farm. He said he also feels certain that SHAW has been to Clinton many times and said there are many people in Clinton who could help us if they wanted to get involved.

DWYER said that H. B. FAIRCHILD used to run the farm for COBB up until 1963. FAIRCHILD left around 1963 and is now managing MANCHAC PLANTATION in Sunshine, La. In '63 JERRY MORROW was in charge of the plantation and made arrangements for the parties that were given there. It seems that they had a guest house and the people who attended these parties stayed at the guest house and signed a registration book. JERRY MORROW eventually lost his job to BOSS DANIELS who may or may not be there at the present time.

REEVES MORGAN agrees that FAIRCHILD and MORROW would be good sources of information for us.

DWYER said that we might also talk to BENJAMIN GARRIS who is a retired FBI agent now working at Angola State Penitentiary.

DWYER said that MATT PLENNIGER kept the books for Merridale Farms (COBB'S farm), and now teaches school at St. Francisville High.

DWYER said that JOHN HENRY SHIPES told him that SHAW had some connection with the "Klan" around the St. Francisville area, and that he possibly may have supplied some money.

DWYER said we should also talk to LLOYD COBB's brother-in-law who is in Shreveport and who doesn't like COBB. He could not furnish us the name at this time.

DWYER said that SHIPES has already been approached by one of the attorneys for SHAW who wanted him to testify for SHAW. SHIPES however refused.

DWYER said that there is a person by the name of SYLVESTER in Clinton who is known as ED PARTIN'S "strong-arm man" and who would be able to give us some very valuable information about SHAW if he wanted to cooperate. He said he believes that SYLVESTER can tell us who SHAW knew in Clinton and when he was there.

 $\,$ DWYER said we should also talk to RICHARD KILBOURNE the District Attorney in Clinton for information about SHAW and his friends.

He also said that we should talk to JUDGE BENNETT and ZIP MORGAN for information about SHAW. (MORGAN IS A FRIEND OF GARRISON)

RYDER COFFEE HOUSE LEAD:

Since the Ryder Coffee House continually comes up in regards to LEE HARVEY OSWALD, we should remain aware of its potential. In this regard DAPHNE STAPELTON recalls meeting OSWALD in the Ryder Coffee House when he supposedly was looking for JACK FRAZIER. He also went to HOWARD COHEN'S apartment on this occasion but COHEN was not at home. (JACK FRAZIER and HOWARD COHEN have both been mentioned before as possible acquaintances of LEE HARVEY OSWALD.) STAPELTON also said that an elderly woman with sort of grey hair, in her 40's, drove OSWALD up to the coffee house on this occasion in some type of red sports car.

NAPOLEON STREET LIBRARY LEAD:

NORMAN GALLO was an employee of the NAPOLEON STREET BRANCH LIBRARY. In addition to having an interesting background which included travels to many parts of the world and doing intelligence work when he was in the Air Force, he also met LEE HARVEY OSWALD on several occasions when OSWALD checked out books at the Napoleon Street Branch Library. He may be able to contribute some interesting information on LEE HARVEY OSWALD. He is not in town at the present time, but his parents live in Jefferson Parish.

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PFISTERER DENTAL LABORATORY LEAD:

MRS. AMELDA SMITH, 4951 Drew Avenue, and PALMER McBRIDE, both worked and knew OSWALD when he worked with them at the above-named dental laboratory. MRS. SMITH said that she had difficulty with him and MR. McBRIDE argued with him often. Perhaps they can give us some interesting information on LEE HARVEY OSWALD.

We are still attempting to acquire a copy of the 41 page report on OSWALD and FERRIE prepared by MAJOR JOHN R. THOMAS and SGT. ROBERT W. KNIGHT of the Louisiana State Police at the request of the Warren Commission. Approximately 10 pages of this report are still classified. MAJOR THOMAS' name has come up before. MR. WILLIS, who worked at the Motor Vehicle Registration Bureau in Baton Rouge, told us that after our investigation started MAJOR THOMAS came into the Motor Vehicle Registration Bureau and said that he had orders from the Governor to check on SHAW'S vehicle registration. WILLIS said that THOMAS pulled some cards out of the file and kept them. I checked with the Governor's office and they said that they did not ask MAJOR THOMAS to do this and I checked with MAJOR THOMAS and he denied that he did this.

Fro some time I have been trying to locate GUY BANISTER'S files which were picked clean after his death by DELPHINE ROBERTS (who was first on the scene), MRS. MARY BANISTER and the FBI. ROSS BANISTER told me that MAJOR WYLIE of the Louisiana State Police obtained some of the BANISTER files from MARY BANISTER. He also said that an ex-FBI agent was helping MARY BANISTER dispose of or sell the files. Also JOE COOPER of Baton Rouge said that he heard that BANISTER had a file on LEE. HARVEY OSWALD and CLAY SHAW which went to MAJOR WYLIE of the Louisiana State Police.

(NOTE: BANISTER did have a folder on CLAY L. SHAW and the Fair Play For Cuba Committee) but both folders are empty. I have seen these empty folders in the office of the State Sovereignty Commission in Baton Rouge.)

I have been visited first by a man who identified himself as Mr.
Wilson who said he was an investigator for the defense for Clay
Shaw. NAXX We went to a coffee shop on Gravier Street and talked
for about ten minutes and he wanted to know if I could help him in
any way, if I could give him any information about the investigation
in general. XXXX I told him I didn't know anything. He asked
if I had been interviewed by the District Attorney's office and
I told him I had been and then he asked if I had been intimidated
in any way and I told him no, not in any way. Most of the
conversation was in general, just what I knew about the case or
about Clay Shaw. This is all there was to this particular man.
This was a few days after I came to the District Attorney's office
where I was interviewed by Mr. Alcock.

and then a few days later I was called on by a man who I was not familiar with at that time whose name is waiter. Sheridan. He came to the club and we went to the doffee shop on Gravier. Street and talked. He said that he was very much interested in the Clay Shaw investigation, that he wanted to speak to me in the interest of Clay Shaw. He asked me if I had been interviewed by anyone and I told him kkw about Mr. Wilson and prior to that the District Attorney's office. He asked if I could help him in any way. He asked if I knew Fred Leemans and I told him yes. He was a partner of mine in 1961 operating the Alla Baba Turkish Baths. Since then I have not had any connection with him. He asked if I could vouch for him in any way, as to his honesty and so forth. I told him I did not know anything about him. I have not seen him for a long time and that we had only been in business together for a short time.

He said I would be perfectly safe in telling him anything, that I would never had to testify in Court no matter what I said.

He siad he felt that Clay Shaw was innocent and would never to to

trial. I asked him why he thought this. He said he was quite positive that Perry Russo, the star witness, would not appear. He said that was the reason there would be no trial. I asked him what would whas happen to Russo, why was he so sure he would not appear. He said he felt that Perry Russo would not appear, there would be no trial and that Perry Russo would be out of the State, somewhere where he could not be extradited and, therefore, he could not appear. I asked him if Perry Russo would go to the same place as Novel and he said that he would probably go to California.

He asked me if I had been pressured in any way by the District Attorney's affice and did I say what I said voluntarily. I told him whatever I said was of my own free will.

The next time I saw Mr. Sheridan was on the NBC program.

That was the first time I xsw knew that he was connected with

NBC. He had not told me at our meeting that he was with NBC.

He led me to believe that he was only interested in Clay Shaw.

I am making this statement of my free will without force or promises or threats to me or my family.

The Illinois Lead: The following would seem to be unusually important. Henry Lesnick, who is in the Department of English at Northwestern University, Evanston, Illinois 60201, has written me and stated that a friend of his who lived in New Orleans for eighteen months in 1961 and 1962, has admitted that he was Clay Shaw's lover intermittently during that period. This friend of Lesnick's also stated that David Ferrie was Shaw's lover as well. The friend states that he met them early in 1961 at a party which they attended together. Mr. Lesnick gave no details, indicating that he assumes that we already know this. Actually, inasmuch as this is the point on which we really should have more information (since it reinforces Perry Russo and explains many other things) we should contact Mr. Lesnick and see if his friend will meet with us. Needless to say, all possible details of the Shaw-Ferrie relationship should be obtained. (This is especially important inasmuch as Shaw denies knowing Ferrie.) Furthermore, we should obtain all possible information with regard to other acquaintances of Shaw. Furthermore, inasmuch as this is a period during which Kerry Thornley was active in New Orleans, it is possible that an additional lead might be developed in this direction. This man could be an extremely important witness in an area where we really have had insufficient development; consequently, we should not be too quick to advise him that he does not have to be a witness. However -- if worse comes to worse, needless to say, we would rather have the information than nothing at all . since this seems to be an extremely important lead as it is brand new information in an area where we don't have as much as we should have. It should be followed up and developed to the maximum -- hopefully to the point where we can persuade the friend to be a witness.

Note: This lead is being handled by Alcock (House, 1)

2. The Winkler Lead: In the detective reports (Southern Research in 1961 or 1962) concerning visitors to David Ferrie's house, one of the visitors was a man named Henry Winkler. As I recall, he had a South Claiborne address at the time. This should be confirmed by reexamination of the stake-out portions of the detective report and by checking with the City Directory for relevant periods. Winkler should be interviewed because he may know not only Ferrie but possibly Shaw or Oswald. This should be assigned by Ivon for investigation.

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3. The Covington Lead: In Volume XX, page 215, it is indicated that Oswald "took a few days off" from the Reily Coffee Company and went to covington on May 14, 1963. Inasmuch as he only began work at Reily on May 10th, this is a remarkable occurrence for a brand new employee with a laborer's job. While this does not justify any specific action in the absence of additional evidence connected with Covington, it should be kept in mind as a potential new area.

The "Earl Colomb Lead": This lead comes from Pudgy Miranne. Mr. C. EARL COLOMB, who was formerly the Vice-President of the International Trade Mart at a time when THEODORE BRENT -- SHAW's original sponsor -- was head, knows a great deal about SHAW and his activities at the ITM. Some years earlier COLOMB took an occasional trip with SHAW and BRENT. Miranne states that COLOMB is not a friend of SHAW's and may be a source of information. (My initial reaction to this lead is that, timewise, COLOMB's contact with SHAW may have been at too early a stage. However, that very fact might result in his being a source of information clarifying SHAW's now hidden intelligence connections with the federal intelligence apparatus.

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4. The "David Cotter Lead": This information comes from Harry Daniels at the NOAC. This is a vague lead, which places it in the long-shot category, however it mentions an interesting geographical area. According to Daniels, DAVID COTTER is a close friend of SHAW's, in more ways than one. COTTER suddenly left New Orleans when our investigation started and moved to Lacombe. Since then he has moved somewhere else. He worked for "BALLINGER" (follow up will have to be made with Daniels about this) for a while. It is suggested that Lynn Loisel contact Harry Daniels (this is not the former police officer but the man who is attached to the State Police) and see if more specific data is available.

RAY B. HIATT, 1411 Marigny, was interviewed in my office by myself and Louis Ivon. He stated that he bought a 1960 black Cadillac sedan from JEFFERSON BIDDISON a little over a year ago. (Official records reflect that the sale was made on January 18, 1967). The car was in good condition when he bought it. It had approximately 32,000 miles on it at the time. HIATT feels, but does not know positively, that BIDDISON had bought the car new. (Official records reflect that BIDDISON bought the car on September 27, 1961). The only other person HIATT has seen driving the car besides BIDDISON is JACK SAWYER. SAWYER and BIDDISON both work for the Marilyn Tate Real Estate Co. Dlocated at 922 Royal Street. HIATT stated the he had seen BIDDISON talking to CLAY SHAW on at least two occasions. HIATT does not recall BIDDISON taking any extended trips from New Orleans in the past four or five years. It should be added here that HIATT is now, and has been for some time, working for BIDDISON. HIATT will readily testify to the above facts.

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MRS. JEANNE KELTON LEAD:

(See SANDERS' Memo of 4/11/68)

MRS. KELTON lived at 905 Governor Nicholls Street from 1963 to 1966. She said that SHAW used to visit a young man who lived in the apartment building quite often. She said that the young man was "gay" and referred to SHAW as his "patron". MRS. KELTON doesn't remember the boy's name, but she said that JOHN CARTER who also lived at 905 Governor Nicholls could also give us some information on this gay friend of SHAW's. MRS. KELTON also remembers seeing SHAW going in and out of Cosmos' Bar on several occasions.

24) DR. JACOB HAROLD KETY LEAD:

(See SANDERS' Memo of 2/14/68)

DR. KETY told SANDERS that GREG DONNELLY who lives in Abita Springs, could give us some information on CLAY SHAW. DONNELLY said that he knew CLAY SHAW when he was poor and before SHAW was "adopted" by BRENT. DONNELLY, who is gay, lives with CARL CRAMER, a sculptor, and openly says that they are married to each other. Their phone number in Abita Springs is 892-2187.

25) JACK FRAZIER LEAD:

(See FRAZIER letters of 1/1/68 and 12/29/67, SANDERS' memo of 3/6/68, Sciambra memo of 9/16/68 and REID memo of 9/25/68)

Perhaps some time should be spent cultivating FRAZIER. He could be a good source of information. He ran the Ryder Coffee House where, according to several people, OSWALD frequented. He was a friend of THORNLEY, WILL BRADY, IVAN COTTMANN, HOWARD COHEN, JOHN CAMUS, and HELEN GLADSTONE (all Ryder House regulars). One rumor was that

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he took a trip to Mexico with OSWALD and COHEN (he has denied this). He has said that he believes BRADY's deportation and OSWALD's leaflet distribution are connected in some way. He said, "I think that BRADY was deported because the CIA wanted him out of the country." According to DAPHNE STAPELTON, who lived in one of the Ryder House Apartments, OSWALD came to the Ryder House one day and asked her "Is JACK here?" When she said, no, OSWALD then wrote his name on a piece of paper and told her to, "Give it to JACK and tell him I was here." FRAZIER has denied all of this to Barbara Reid and Harold Weisberg, however, he did say that as best as he can remember, he has never met LEE HARVEY OSWALD, but he cannot rule out the possibility.

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26) HOWARD COHEN LEAD:

(See FRAZIER letter of 12/29/67, Sciambra memo of 9/16/68, Reid memo of 9/25/68)

COHEN's name has come up several times in connection with OSWALD. He worked at the Ryder Coffee House and lived in one of the upstairs apartments. He was a friend of all the Ryder House regulars. He led a Marxist discussion group at the Ryder House. According to STAPELTON, OSWALD went to COHEN's apartment looking for him one day, but COHEN was not at home. A last check, according to Reid, COHEN was in Japan.

27) JACK BURNSIDE LEAD: (See BURNSIDE memo)

BURNSIDE in my opinion is worth talking to again. He was a friend of all the regulars at the Ryder Coffee House, especially THORNLEY. JACK FRAZIER pointed him out as someone who may be able to give us some information on OSWALD and THORNLEY. He was supposedly in Fong's Restaurant on Decatur Street with THORNLEY when OSWALD came in to meet THORNLEY. He told this to someone and said that THORNLEY introduced him to OSWALD, however, when confronted with this by Weisberg and Reid, he denied it.

28) JOHN CAMUS LEAD: (See FRAZIER letter of 1/1/68)

The GLEASONS lived in an apartment above the Ryder Coffee House. According to STAPELTON, PATTIE was with her when OSWALD came to the Ryder Coffee House and asked her for JACK FRAZIER Subsequently, the GLEASONS were supposedly seen sitting at a table with OSWALD and "a couple of other people" in the Ryder Coffee House. & (Reid may be able to locate.)

32) LONNIE GOLDFINCH LEAD: (See Reid memo)

GOLDFINCH is an ex-FBI informer who also worked for GUV BANNITETED worked for GUY BANNISTER. He is supposed to have known OSWALD in New Orleans. He is presently living in Kansas City and Reid is attempting to get his address for us.

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KARNO was connected with the Modern Language Institute through his friendship with ARNESTO. RODRIGUEZ and ROGER LOVIN. He supposedly met OSWALD at the Napoleon Street Branch Library and was seen with him at the Ryder Coffee House. (Reid can locate.)

34) DAVE GRAYDON LEAD: (See prior GRAYDON memo)

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We have already talked to GRAYDON in regard to WILL BRADY who used to be his roommate, however, we have not talked to him in regard to EDDIE PORTER whom he knows from the Penny Arcade on Royal Street. He says that PORTER knew BRADY and some other people from around the Ryder Coffee House. He might possibly know PORTER's friend JOHN, from the Arcade, who was a friend of OSWALD's. He is presently living at 1408 Pauger Street, New Orleans.

She said that several days before OSWALD moved, she observed an individual talking to her husband who asked for the location of the OSWALDS. She describes this person as a white male, approximately 5'7", 175 pounds, dark complexion, and had a foreign appearance, possibly Spanish. She also recalls seeing a young couple in their early 20's stopping in to see the OSWALDS. She also recalls seeing a female who wore a white coat and whom she thinks was a Welfare worker, call at the OSWALD apartment.

38) BRIAN AMPOLEX LEAD: (See FBI interview of 11/29/63)

BRIAN AMPOLEX, 1418 Haring Road, Metairie, Louisfana, met LEE HARVEY OSWALD one or two days before OSWALD was arrested for handing out leaflets on Canal Street. He and OSWALD had about a five minute convensation on politics. While he was conversing with OSWALD, he was aware that there was one or two other persons also handing out leaflets, but according to the report, he paid no attention to them and does not recall what they looked like.

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39) DOROTHY RIEGEL or RAGAN LEAD: (See Reid memo)

REIGEL or RAGAN allegedly was a hustler who knew OSWALD and gave him money during the summer of 1963.

40) LAKEFRONT AIRPORT MECHANIC LEAD:

DAVE PERALE supposedly had a colored friend named DHILLIPS who was a mechanic and who went many places with him, including the Lakefront Airport (unknown whether he was an airplane or automobile mechanic). PHILLIPS supposedly was a prested for vagrancy on Orleans Alente in 1963, and given tharty days. He supposedly went before Judge Babylon.

ROLFE advised that she had learned the first name of the woman at the party with WILLIAM PERRY BROWN. She said that the first name was $\overline{\text{DEEMB}}$ and that she would try to get the last name. She stated that $\overline{\text{DEEMA}}$ was a lesbian and she seemed to be positive about her information concerning the party. (Leb. "Sam")

MRS. FRED WILSON:

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At an early juncture in the Jackson, Loursiana inquiry Fruge came across information that a woman at Jackson - "possibly MRS. FRED WILSON - was a former prostitute and was driving a brand new car with Texas license plates in 1963"./The car, it was indicted was registered to JACK NUBY. FRED WILSON, the information indicated, as in the dirt hadling business. This lead can be checked out by Sciambra.

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A painter and carpenter, 2039 seventh Street, in 1963 was helping to paint SHAW'S bathroom at his home. He was working with another colored man (and a white plumber who has since died). The other colored man he believed to be named FRERET. CLARK observed two young men playing cards most of the day in SHAW'S apartment. He identifies one of the men as LEE OSWALD and the other as an unknown young man. He does not recall seeing SHAW there during this particular day, although it was SHAW'S apartment. CLARK'S wife owns a restaurant at 2039 seventh Street. As of this date, he is being contacted for us. If this contact is unsuccessful we will have to follow-up ourselves. The source of this information should rate as very good.

IX. JAMES WARREN:

One JAMES WARREN left New Orleans when the probe started. He worked with CLAY SHAW. His daughter PHYLLIS dated PERRY RUSSO and some of his friends. They live at 9011 Sara Lane in Shreveport. PHYLLIS WARREN is now at Southeastern in Hammond. (Hammond comes up again!)

THERESA CLAIRE FAGNANT:

This young lady lived at 617 Dumaine Street from October 1962 to April 1963. On last information she was living at 11tl Stephens (the Three Oaks Apartments) in Gretna. On November 22nd she was working at Beeing out at Michoud. She left at noon and failed to return. She was missing for a week and on her return claimed that she had gone skiing in New Mexico. Another interesting factor concerning FAGNANT, in addition to her actions, is the fact that this apartment house is the same one in which DONALD DOOTY - former Army Intelligence employee and close friend of CLAY SHAW stayed on his return from Mexico in 1963. The 1962 Directory also shows that one TIMOTHY J. O"HALLORAN. also of the Boeing Company, lived there. Also living there, according to the 1962 Directory, was one LUTHER P. HIMES, an importer. On moving from 817 Dumaine, FAGNANT moved to the Studio Arms at 3500 Division Street. The source of information concerning her departure from Boeing on the day of the assassination seems to be good.

THE MORGAN-SHREVEPORT PHONE NUMBER: XVIP

Among the names listed in CLAY SHAW'S notebook is a man named MORGAN. MORGAN's phone number in Shreveport is indicated in that notebook. A review of DAVID FERRIE's telephone calls revealed that FERRIE called that number from his home phone.

VI. MEDALLION REAL ESTATE: COURSEMUL CHIEF FOR

On several occasions we have received information that a man named LOPEZ, who works at Medallion Real Estate Company, once made a trip to Cuba with SHAW. This note is placed herein primarily for future information, Inasmuch as LOPEZ is likely to be a friend of SHAW'S it would not be wise to contact him at the present time.

VII. ROBERT STRATTON:

His telephone number is 525-1380. Now this subject is a Geologist, and a graduate of L S U. He had been recently charged last year with murder) on APRIL 12, 1967. Also another subject, his name is one CHESLEY, however, he goes by the name of ROGER SOLIEAEU (I believe this is the spelling). This subject is a school teacher at JOHN CURTIS CHRISTIAN SCHOOL in Metairie. He rooms with this subject THOMPSON. Both these subjects are homosexuals - this is a fact -. they are both homosexuals and have been living together for years. This killing, murder - what ever you want to call it, took place at 1435 NO. JOHNSON STREET on April 12, 1967. DERIS E. THOMPSON was charged with murder. Their part in the Kennedy Assassination . plot - both these subjects, I know for a fact as very close intimate friends with MR. CLAY SHAW. I have seen them go into his apartment in the French Quarter on numerous occasions and were constantly with this subject so its a fact. To state further would be the fact that both these subjects possess a large number of firearms and explosives

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aswell. Fir. Thompson owns over 150 hand guns - by hand guns I mean pistols and revolvers plus a number of high power rifles - plus explosives at this address at 521. Explosives in the form of half sticks of dynamite. Now another interesting fact is that not only do they hand with Mr. Clay Shaw but he knows them very well and they have gone to his apartment numerous times. Both these subjects were also well known to MR. DAVID FERRIE up on Louisiana Avenue. If you would check Mr. Thompson's personal phone book you find Mr. Ferrie listed as well as Mr. Clay Shaw; so I think both of these would be of interest. SOLIEAEU is a W/M approx. 30 yrs. while THOMPSON is 33 yrs. They spoke on occasions to great detail about the Kennedy Administration.

If you do a small amount of investigation which I'm sure that the New Orleans Police Department will do - as they have in the past. You will uncover a great deal of facts which will help Mr. Garrison as well as the Intelligence Unit."

I would also like to report that I failed to give some information that both these subjects are members of an organization called SPARTICIST ASSOCIATION. He does have a large amount of hand guns and has loaned these guns out at times to certain characters who care not of the best character.

So if you put out an investigation - espicially about the explosives - I am sure it will yeild you the benifit of your trouble. I am hoping to see an investigation come forth.

He stated that there was a JAMES L. CHANEY, JR., on Irwing Simmons Drive in Dallas, Texas. He stated that this gentleman was between the age of 26 to 27; that he was a draftsman with Delta Showcase in Dallas. He stated that this MR. CHANEY had no criminal record. Further, that there was no information relative to him in any intelligence agency; that he had good credit with a low checking balance and a low savings balance in a local bank. MR. RATHERMILL indicated that he does not believe this to be the gentleman we are seeking. Further, MR. RATHERMILL gave me the name of JACK R. CHANEY. He stated that his information was to the effect that JACK RUBY had made a long-distance phone call to this JACK CHANEY at one time. The last information which he had relative to JACK R. CHANEY was that he was at the Continental Houston Hotel, Houston, Texas telephone - RE-3-0024. MR. RATHERMILL seemed to think that this was perhaps the gentleman our office was looking for.

Before leaving Dallas I intend to place a long-distance phone call to the Continental Houston Hotel, Houston, to check out JACK R. CHANEY.

This date I contacted DR. SHAW and completely explained our desire for his attendance in New Orleans. DR. SHAW stated that his testimony, of course, would be the same as it was before the Warren Commission. He stated that he was able to determine the angulation of the wound which was inflicted upon Governor Connally. I asked him whether the angulation was approximately 27 degrees, and he stated that he did not recall exactly.

DR. SHAW - continued:

He stated that the bullet that passed through Gov. Connally fractured the fifth rib in Governor Connally's chest, but that this fracture, because of the angle of the bullet, probably did not change the course of the projectory very much. DR. SHAW further requested formal request for rendition of the witness be filed opposed to his voluntarily appearing in New Orleans.

As soon as possible, we must get out a Subpoena Duces Tecum for all of Dr. SHAW's medical records relative to his treatment of Governor Connally. Further, we must file our requisition for interstate witness.

MR. HOLLAND was contacted, however, due to his being ill for a period of three months I spoke to his daughter-in-law. Mr. HOLLAND refused to speak to us on the telephone.

It should be noted that in August of 1968, when MR. HOLLAND was interviewed by myself, he was a most cooperative witness. However now, even though I could hear MR. HOLLAND speaking to his daughter-in-law over the telephone, he refused to speak to me.

I was informed that MR. HOLLAND has been ill for some three months, and that at this time he was unable to make any trips of any nature whatsoever. Therefore, it is important that we file immediately an interstate witness rendition against Mr. HOLLAND In order that he appear in time for the Shaw trial.

RICHARD DODD:

This witness was on the triple overpass with S. M. HOLLAND and stated that he had seen the puff of smoke come from under the trees on the grassy knell, as well as having gone behind the fence and seen the footprints.

I was informed by MR. HOLLAND , and related through his daughter-in-law, that RICHARD DODD is now deceased, having died last year.

We discussed with MR. FRAZIER, MRS. RANDALL, and MR. HOLLENBECK the possibility of MR. FRAZIER voluntarily returning or coming to the City of New Orleans for the purpose of testifying in the case of State versus Shaw. We informed MR. FRAZIER that we were interested in him testifying simply as he had testified before the Warren Commission. We informed him that we would pay all of his expenses, and attempted to get MR. FRAZIER"S home telephone number and address. MR. FRAZIER stated that he did not have a telephone, and that he did not wish to give out his address.
