RE : BETTY MCDONALD

1. MIKE AGOCA of Life Magazine advised that he had located the BETTY McDONALD, librarian, referred to in the Warren Report as a guest at a party given by EVERETT GLOVER in 1963 at which MARINA OSWALD was introduced to RUTH PAINE, and that said BETTY McDONALD was then an employee of Magnolia Oil Company, a subsidiary of Mobileoil, which then as now employed GLOVER. AGOCA said that this BETTY MCDONALD had married a DR. ALLEN N. MILLER and now lived in Irving, Texas.
2. I telephoned the ALLEN N. MILLER RESIDENCE , BL 5-3353, in Irving (2105 Carpenter Freeway, office; residence 1225 W. Graywyler, BL 4-9626) . Dr. Miller answered; I stated my name but not my connection with this office nor the purpose of the call. Mrs. Miller was out.
3. Next day, I called back, Mrs. Miller answered, and I identified myself with this office, and stated the nature of the call. Mrs. Miller, speaking evenly and with no trace of surprise or irritation, answered quickly that she was the same BETTY MCDONALD WHO HAD attended that party, that she had gone alone to the party upon the invitation of Glover, whom she had known through their employment association, and that he had only recently moved into the house at which the party was given with CO-EMPLOYEE ROOM MATES RICHARD L. PIERCE AND AND DR. VOLKMAR SCHMIDT. I neglected to ask MRS. MILLER whether she ever had been a librarian.
