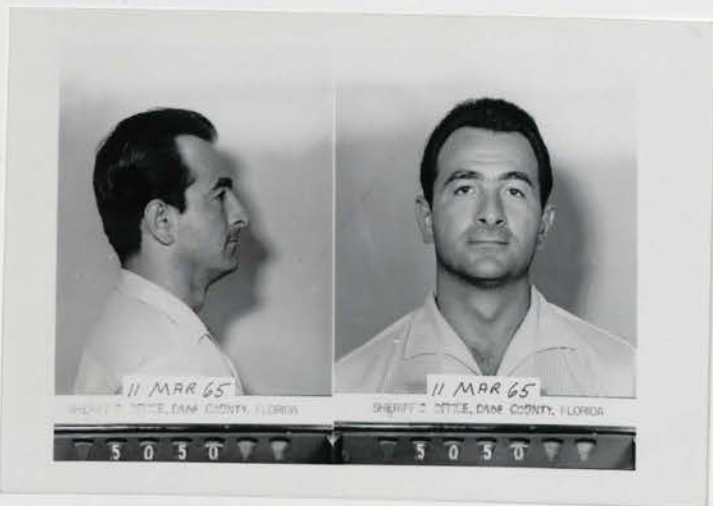
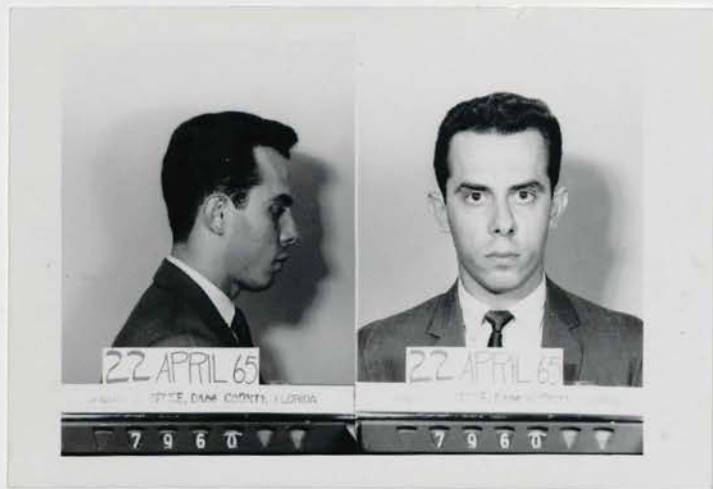

Re: FRIENDS OF DEMOCRATIC CUBA (CUBANS)
(and/or CUBAN REVOLUTIONARY FRONT)

IN EARLY JANUARY OF 1961 I WENT TO NEW ORLEANS WHILE ON A BUMMING AROUND THE COUNTRY EXPEDITION. AS MY FUNDS WERE LOW AT THAT TIME, I BEGAN LOOKING FOR A JOB. WHILE FOLLOWING A JOB LEAD ON A SIDE STREET OFF CANAL STREET - I DON'T REMEMBER THE NAME OF THE STREET - I NOTED A BUILDING ALL DECKED OUT IN RED, WHITE AND BLUE BANNERS WITH A LARGE SIGN ACROSS THE FRONT IN LETTERS AT LEAST A FOOT TALL, SAYING FRIENDS OF DEMOCRATIC CUBA (LATER THE NAME WAS CHANGED).

I WONDERED AT THIS AS CASTRO WAS AT THAT TIME MAKING INTERNATIONAL PLEAS FOR MILITARY AID AS THERE WAS, HE SAID, GOING TO BE AN INVASION FROM THE UNITED STATES... AND HE HAD LONG SINCE DECLARED CUBA COMMUNIST. SO I WENT IN TO INFORM THESE PEOPLE THAT CUBA WAS NOT A DEMOCRATIC BUT A DICTATORIAL NATION. I STEPPED INTO THE MOST UNUSUAL SITUATION I HAVE EVER ENCOUNTERED.

SUPPOSEDLY, THIS ORGANIZATION AND ITS PEOPLE WERE COLLECTING CLOTHING, FOOD, MONEY AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES, ETC, FOR CUBAN REFUGEES WHO WERE COMING OVER TO THE U.S. THE ORGANIZATION WAS IN EFFECT, I LEARNED SHORTLY, A FRONT FOR THE SCHEME OF AN INVASION OF CUBA AND THIS WAS ONE OF THEIR HEADQUARTERS, HAVING NO PLACE TO STAY, THEY INVITED ME TO STAY WITH THEM IN THIS OFFICE AREA THEY HAD IN THE BUILDING IN EXCHANGE FOR USE OF MY CAR.

I BECAME ACQUAINTED WITH A NUMBER OF PEOPLE THE LIKE OF WHICH I THOUGHT EXISTED ONLY IN MOVIES. WHEN YOUR ASSASSINATION INVESTIGATION CAME TO LIGHT I RECOGNIZED IMMEDIATELY MANY OF THE FACES AND NAMES AS THOSE I HAD ASSOCIATED WITH FOR OVER TWO MONTHS AND KNEW AS UNPREDICTABLE CHARACTERS.

I MET GUY BANNISTER AND TALKED WITH HIM IN GROUPS A NUMBER OF TIMES - HE EXPLAINED HIMSELF TO BE AN EX FBI MAN WHO WAS RETIRED AND NOT DOING PRIVATE INVESTIGATING. HE HAD SOME KIND OF DELUSIONS OF GRANDEUR ABOUT OBTAINING A HIGH OFFICE IN CUBA AFTER THE CASTRO OVERTHROW. WHEN THE FIRST PLAN FOR INVASION DIDN'T MATERIALIZE (THERE WAS THREE SUCH WHILE I WAS THERE) HE SUGGESTED A WILD SCHEME TO ORGANIZE A "BLACK BRIGADE" OF ANTI COMMUNIST BANDITTS, WHICH WAS TO BE NAMED "BANNISTER'S BASTARDS" AND WERE TO FIGHT SOUTH AND CENTRAL AMERICAN COMMUNIST GUERRILLAS ANYWHERE AND EVERYWHERE, FOR PAY FROM GOVERNMENTS OF COUNTRIES. HE CAME INTO THE OFFICE ALONE MOST OF THE TIME BUT SOMETIMES HE HAD OTHER MEN WITH HIM. THOUGH HIS NATURE WAS NOT NEARLY AS EXPLOSIVE AS THE LATIN'S THERE, SOME OF HIS IDEAS WERE WILD TO SAY THE LEAST. AN INTERESTING POINT... AS WELL AS I CAN REMEMBER HIM, HE LOOKED A GREAT DEAL LIKE THE PICTURES I HAVE SEEN OF CLAY SHAW!

ONE OF THE DISGRUNTLED CUBANS I BECAME ACQUAINTED WITH WAS SERGIO - CAN'T REMEMBER HIS LAST NAME - IT WAS SOMETHING LIKE ARCADIA. HE WAS ALWAYS IMMACULATELY DRESSED IN A BLUE SUIT, WELL SHAVEN AND ALCOF. HE WAS THE CHIEF SPIRIT IN NEW ORLEANS FOR THE ORGANIZATION OF THE INVASION. MOST OF HIS COHORTS WERE EVIDENTLY OF THE SAME SOCIO ECONOMIC LEVEL, USED TO COMMAND AND WANTED THEMSELVES TO BE CHIEF. THEREFORE THEY COULD NOT SEEM TO BE ORGANIZED. I REMEMBER THAT ONE OF HIS PLANS WAS TO HAVE A FLOAT IN THE MARDI GRAS PARADE CONSISTING OF A LARGE CUBAN FLAG -

BED SHEET SIZE - ON A FLOAT BED IN THIS MANNER - ~~SEE BELOW~~ - WITH POINTING SUPERIMPOSED TO THE EFFECT THAT PEOPLE THROW COINS AGAINST THE FLAG WHICH WOULD THEN FALL ONTO THE BED OF THE FLOAT TO BE COLLECTED TO AID IN FREEDING CUBA.

HE, SERGIO - WAS OF AN EXPLOSIVE TEMPERAMENT AND CARED NOT A WHIT FOR ANYONE OTHER THEN HIMSELF AND HIS POSSESSIONS. ON SEVERAL OCCASIONS HE AND DR. JOSE DEL HAYA (THE MOST IMPORTANT FIGURE OF THE GROUP) ALMOST DID BATTLE IN THE OFFICE.

I HAVE HEARD NOTHING OF DR. JOSE DEL HAYA IN YOUR INVESTIGATIONS. HE WAS THE NOBLEST ROMAN OF THEM ALL, WAS SINCERE AND MOST PERSONABLE. HE WAS SLIGHT OF BUILD, ABOUT THIRTY YEARS OF AGE, REFINED, INTELLIGENT AND THE ONLY ONE OF THE GROUP OF PERHAPS TWENTY PEOPLE IN THE GROUP THAT WAS OF VALUE. HE TOLD ME HE HAD BEEN WITH THE STUDENT REVOLT OF 1953 IN CUBA AND WAS SEVERELY WOUNDED. HE FOUGHT WITH CASTRO ON HIS SIDE, BUT DISAGREED WITH HIM POLITICALLY. HE TOLD ME HE WAS SENT TO THE U.S. BY CASTRO AFTER CASTRO'S VICTORY, TO GARNER PUBLIC SUPPORT. HE WAS RECALLED AND IMPRISONED WHEN HE QUESTIONED THE POST REVOLUTION PURGES. HE ESCAPED, CAME TO THE U.S. AND WAS STRIVING TO ATTAIN RECOGNITION BY THE AMERICAN MEDICAL ASSOC. AT THE SOME TIME, HE WAS TRYING TO GET COMPANIES WITH INDUSTRIES WHICH WERE NATIONALIZED BY CASTRO TO CONTRIBUTE FUNDS FOR HIS OVERTHROW. HE WAS A MAN OF PASSION AND COMPASSION DEDICATED TO HIS PEOPLE. THE LAST I HEARD OF HIM, HE WAS IN OKLAHOMA CITY WORKING IN A HOSPITAL. IF YOU KNOW ANYTHING OF HIM, TRY TO FIND HIM. I AM SURE HE KNOWS AND CAN CONTRIBUTE MUCH KNOWLEDGE TO YOUR INVESTIGATION. I DON'T KNOW WHO HE REALLY WAS. I USED TO ACCOMPANY HIM ON SOME STRANGE MISSIONS WHICH HE WOULD NOT EXPLAIN AND AFTER THE CIA TIE WAS EXPOSED AT THE BAY OF PIGS, I BEGAN TO WONDER IF ANY OF THESE PEOPLE WERE REAL.

Betty Parrett suggests this may be one "JIM POOLE"

THERE WAS A ROUST ABOUT WHO CALLED HIMSELF "TIGER" JIM - A FLOATER WHO LIKED TO WEAR A HIRT AND TIE - WAS POTENTIALLY INTELLIGENT BUT COULD NOT BE TRUSTED FOR A MOMENT. HE WAS EVIDENTLY A MAN OF WORDLY EXPERIENCE - HE KNEW PEOPLE IN NEW ORLEANS. HE ALSO CONSIDERED CUBA, AS HE PUT IT, "ONE BIG PIE OF WHICH HE WANTED A SLICE, AND THE REVOLUTION WOULD AFFORD IT".

HE AND A MAN NAMED CHARLIE, WHO SUPPOSEDLY HAD WORKED IN A JEWELRY STORE IN PHILADELPHIA PENN., BUT HAD ONLY SHORTLY BEFORE RETURNED FROM MONTEVIDEO, DEVISED A PLOT WHICH I OVERHEARD IN THE PLANNING (AFTER THE SECOND INVASION IDEA FADED OUT) OF ABSCONDING WITH THE MEDICAL SUPPLIES WHICH HAD BEEN STOCKPILED IN THE OFFICE AND SELLING THE SERINGES AND MORPHINE IN THE FRENCH QUARTER FOR MONEY TO START A CHICKEN FARM IN PERU.... ALONG WITH A SHAGGLE TOOTHED CHARACTER WHO CLAIMED TO BE OF PURE BLOOD CHEROKEE INDIAN, KOREAN WAR VETERAN AND TRUCK MECHANIC, AND WHO WAS SUPPOSEDLY ENGAGED TO MARRY THE DAUGHTER OF A MILLIONAIRE FROM LIMA, PERU. HIS NAME WAS JOSEPH MOORE AND HE GAVE ME THIS ADDRESS IF EVER I WAS IN LIMA, PERU - AV. AREGAIZ, 2798 SAN ISIDRO, LIMA, PERU. I FOUND I STILL HAD THIS ADDRESS IN AN OLD WALLET AND THIS IS HASWELL AS I CAN MAKE OUT HIS WRITING. NOTE: I ALSO JUST FOUND DR. JOSE DEL HAYAS' ADDRESS HE GAVE ME BEFORE LEAVING NEW ORLEANS: DR. JOSE DEL HAYA, C/O GENERAL DELIVERY, NEW ORLEANS, LA. ALSO 1420, 15TH ST. NORTH., ST. PETERSBURG, FLA., AND CONCORDIA 963, HABANA, CUBA.

JOE MOORE WAS TALL - 6 FT. 3 INCHES, THIN AND WEIGHED 175-180 LBS. CHARLIE WAS 5 FT. 8 INCHES, MEDIUM BUILD. BLOND, SHIRT AND TIE TYPE WITH SOME COLLEGE AND A GREAT CAPACITY TO DEAL WITH EXPLOSIVE LATIN NATURES. HIS CLOSEST COHORT WAS A MAN WHO REMINDED ME OF GENE KELLY (ACTOR) IN APPEARANCE BUT WAS MENTALLY BACKWARD. HE CLAIMED TO HAVE JUST ESCAPED TO THE U.S. FROM A PRISON IN VERA CRUIZ, WHERE HE AND SEVERAL CONFEDERATES HAD BEEN IMPRISONED FOR BEING CAUGHT WITH A LOAD OF GUNS

WHICH WERE HEADED FOR GUATEMALA.

THEN THERE WAS BILL WHOEVER HE WAS; HE LOOKED LIKE A POOR MAN'S CLARK GABLE WITH TWENTY EXTRA POUNDS. A THEATRICAL GENERAL WHO LIKED TO SIT BEHIND A DESK WITH PAPERS AND PEN IN HAND WITH OVERLY DRAMATIZED EXPRESSION OF MEDITATION AND CONCERN. HE WANTED TO BE A COMMANDER IN THE FIELD OF THE COUNTER REVOLUTIONARIES AND STOICLY DISREGARD THE PRAISE OF THE FREED MULTITUDE AS HE BORE THE WEIGHT OF THE OFFICE OF FREEDOM, AS LONG AS IT WASN'T DANGEROUS OR REQUIRED NO REAL RESPONSIBILITY. I REMEMBER HE WAS LIVING OFF AND ON WITH A VERY HEAVY BLOND WOMAN IN THE QUARTER WHO WORE WHITE AS IF SHE WERE A NURSE. HER NAME WAS BETTY. SHE ONCE CALLED THE OFFICE AND SAID SHE HAD FOUND A NOTE IN THE GARBAGE CAN INDICATING THAT BILL WAS A DOUBLE AGENT.

A GIRL WHO CLAIMED TO BE FROM COLUMBIA NAMED CHRISTINA CAME INTO THE OFFICE FREQUENTLY, STRUCK A RELATIONSHIP WITH TIGER JIN AND THEY BECAME ENGAGED. SHE WAS A DEVOUT PATRIOT TO LATIN FREEDOM AND STAUNCHLY SUPPORTED THE CASTRO OVERTHROW. HOWEVER, SHE WAS REFINED AND EDUCATED SOMEWHAT AND MOVED THROUGH AT ODD ANGLES IF THAT MAKES SENSE, NOT FITTING AT ALL WITH THE OVERALL EARTHY, CARNAL GROUP TYPE CAST. SHE WAS MORE OF DEL HAYA'S CLASS ... I REMEMBER THAT WE WENT OVER TO VISIT HER ONCE AND ALL EVENING THERE WAS CONVERSATION IN DOUBLE TALK. I AM SURE IT WAS NOT THAT OF SEDUCTION AROUND A THIRD PERSON EITHER.

THERE WAS A FELLOW CALLED ROSIE. HE WAS UNCLEAN, LETHARGIC OF MIND AND LETHAL. THOUGH HE SEEMED DULL EYED AND DULL WITTED, HE WOULD AT THE SAME TIME DO LITTLE THINGS THAT REQUIRED WIT. HE WANTED ME TO GO ON A LITTLE TRIP WITH HIM TO BRAZEL WHERE WE WERE TO PICK UP A QUANTITY OF UN-CUT STONES WHICH WOULD THEN BE DROPPED ON A REEF AT THE EDGE OF U.S. TERRITORIAL WATERS TO BE PICKED UP BY DIVERS AND SHUGGLED INTO THE U.S. WE WOULD SPLIT \$50,000.00 FOR IT. I WAS THE ONLY ONE HE TRUSTED.

ON TWO OCCASIONS, AN ALOOF, REFINED, HANDSOME YOUNG CUBAN CAME IN, WHO WAS NAMED FRANCESCO SOMETHING. HIS FATHER WAS AROUND OFTEN AND HAD FOUGHT FOR CUBAN UNITY AND FREEDOM SEVERAL TIMES. EACH TIME FRANCESCO WAS TO ARRIVE, THERE WAS MUCH HULLABALLOO. MY CAR WAS USED TO PICK HIM UP AT THE AIRPORT.

OF LITTLE VALUE BUT ALWAYS THERE WAS A MENTALLY RETARDED MAN NAMED JERRY.

IN REFERENCE TO ALL THE ABOVE NAMED PEOPLE, I AM SORRY THAT I CANNOT REMEMBER THEIR FULL NAMES, BUT I COULD IDENTIFY MOST OF THEIR PHOTOS AND RECALL MORE DETAILS ON EACH OF THEM AND OTHERS. IF YOU THINK THAT I COULD BE OF HELP, PLEASE WRITE A LETTER TO PLAYBOY MAGAZINE, STATING THAT YOU WOULD LIKE TO TALK WITH THE GUY FROM UP NORTH. I WOULD CONTACT YOU DIRECTLY BUT IT IS TOO DANGEROUS.
