Information has been received by Kansas City to indicate that captioned organization is perhaps gaining some organizational status within this Division. b7c-7a b7D-2a

On February 9, 1971, [redacted] reported conversation among New Left individuals at Lawrence, Kansas, within the past thirty days regarding the probability of a Gay Liberation Front rally at Lawrence. (S) (u)

Additionally, on February 17, 1971, The Maneater, campus publication at the University of Missouri, Columbia, Missouri, publicized a meeting of the Gay Liberation Front at Columbia where sixty to seventy people were in attendance.

In the June 1970 issue of the FBI publication, The Extremist Speaks, a representative of the Gay Liberation Front at New Haven, Connecticut, was quoted as saying in part, "We demand that you treat us as revolutionaries..."

UACB, Kansas City is instituting sufficient inquiry through established sources to determine the degree of New Left influence on the Gay Liberation Front in this Division and whether further active investigation appears warranted.

Re Bureau letter to Kansas City dated 3/17/71.

From a review of information received from many established sources and confidential informants, it has been determined there is a lack of basis to show New Left affiliation with the Gay Liberation Front.

Further investigation is not justified since sources indicate group is primarily interested in homosexual activities and the rights of homosexuals. There is no indication of clear cut leadership of this loosely knit group of homosexuals.

It does not appear that dissemination is warranted in view of the negative information received to date, therefore, this matter is being closed in Kansas City.
