




Their egress to the National Convention in Miami will be through the Gay Political Caucus which meets at the Village Independent Democratic Club, Sheridan Square, NYC.





On December 3, 1970, advised that a number of posters had been put up on the San Diego State College (SDSC) campus which read as follows:

"San Diego's First Gay-In, Sunday, December 13th (1970), Presidio Park, Eucalyptus Grove From Noon til? Sponsored by the Gay Liberation Front of San Diego, telephone 582-3387."

On December 10, 1970, advised that the Gay Liberation Front (GLF) held a "Gay-In" at Presidio Park in the Eucalyptus Grove on December 19, 1970, and further advised that the "Gay-In" was open to the public and advised that a permit had been issued by the San Diego Park and Recreation Department for a picnic to be held by the GLF.

GLF is a member organization of Community Congress of San Diego and is self-described as an organization representing the homophile community; it seeks to provide information and enlighterment about the goals and programs of this minority group and to educate the uninformed.

This document contains neither recommendations nor conclusions of the FBI. It is the property of the FBI and is loaned to your agency; it and its contents are not to be distributed outside your agency.

The December 8, 1970, edition of the "Daily Aztec", a campus newspaper of SDSC contained a letter to the editor which protested the tearing down of GLF posters on the SDSC campus by various unknown individuals. The letter stated that the GLF met on Tuesday at 7:30 PM at the Presidential Suite Aztec Center on SDSC campus. The article was signed by a JIM OBERLE, Vice President of GLF, SDSC Chapter.

In an article from the "Daily Martec", dated March 19, 1970, a representative of the GLF Chapter at SDSC was quoted as saying that the "GLF hopes to promote communications between homosexuals and heterosexual students."

An article from the "Daily Aztec," dated November 16, 1971, stated that group encounter sessions sponsored jointly by the Experimental College and the GLF would begin at 7:30 PM, Tuesday, November 30. The announcement was made by STEVE BELL, a GLF spokesman who stated that the sessions were open to all students.

h2-1 070-1

On October 1, 1971, advised that the GLF was not included on the official list of approved campus organizations at the University of California at San Diego (UCSD) and further advised that no chapter was in existence at UCSD.

h2-1 h7D-1

On October 14, 1971, advised that the GLF was not approved as an official campus organization at SDSC.

h2-1 b70-1

On November 22, 1971, advised that the GLF held a demonstration in front of the San Diego Police Department on November 22, 1971, to protest harassment of the "Gay People" by the San Diego Police Department. Source advised that the demonstration was covered by local news media and described the demonstration as peaceful with no unusual incidents occurring.

Source further advised that the GLF of San Diego maintains its headquarters at 906 North 47th Street, San Diego, California, and that this address is the location of the Chollas View Methodist Church and a "Good Neighbor Center" which is part of the Methodist Church.

The December 31, 1971 - January 6, 1972, issue of the Berkeley Tribe", a new left underground type newspaper published at Berkeley, California, contained a letter from STEVE BELL, President, San Diego Gay Liberation Front (SDGLF), requesting all gay organizations intending to attend the Republican National Convention to communicate with the SDGLF with a view toward unifying and merging projected activity into a coherent whole and at the same time swelling the numbers involved. Gay organizations were requested to inform the SDGLF by January 10, 1972, in order that definite plans could be laid out far enough in advance of their implementation to assure their effectiveness.

On February 11, 1972 advised that STEVE BELL attended a meeting of the Committee to Investigate Right Ming Terrorism (CIRT) on February 6, 1972, at SDSC and further advised that BELL stated that CIRT had the support of the GLF and further advised that BELL stated he would not be able to attend a CIRT meeting next Sunday because he was attending a demonstration in Chicago.

The Committee to Investigate Right Wing
Terrorism is a committee of the San Diego
Convention Coalition a group formed to oppose
the Republican National Convention in August,
1972, and is charged with the investigation
of all activities of Right Wing Organizations
in the San Diego area and investigation concerning
facilities and operational plans of all law
enforcement agencies in the San Diego area
including the FBI.

On February 1, 1972, advised that at a meeting of the San Diego Convention Coalition (SDCC) on January 29, 1972, at 5717 Lindo Paseo, San Diego, California, a representative of the GLF was in attendance and was identified only as BILL (LNU). No further description of "BILL" was available. Source also advised on January 26, 1972, that BILL (LNU) was also in attendance at a meeting of the SDCC on January 22, 1972, at 5717 Lindo Paseo.

The SDCC is a group comprised of representatives of various radical groups in San Diego, California, which was formed for active opposition to the United States government through "serious, determined, and long-term social upheaval."

The February 24 - March 9, 1972, issue of the "Door", a new left type underground newspaper published in San Diego, contained an article stating that the San Diego Branch of the GLF held a press conference on the steps of the San Diego Sports Arena on February 14, 1972. The conference was called so that the GLF could announce their intentions of having demonstrations for the 1972 GOP Convention. Not one representative of the news media showed up.

On March 10, 1972, devised that an organizational membership list of the Community Congress of San Diego includes the GLF of San Diego. The Community Congress organization list also contains a description of the GLF which states that it is "an organization representing the homophile community; it seeks to provide information and enlightenment about the goals and programs of this minority group and to educate the uninformed."







II. CONNECTIONS WITH SUBVERSIVE ORGANIZATIONS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES

An article from the "Daily Aztec", a student publication at San Diego State College (SDSC), San Diego, California, on March 19, 1970, reported that subject was a representative of the Gay Liberation Front (GLF) at San Diego State College.

Gay Liberation Front is a member organization of Community Congress of San Diego and is self-described as an organization representing the homophile community; it seeks to provide information and enlightenment about the goals and programs of this minority group and to educate the uninformed.

The December 31, 1971, to January 6, 1972, issue of the "Berkeley Tribe", a New Left underground type newspaper published at Berkeley, California, contained a letter from STEVE BELL, described as President of the San Diego Gay Liberation Front. In this letter, subject requested all Gay organizations who had plans to attend the Republican National Convention, originally scheduled to be held in San Diego, California, in August, 1972, to communicate with the San Diego Chapter of the Gay Liberation Front in order to unify and merge projected activity into a coherent whole, and at the same time, greatly increasing the number of people involved in the Convention. The letter further requested Gay organizations to inform the San Diego Gay Liberation Front (SDGLF), not later than January 10, 1972, in order that definite plans could be laid out far enough in advance of their implementation to assure their effectiveness.

STEPHEN BAXTER BELL SECURITY MATTER -SUBVERSIVE

Subject was reported to have attended a meeting of the Committee to Investigate Right Wing Terrorism (CIRT) on February 6, 1972, at San Diego State College. It was reported that subject stated that the CIRT had the support of the Gay Liberation Front and further stated that he would not be able to attend a CIRT meeting scheduled for next Sunday because he was attending a demonstration in Chicago, Illinois.

The Committee to Investigate Right Wing Terrorism is a committee of the San Diego Convention Coalition (SDCC), a group formed to oppose the Republican National Convention in August, 1972, and is charged with the investigation of all activities of Right Wing Organizations in the San Diego area and investigation concerning facilities and operational plans of all law enforcement agencies in the San Diego area, including the FBI.

The San Diego Convention Coalition (SDCC) is a group comprised of representatives of various radical groups in San Diego, California, which was formed for active opposition to the United States Government through "serious, determined, and long-term social upheaval."

Subject was identified as attending a meeting of the San Diego Convention Coalition on February 6, 1972, at which time subject indicated support of the San Diego Convention

Coalition by the San Diego Gay Liberation Front, and further identified himself as President of the Gay Liberation Front in San Diego, California.



On June 29, 1972, a source who is in a position to receive the information, furnished an information leaflet entitled "Help Make a Gay Presence at the Democratic Convention"; a copy of this leaflet is attached.

This leaflet, printed by the National Coalition of Gay Organizations of Washington, D. C., contains a map of two carawan routes covering the country and ending in Miami, Florida, on July 10, 1972. Further, the leaflet explains that the caravan will stop as indicated at the various Greyhound Bus Stations and that they (the homosexuals) have received excellent cooperation from the Greyhound authorities. A source in a position to furnish reliable information advised June 29, 1972, that Steven Mann of the National Coalition of Gay Organizations had contacted the Greyhound Lines regarding the chartering of two buses for July 9, 1972, to travel to Miami. However, source related no firm commitment has been made to date to Greyhound regarding the charter. Source was not in a position to furnish information regarding charters of other Greyhound buses in other cities.




