A review of WFO files indicate the above caption was recently utilized by WFO as a means of reporting proposed travel by various homosexual groups or individuals to Miami, Florida in connection with MIDEAM and MIREP.

Regarding the existence of a GLF branch at Washington, D.C. (WDC), the following is noted. On 9/12/72 [redacted] advised that a branch of the GLF has not been reported to exist at WDC since approximately January 1972, at which time the GLF consisted of an ad hoc group of homosexuals living at 1620 S Street, N.W. WDC. In fact, at that time the GLF described itself as having neither leaders nor by-laws.

WFO sources have been canvassed in an attempt to ascertain whether a branch of the GLF is presently organized at WDC. While sources are cognizant of the activity of homosexuals working for the recognition of "gay rights", there has been no indication that a GLF branch is presently engaged in subversive activity at WDC.

Considering the above, captioned matter is being placed in a closed status and any subversive activity on the part of homosexuals at WDC will be reported under a separate, more suitable individual or organizational caption.
