Gay Liberation Organizes Group In Pxford Area

TITUE:

Gay People of Oxford held its second meeting at Together House last Thursday, April 3.

"The movement came about on this campus in March because a few people decided to get that heads together," explained Larry Mart member.

The group inclues males and females, students, professors, and Oxford residents.

"Our emphasis is similar to that of Gay Liberation-consciousness raising. We are somewhat related to women's lib because both are trying to get rid of sexual roles. Even though 15 attended the meeting, that is no real indication of the number involved, hecause most people here are probably exually oppressed.

As Paul Goodman and, gay is anyone who is not straight—exclusively heterosexual. Gay is sexually free. Most people are not totally heterosexual or homosexual," Matt stated.

Achieving recognition as a student group and activities for Gay Pride Week, May 15-21 are planned.

"I would like to see something done here such as showing films and speaking to classes. This type of education is needed," said Matt.

A library containing information about homosexuality, including books of fiction is another group plan.

"Thus far, our purpose has been to educate and liberate ourselves. This is necessary because society has taught us it is bad to be homosexual. This hate and guilt and criminality is internalized and hidden. Gay people who do have these feelings of contempt and inferiority must get over it," commented Matt.

According to Matt, the gay movement began in spring 1967 at Columbia University. This set the precedent for Gay Liberation Front, which became attached to other groups such as the war and black movements. Because the gay movement received nothing in return, Gay Antisists Ministre began.

The following is submitted to indicated files which was not included in teletypes submitted in connection with captioned demonstration.

Observation of Washington Park determined that participants in the rally and march began arriving at about 11:00 A.M. with the crowd slowly gathering until approximately 12:30 when a musical group began playing in the band shell. ROGLE BREWIN was observed giving tracts and instructions to people arriving and appeared to be in charge.

At approximately 12:45 DREWIN began speaking over a loudspeaker giving instructions concerning the rally and march and then introduced a series of speakers, each of whom was introduced as representing a particular

DOROTHY MC LEAN or MC CLAIN, representing Women's International League for Peace and Freedom.

NANCY HORN, from Miami University, representing Women's Liberation.

ROBERT WRIGHT, Publisher, Community Catalyst News Letter.

ROBERT GRAY, representing the Cincinnati Gay Community.

D. or T. OSBORNE, representing the Young Workers Liberation League.

MIKE CILLIAM or GILLAM representing Vietnam Veterans Against the War.

GILLIAM was introduced as a former Marine, who stated he had seen atrocities such as North Vietnamese persons being skinned alive, the bombing of children and other civilians and the willful execution of civilians by U. S. Soldiers.

GARY ETAIGER was introduced as the Regional Coordinator of VVAW, who had just returned from Paris. STAIGER spoke briefly commenting that he and others from VVAU, whom he did not name; had talked at length with representatives of North Vietnam and the People's Republic of South Vietnam and stated that the only reason the war in Vietnam continued was because the U.S. refused to enter into true negotiation.

Following the speeches FREWIN gave instructions concerning the march and the marchers picked up placards stacked beside the band shell. Marchers then proceeded South on Race Street accompanied by a police department escort at the front and the rear of the parade to Fifth Street where they turned East and marched on to Fountain Square. After arriving at Fountain Square, a group of young men wearing portions of military uniforms representing VVAW conjucted a "Guerille Theater" wherein they

marched in close order drill briefly and then proceeded to run around in circles with their arms outstretched using noises to simulate airplanes. They ran around powersi young women who had seated themselves on the avoignt wearing "coolie" hats. The girls acreamed and rolled over pretending to be dead and then were carried away by the VVAM members who conducted a "body count."
