# Gay Liberation organizes

"Gay brothers and sisters, WAKE UP! We will be victims no longer—we will have our freedom."

In this statement, Barry Zelikovsky, non-student, is addressing the homosexual population, that significant sector of society which is considered sick and abnormal by so many people.

Zelikovsky is currently organizing the formation of a chapter of the Gay Liberation Front (GLF) in the Santa Barbara community, Isla Vista is particular.

According to Zelikovsky, there is a "good, healthy

homosexual contingent in Isla Vista that is ready to come out and liberate itself from the oppression of which it has been a victim for so long.

Isla Vista was chosen as the site for the organization of a new GLF chapter because, in Zelikovsky's opinion, the community is a counter-culture whose members are more accepting of life styles that differ from the norm.

Zelikovsky spoke of former homosexual movements stating that their aims and those of the GLF are the same, however, the tactics of GLF differ. Whereas the goal of the former groups was to end legal discrimination towards homosexuals, the GLF has as its primary aim personal liberation for the homosexual.

Elaborating on this topic, Zelikovsky used himself as an example describing the liberating feeling he experienced when he "came out of hiding" and proclaimed his homosexuality to the outside world.

Contributing to this feeling, according to Zelikovsky, is the fact that the GLF is already making progress. As well as achieving liberation on a personal basis, the GLF is having success in eradicating institutional prejudices against homosexuals. In such instances, Zelikovsky

claims that homosexuals are speaking up and are using the support of the American Constitution and lawyers to defend themselves.

The ultimate goal of GLF is total acceptance of the homosexual by society. In

Zelikovsky's words, "Our GLF would be founded on the belief that homosexuality is a natural form of human expression and should not be suppressed. Each person should be able to enjoy his or her own sexuality without feelings of guilt or inferiority."

Zelikovsky is well aware of the great amount of time and effort that will be necessary to reach this goal. In his opinion, it will involve changing the educational process so as to prevent students of all ages from being misinformed by teachers and books about homosexuality.

The GLF will have its first organizational meeting this Friday, Nov. 6 at 7:30 p.m. in the I.V. Community Service Building, Suite F. Zelikovsky expects the meeting to be well attended, however he feels that many homosexuals will be hesitant to attend due to fear of publicity.

Zelikovsky reminds this fearful faction that "the gay population has a choice — either it can be closeted, afraid and inhibited or it can proclaim its freedom among brothers and sisters who care."

One of the factors leading to Zelikovsky's prediction of a large attendance at GLF's first meeting is the many phone calls he has received since the meeting was first publicized. He claims to have received numerous phone calls of support from the campus dormitories and all over the Santa Barbara community.

In discussing GLF's future needs, Zelikovsky

**SYNOPSIS**

1. Requester desired investigation based upon receipt of a letter written on the letterhead of the GAY LIBERATION FRONT OF LOS ANGELES (GLFLA), requesting Subj be given an honorable discharge from the Navy, in view of being a homosexual. Upon interrogation, Subj denied any pre-service acts, other than kissing a neighbor boy as a youth. He denied any acts with service personnel and declined to name any individuals outside of the military with whom he had engaged in such activity. Subj did indicate that he had resided with one individual while on authorized liberties but would not provide his full name. Subj additionally admitted association with members of the GLFLA and of attending meetings of this organization. Subj had met all of these individuals through his religious affiliation with the First Unitarian Church of Los Angeles. Subj declined to make a written statement or further discuss his homosexual involvement without consulting with GLFLA. When Subj was unable to make telephonic contact with same, the interrogation was terminated. Subj was re-interrogated the following day, and upon GLFLA advice, would make a statement, however he had been told not to further discuss his homosexual experiences and limit the content of his statement to information provided the previous day. Subj declined to permit a search of his personal effects.

**PREDICATION**

2. Investigation was predicated upon the request of the Commanding Officer, UES DE LAYEN (DD-727), of 29 Oct 1970.

**CONTACT WITH COMMAND**

3. Command advised that investigation was desired after receipt of attachment (1), a letter received from the GAY LIBERATION FRONT OF LOS ANGELES (GLFLA), requesting Subj be separated from the Naval Service, based upon his proclaimed homosexuality. Subj, prior to receipt of reference (a), had not provided any reason to question his moral conduct or had he made it known to any member of the command that he was homosexual. In view of this correspondence, Subj access to classified material was immediately terminated.

**INTERROGATION OF SUBJ**

4. On 29 Oct 1970, Subj, following appropriate warning, was interviewed at WLCRA Long Beach by the reporting Agent. Subj stated he presently considers himself to be a homosexual, however did not realize this at

the time he enlisted in the Navy. Subj stated that when he was in his early teens he developed a "crush" on a neighbor boy. One day while wrestling with him, he kissed him on the cheek several times before the other boy pushed him away. He said that other than kissing him, he made no other physical approach to him.

5. Subj denied any pre-service homosexual activity. He claimed that his homosexual drives during Recruit Training and ID School were overshadowed by academic pressures. When assigned to a Long Beach based ship, being of the Unitarian faith, he began attending services at the First Unitarian Church, in Los Angeles, California, whenever possible. He mentioned that he began living with an individual identified as who lived in the vicinity of Eighth Street and Fidora, Los Angeles, in order to be located close to the church. Subj declined to furnish any further identifying information concerning this individual and when he ultimately consented to make a signed statement, attachment (2), declined to include any mention of this person.

6. Through his attendance at church activities, he said he became closely acquainted with one *b7c-5a* who later openly announced he was homosexual and joined the GLFLA. Through his association with *b7c-5a* Subj said he too began attending GLFLA meetings and became acquainted with various people and the work of the GLFLA. It was only at this time that he came to realize himself to be homosexual.

7. Subj stated with increased pressures on him as a homosexual in the Navy, he sought the assistance of the GLFLA himself, discussing his problem with *b7c-5a, d*. Subj acknowledged that he furnished the majority of the information contained in attachment (1), which was later prepared on GLFLA letterhead, with extensive distribution. He identified *b7c-5a* as being the Chairman of the Military Counseling Section of the GLFLA, but would not further discuss this individual or his activities.

8. Subj refused to name any individuals with whom he had engaged in homosexual activity without first contacting a member of the GLFLA. Subj was provided a private office and telephone for this purpose. After placing a call to an unknown telephone number, Subj stated that he had not been able to reach his party however he had been able to contact another individual who would relay his message, and have the individual call him back. Approximately thirty-two minutes later, Subj received a telephone call. After taking this call, Subj stated he had initially called *b7c-5a*, attempting to speak with *b7c-5a*. He said *b7c-5a* had returned his call stating he had not been able to contact *b7c-5a* and cautioned

Subj not to make any further verbal statements or make a written statement, without clearing with *b7c-5a* or other CLIA officials.

9. Subj stated that he had arranged to contact *b7c-5a* later that evening and desired to terminate the interview. Subj declined to grant the reporting Agent permission to conduct a search of his personal effects.

10. On 30 Oct 1970, again following appropriate warning was interrogated at NISRA Long Beach. At the outset, Subj stated he would furnish no information in addition to that furnished the previous day on the advice of *b7c-5a*. He said that he had talked with *b7c-5a* the previous evening and had been counseled not to discuss any homosexual activity since entering the Navy. He was told that he could state that he had not engaged in any homosexual acts with other naval personnel, but could not discuss his activities with civilians while in the Navy.

11. Subj's signed sworn statement is attachment (2). Subj again declined to permit a search of his personal effects.

**SERVICE RECORD CHECK**

12. On 29 Oct 1970, Subj's enlisted Service Record was reviewed. It was noted that a satisfactory National Agency Check (NAC) was completed on Subj on 6 Feb 1969. Subj was granted a SECRET clearance based on the NAC on 2 Sep 1969. As indicated supra, Subj's access to SECRET material was revoked by the command, upon receipt of attachment (1). No additional pertinent information was noted.

Sirs:

1. b7c-5a has sought out the Gay Liberation Front of Los Angeles for assistance in arranging his immediate separation from the United States Naval Service. Sailor b7c-5a enlisted in the U.S. Navy 13 September 1968, began active duty 13 January 1969. His recruit training was at the United States Naval Training Station, Great Lakes, Illinois. Later he attended Radaman "A" School at Great Lakes, from March, 1969, graduating August, 1969.

Since that training assignment he has done duty on the U.S.S. Dynamic (MSO-432), and is now stationed on the U.S.S. DeHaven (00-727).

2. During his military service Sailor b7c-5a has served efficiently, loyally, and with excellent personal conduct record. He has never been court martialed, brought for Captain's Mast, or placed on report.

3. Now Sailor b7c-5a has asked our entry into this matter as Advocates. Our goal is to protect the civil liberties, civil rights and human rights of homosexual men and women. This we have been able to do in many creative, legal and non-violent ways.

b7c-5a request is based upon his proclaimed homosexuality, and strong Department of Defense and Naval Regulations regulating such conduct.

4. His statement to us is: "Since coming into the Navy, I have discovered that I am a homosexual. I didn't realize this at the time I enlisted-it was something I now realize I wouldn't admit to myself because of the social stigma attached to homosexuality. With constant contact with other sailors in the Navy, I began to feel more and more pressure

on myself, especially during extended periods at sea, and I finally come to realize and accept the fact that I am a homosexual.

I am aware that homosexuals are not wanted in the service and that homosexual acts constitute a court martial offense, and because of the increasing emotional and mental pressures I am facing, I request assistance from *b7c-5a* and the Gay Liberation Front in securing a discharge."

5. We are keenly aware of military regulations proscribing such behavior and have repeatedly asked that all such regulations be abolished as being irrelevant to life in the United States today, are more than hypocritical since homosexual acts are common in the Military Service, and work a hardship on loyal members, who would otherwise like to serve. In a civilian surrounding Sailor *b7c-5a* would not be under the rigid regulations and directives set forth by the Department of Defense and the Navy. He would be able to lead an active and productive life as a civilian without the total male atmosphere and environment that the Navy forces him to live in--forcing him to be in constant jeopardy.

Once again we ask that these primitive and Puritanical regulations be abolished.

6. Therefore, we ask that *b7c-5a, d* be honorably discharged, and at the earliest possible time from the United States Naval Service.

7. In *b7c-5a* case, we shall have to make a demand that we have not previously made; We have had many disgusting reports of mistreatment of proclaimed homosexuals in the military service. In all fairness, we must say that no such reports have come in on the United States Navy in a long time. However we have had reports to the fact that if a serviceman is a homosexual, it has been announced on the microphone to entire commands; servicemen requesting discharges have been incarcerated, in violation of the law; such potential discharges have in some cases been handed over to other servicemen and prison inmates to be criminally assaulted; in one uncommonly sickening case, an applicant was brought into a room where a member of the security force demanded that he commit oral copulation on him "to prove that you're queer". A few years ago we had to suffer such indignities in silence; we are no longer silent and will not allow such criminal acts against any member of the homosexual community.

Therefore, we suggest that *b7c-5a* be relieved of duty aboard the U.S.S. DeHaven, sent to the casual company while awaiting adjudication, and that an Honorable Discharge be granted him at the earliest possible time, that he might come into the city and seek civilian employment.

MILITARY SUSPECT'S ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND WAIVER OF RIGHTS

I, b7c-5a,d have been advised  
by Special Agent(s) b7c-2 that I am  
suspected of homosexual conduct.  
I have also been advised:

- (1) That I have the right to remain silent and make no statement at all;
- (2) That any statement I do make may be used as evidence against me in a trial by Court-Martial;
- (3) That I have the right to consult with a lawyer prior to any questioning. This lawyer may be a <sup>civilian</sup> lawyer retained by me at my own expense; or, if I wish, Navy b7c-5a authority will appoint a military lawyer to act as my counsel without cost to me;
- (4) That I have the right to have such retained civilian lawyer or appointed military lawyer present during this interview;
- (5) That I have the right to terminate this interview at any time for any reason.

I understand my rights as related to me and as set forth above. With that understanding, I have decided that I do not desire to consult with either a civilian or a military lawyer at this time and I do not desire to have such a lawyer present during this interview. I make this decision freely and voluntarily and it is made with no threats having been made or promises extended to me.

I was born on b7c-5c I am a male, Caucasian, single, b7c-5c lbs., with b7c-5c hair and b7c-5c eyes. I attended 12 years of school and am a high school graduate. My Social Security Number is b7c-5c. I enlisted in the USNR on 19 September 1968 and served until 13 Jan 1969 and went on active duty on 14 January 1969. I am presently assigned to USS DE HAVEN (DD-727), having reported aboard for duty on 20 June 1970. I was previously attached to USS DYNAMIC (MSO-432).

At the present time I consider myself to be homosexual. I didn't realize

this at the time I call it. It was something I now realize I wouldn't admit to myself because of the social stigma attached to homosexuality.

I first began to realize that I had a "crush" on the boy next door when I was in the Eighth Grade of school. I felt that since I knew other boys that had this same tendency and were not homosexual, that I was not homosexual. While wrestling one day with him, I kissed him a couple of times on the cheek and he pushed me away. I never attempted anything else with him from that time on. Other than kissing him, I made no other physical approach to him.

During high school I never dated much and ~~with anyone~~ when I did date it was for social reasons, such as attending a dance, but not for sexual reasons.

As a youth, I was hitch-hiking South to Florida, for adventure, and was picked up by a truck driver. While in his company he asked me if he could blow me, by which he meant, take my penis in his mouth. I was repulsed by this advance as he was a fat colored truck driver. I asked him to stop and let me out which he did.

Prior to entering the Navy, I never engaged in any homosexual acts with anyone. I feared the legal and social stigma of becoming involved in such activity, subconsciously. My parents drilled it into me that homosexuality was a psychological mental problem as I grew up.

After entering the Navy I attended Boot Camp and then went to RD School. During both the pressures of training overshadowed any sexual tendencies or feelings I had. After completion of school, I was assigned to duty aboard USS DYNAMIC (SSD-432). Once aboard, during long periods at sea and in close quarters with an all male environment, I began to feel increasing pressure. I ~~couldn't~~ couldn't admit to myself that I was a homosexual however at the same time began to feel an attraction toward some of my crewmembers. Although I had these ~~feelings~~ feelings, I made no advances to anyone aboard ship.

I joined USS DYNAMIC overseas and it sailed back to Long Beach, California, three days later. Once back in Long Beach, in order to meet new people, I started going to the First Unitarian Church in Los Angeles, California, which is my church. My parents are also members of the same church in Baltimore, Maryland. While attending church in Los Angeles, I met various people. One of these people was *b7c-5a* who was also a member of the church. When I first met him, I didn't know he was a homosexual. I associated with him and others whom I had met through the church and in May 1970, he declared himself a homosexual and became a member of the Gay Liberation Front in Los Angeles. Through my association with *b7c-5a* I came to realize that I was a homosexual, and in the months that followed went to several Gay Liberation Front meetings and became familiar with various people and work of the Gay Liberation Front.

In view of the increasing pressures on me as a homosexual in the Navy, I went to the Gay Liberation Front to gain assistance in gaining a discharge from the Navy. I talked about this with *b7c-5a* who had me discuss this with *b7c-5a* the head of the Gay Liberation Front in Los Angeles. From there, I made a formal request in writing to the Gay Liberation front for a assistance. As a result of this request, they prepared a letter which was sent to my Commanding Officer as well as seven other U.S. Government

agencies. I was allowed to read a copy of this letter before it was mailed.

I have been asked to relate and make a statement relative to my homosexual activities. I would like to state that these do not include homosexual acts with any members of the armed services. I do not wish to make any statement concerning my homosexual activities outside of the Navy. I do this on the advice of my civilian counsel.

In view of the above, I would like to request an honorable discharge from the Navy as soon as possible.

The above statement, consisting of this and two additional pages, was prepared for me by *b7c-2* in my presence. I have read this statement, understand it, and have initialed all errors. I have also been offered an opportunity to make any corrections or changes I so desire.

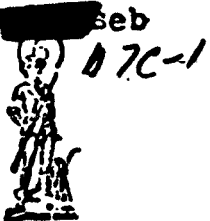



After the Hilton Happening, Don Kilhefner, GLF community organizer, briefly discussed several of the Gay Liberation Front's criticisms of the "Position Statement on Homosexuality and Mental Illness."

"The NAMH defined homosexuality entirely within a context of criminality and deviate behavior. The words "love" and "human affection" were never once mentioned in the statement. Who gave the NAMH the right to establish the definition of our being? No longer will the gay community stand by passively and allow honko straights to tell us who we are. Homosexuals are now defining their own humanity."

Kilhefner continued: "Yes, some of our people are sick—just as some heterosexuals are sick. But it is not mental illness from which gays suffer, but oppression sickness. Professionals don't want to talk about oppression sickness, however, because they are the CAUSE and not the cure."

Kilhefner also remarked, "During the five years the NAMH report on homosexuality was in preparation, not a single gay person was consulted about the contents of the statement. From our gay intelligence system within the NAMH it has also been discovered that the Los Angeles Gay Liberation Front was recently listed in a confidential inter-office memo as a "high risk" group. What's a "high risk" group? Does it mean we ask too many questions about your magic and can't be coerced into obedience by threat of exposure or incarceration in mental institutions? Let it be clear to our oppressors: any time the problems or fate of the gay community is being discussed, the Gay Liberation Front will be there, whether we're invited or not. Gay people are not in concentration camps yet. Straights will deal with us either openly and honestly, or by direct confrontation—but they will deal with us on our terms."

Kilhefner concluded, "The convoluted sexism and basic ignorance of the NAMH was woefully apparent throughout the 'Position Statement.' In what purported to be an official policy statement on homosexuality, gay women were completely ignored. How's that for a super freak-out? Five years of work and no reference whatsoever to gay women.

"The biggest fraud, however, that the NAMH tried to peddle in its statement," Kilhefner stated, "was its support for legalizing 'homosexual contact committed in private between consenting adults.' Gays must not allow themselves to be tricked by this liberal shibboleth. The "consenting adults" law is "one of the biggest shuck and jives of all time," Kilhefner continued. "It gives the illusion that progress is being made when in fact it doesn't even begin to deal with the real problems of police repression in the gay community. The 'consenting adults' law must be exposed for the sham it is: during the past 20 years only two gays were arrested in California for homosexual relations in the privacy of their homes. The 'consenting adults' law would have benefited a grand total of TWO gays during the last 20 years. Isn't that something to get excited over! The real problems of the gay community — illegal entrapment by the vice pigs and police harassment and brutality against gays—are never even touched by the 'consenting adults' law that the NAMH is righteously pushing as the solution to the 'homosexual problem' in America. Illinois has had a 'consenting adults' law since 1962, and the brutalization of gays there by the pigs remains as strong as before."

Kilhefner also feels the NAMH is fucked because "it doesn't recognize the sexuality of 'children.' The Gay Liberation Front supports legalizing sexual relations between any 'consenting PERSONS' regardless of age. We all know it's happening anyway."

**GAYS CRASH HILTON**

**'Some of our people are sick'**

On Friday afternoon, November 20, thirty members of the Gay Liberation Front forced their way into the Grand Ballroom of the Hilton Hotel in downtown Los Angeles and caused the temporary adjournment of a closed executive business session of the National Association for Mental Health. The militant gays were protesting the NAMH's "Position Statement on Homosexuality and Mental Illness" which was being considered for adoption. During the five years the paper had been in preparation, not a single homosexual had been consulted concerning the contents of the statement.

Several days prior to the convention Gay Liberationists had been rebuffed in their attempts to secure time on the program in order to open dialogue on the "Position Statement" between the delegates and the gay community. Brian O'Connell, NAMH's Executive Secretary, responded: "You should be thankful for what we're giving you. . . . your movement will be set back ten years if you try to oppose us." So much for the "proper channels." Direct action was needed.

When the gay militants arrived at the entrance to the funky Grand Ballroom they were met by a phalanx of nervous security guards that refused to allow their admittance. "Sorry, you can't go in there!" "Why not? They're talking about me and my sisters and brothers. Our fate is being discussed, and we only want to participate in that discussion." "It's a business meeting for officially authorized persons only. You can't go in!" "Why don't all those old people in there want to talk to thirty happy homosexuals? Why are they afraid of us?"

Apparently stymied, the G.I. Fers withdrew from the entrance to the ballroom. Shazam! Gay Power to the Rescue! A gay employee (we're everywhere, honkie!) called the group into a corner and informed his militant sisters and brothers that a kitchen adjoining the ballroom had been left unguarded. A wild dash through the kitchen, and the gays were in the executive-business-session-for-officially-authorized-professionals-only meeting.

"We demand to be heard!"

The mental health automatons are freaked! Pandemonium breaks out.

"Your position statement is full of lies and myths. Open your heads!"

Gay Liberationists now line the stage.

"Don't be afraid to talk to homosexuals as equals. Gay people have something important to teach you."

Much banging of the gavel. Trembling honko voice: "This meeting is adjourned . . . everyone please leave the hall immediately . . . everyone please leave the hall."

"Don't run away! We op't take revenge on you right now for all the misery and self-hate you've caused our people."

As the Grand Ballroom was emptied, the gay militants rapped with the delegates and handed out leaflets explaining their objections to the NAMH report. Meanwhile, word had reached the G.I. Fers that the LAPD was on its way into the hotel, and the sisters and brothers decided to vanish in order to fight again another day.

Later in the day when the convention reconvened again, the delegates intelligently declined to vote on the "Position Statement" until more study was done on the entire question. One brave delegate even had the courage to question the NAMH leadership as to why there was no provision for "the people" to be heard at these meetings. Right On! Gay Power wins another one.

# Gays under Christ

"Getting Our Thing Together" is the theme of a conference planned for people whose sexual orientation is gay and whose religious orientation is liberal.

On Saturday, December 12, at the First Unitarian Church of Los Angeles, these gay religious liberals will consider a variety of topics for the purpose of determining what kind of continuing association they want.

Unitarian Minister Richard Nash claims that "homosexuals are the most seriously discriminated against group in the churches and synagogues. It is made clear to them that they are welcome as (most) human beings, but not as homosexuals. This is in contrast to heterosexuals, whose sexual love, marriage, and child bearing are celebrated by the church. Almost without exception, a gay person has to ignore or deny a very significant part of his being in order to participate in the lives of these institutions."

How to deal with this situation is the challenge for the participants of the conference. Large numbers of homosexuals, in the face of discrimination, have simply left the church altogether. But many would like the opportunity to relate honestly and meaningfully to the life of their church or synagogue.

Also on the organizing committee for the day's event is Floyd Hof, who has openly identified himself within his church. However, he feels that it usually takes a great deal of courage even to make that move. "To get it together with others is easier than to step out alone," he explained. "This is the importance of the conference now. If we make plans together, it will be easier for each of us individually. Perhaps we'll want to form an interdenominational religious gay caucus or caucuses in each of the denominations to push for progress, as the blacks did."

While all people are welcome, the planning committee has ~~limited~~ publicity to people who are both gay and religious liberals. The objective is more an organizing meeting for gays than an educational opportunity for straights. Rev. Ted Callaway, Episcopal member of the Liberal Religious Conference Committee, emphasized the interdenominational hopes for the meetings. "We want to attract religious persons of any denomination who think of themselves as liberal," he said.

The all-day Saturday party will give participants the chance to get to know each other. They will see guerrilla theater, and there will be workshops devoted to a range of concerns of the gay community. Then in the evening, at Troupers Hall in Hollywood, a dance will cap the full day. The entire gay community of Los Angeles is invited to the dance. With this move the organizers want to show their solidarity with all gay brothers and sisters.

Conference participants are being asked to register in advance and to select their preferences for workshops from the following topics: Homosexuality; Sickness or ties; Developing a Gay Culture with Alternatives; Gay Relationships; Alternatives; Gay Relationships; Bisexuality; Discrimination Among Homosexuals; Special Problems of the Lesbian; Heterosexually Married Homosexuals; Generation Gap in the Gay World; A Liberal Gay Church; Living With Dignity; Group Encounter; Police and the Courts; Getting to Doctors, Lawyers, Psychologists, etc.; The Drug Scene in Gay Life; Nature of Our Oppression; and Coalitions.

While the First Unitarian Church has come to an agreement with the Conference Committee about use of its facilities for December 12, it also made clear that the use of the church does not imply church endorsement.

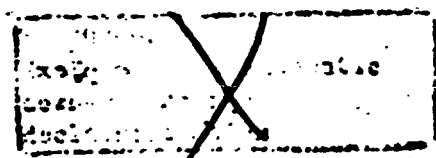

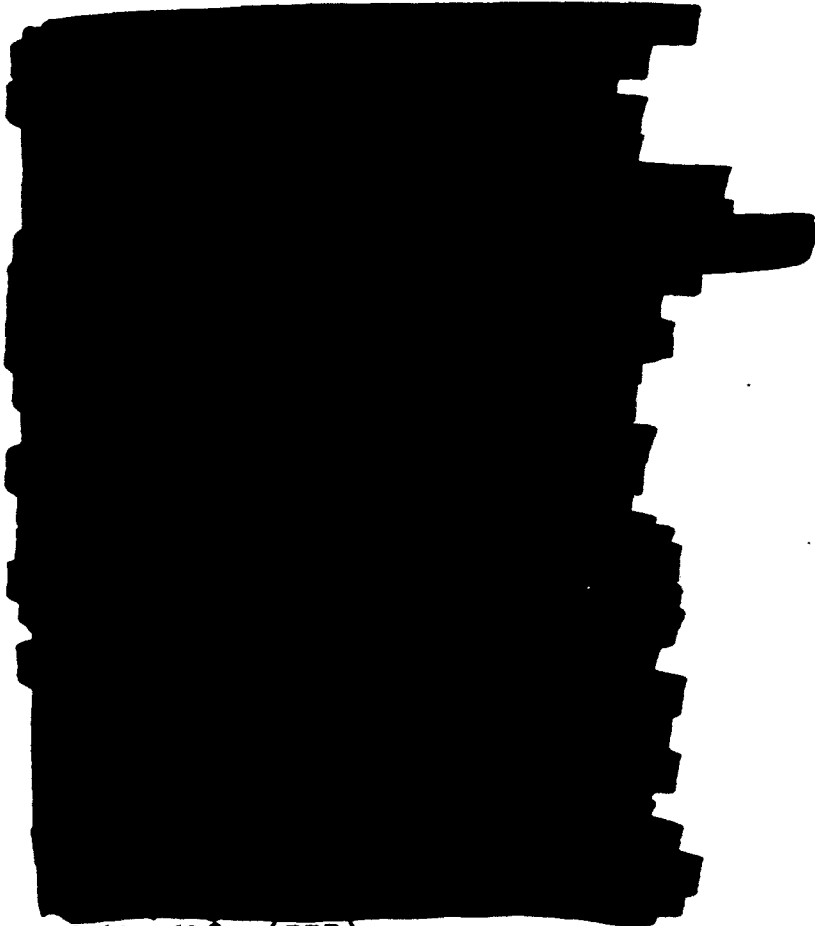

On 12/3/70, a female called the Santa Barbara Resident Agency and declined to give her identity but explained that she had attended several meetings of the Gay Liberation Front which is located at 900 Embarcadero Del Mar, Isla Vista. She explained that her husband, whom she would not identify, had apparently joined this organization and she was curious to learn something about it.

She identified the leader as BARRY ZELIKOVSKY, 734 Coyote, Santa Barbara, and described him as a white male, about 24 years old, hippie appearance, blonde curly hair. She said there were about 15 persons attending the Sunday afternoon meetings, a few of them black and a few of them are women. She said the talk given by ZELIKOVSKY was very militant and he seems to follow the line of the new left agitators.

The caller refused to give her identity but finally said she might be contacted if deemed necessary through [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] She agreed to recontact this office if she attended any further meetings and had information of possible interest to this office.
