VENCEREMOS BRIGADE

The Venceremos Brigade (VB) has been publicly described as a group of American volunteers travelling to Cuba, at the invitation of the Cuban Government, to assist in the harvesting of sugar cane.

The VB, organized in June, 1969, by a coalition of the New Left in open defiance of the United States Department of State ban on travel to Cuba, has already sponsored two contingents to Cuba. One group of over 200 Americans traveled to Cuba via Mexico in November - December, 1969, for a stay of almost two months. The second group of over 500 Americans departed by Cuban vessel at St. John's, New Brunswick, Canada, on February 13, 1970, and returned on April 28, 1970.

Venceremos translated means "we will win," a slogan of the late Che Guevera, Cuban revolutionary leader.

STUDENTS FOR A DELICERATIC SOCIETY

A source has advised that the Students for a Democratic Society (SDS), as presently regarded, came into being at a founding convention held June, 1962, at Port Huron, Michigan. From an initial posture of "participatory democracy" the line of the national leadership has revealed a growing Marxist-Leninist adberence which currently calls for the building of a revolutionary youth movement. Concurrently, the program of SDS has evolved from civil rights struggles to an anti-Vietnam war stance to an advocacy of a militant anti-imperialist position. China, Vietnam and Cuba are regarded as the leaders of worldwide struggles against United States imperialism whereas the Soviet Union is held to be revisionist and also imperialist.

At the June, 1969, SDS National Convention, Progressive Labor Party (PLP) forces in the organization were expelled. As a result, the National Office (NO) group maintained its National Headquarters at 1603 West Madison Street, Chicago, and the PLP faction set up headquarters in Cambridge, Massachusetts. This headquarters subsequently moved to Boston. Each group elected its own national officers, which include three national secretaries and a National Interim Committee of eight. Both the NO forces and the PLP forces claim to be the true SDS. Both groups also print their versions of "New Left Notes" which sets forth the line and the program of the particular faction. The NO version of "New Left Notes" was recently printed under the title "The Fire Next Time" to achieve a broader mass appeal.

Two major factions have developed internally within the NO group, namely, the Weatherman or Revolutionary Youth Movement (RYM) I faction, and the RYM II faction. Weatherman is action-oriented upholding Castro's position that the duty of revolutionaries is to make revolution. Weatherman is regarded by RYM II as an adventuristic, elitist faction which denies the historical role of the working class as the base for revolution. RYM II maintains that revolution, although desired, is not possible under present conditions, hence emphasizes organizing and raising the political consciousness

of the working class upon whom they feel successful revolution depends. Although disclaiming control and domination by the Communist Party, USA, leaders in these two factions have in the past proclaimed themselves to be communists and to follow the precepts of a Marxist-Leninist philosophy, along pro-Chinese communist lines.

A second source has advised that the PLP faction which is more commonly known as the Worker Student Alliance is dominated and controlled by members of the PLP, who are required to identify themselves with the pro-Chinese Marxist-Leninist philosophy of the PLP. They advocate that an alliance between workers and students is vital to the bringing about of a revolution in the United States.

SDS regions and university and college chapters, although operating under the outlines of the SDS Maticall Constitution, are autonomous in nature and free to carry out independent policy reflective of local conditions. Because of this autonomy internal struggles reflecting the major factional interests of SDS have occurred at the chapter level since the beginning of the 1969-70 school year.

PROGRESSIVE LACOR PARTY (PLP)

"The New York Times" city edition, Tuesday,
April 20, 1965, page 27, reported that a new party of
"revolutionary socialism" was formally founded on April 18,
1965, under the name of the PLP which had been known as the
Progressive Labor Novement.

According to the article, "The Progressive Labor Movement was founded in 1962 by Bilton Rosen and Norther Scheer after they were expelled from the Communist Party of the United States for assertedly following the Chinese Communist line."

A source advised on June 3, 1968, that the PLP held its Second Entional Convention in New York City, I'my 31 to June 2, 1968, at which time the PLP reasserted its objective of the establishment of a militant working class movement based on Marming-Leninism. This is to be accomplished through the Party's over-all revolutionary strategy of raising the consciousness of the people and helping to provide ideological leadership in the working class struggle for state power.

The source also advised that at the Second National Convention Milton Rosen was unanimously re-elected National Chairman of the PLP and Levi Laub, Fred Jerome, Jared Israel, William Epton, Jacob Rosem, Jeffrey Gordon, and Walter Linder were elected as the National Committee to lead the PLP until the next convention.

The PLP publishes "Progressive Labor," a bimonthly magazine; "World Revolution," a quarterly periodical; and "Challenge-Desafio," a monthly newspaper.

The April, 1969, issue of "Challenge-Desafio" sets forth that "Challenge is dedicated to the peoples fight for a new way of life-where the working men and women control their own homes and factories; where they themselves make up the entire government on every level and control the schools, courts, police and all institutions which are now used to control them."

SOME MEMBERS OF THE VVAW CARRIED FLAGS OF THE C HINESE PEOPLES REPUBLIC, NORTH VIETNAM AND THE VIET CONG.

GAY LIBERATION FRONT.

UPON ARRIVAL AT THE CAPITOL, PAUL MAYER, ACTED AS
MCDERATOR AND FIRST INTRODUCED CONGRESSWOMAN BELLA ABZUG. SHE
STATED THAT SHE STANDS WITH THE HARRISBURG 7 AND BELIEVES THAT
WE SHOULD GET RID OF J. EDGAR HOOVER. SHE WENT ON TO SPEAK ON
CIVIL RIGHTS, AMNESTY FOR ALL POLITICAL PRISONERS AND LEFT IMMEDIATELY AFTER HER TALK TO CATCH AN OUTGOING FLIGHT.

RUBY DEE THEN INTRODUCED FANIA JORDAN, SISTER OF

ANGELA DAVIS, WHO SPOKE BRIEFLY ON THE GRANDEUR OF THE COMMUNIST PARTY, DISMISSING THE ANGELA DAVIS INDICTMENT AND EMPHASIZED ANTI-CORPORATION ACTIVITIES.

DANIEL ELLSBERG SPOKE IN SUPPORT OF THE
BERRIGANS AND RIDICULED THE FBI FOR THEIR CONDUCT DURING THE
PERIOD OF TIME THAT BERRIGAN WAS IN A FUGITIVE STATUS. HE STATED
THE FIRST AMENDMENT WAS ON TRIAL, NOT THE BERRIGANS.

REV. RALPH DAVID ABERNATHY, SOUTHERN CHRISTIAN
LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE, SPOKE BRIEFLY, STATING THAT THE COUNTRY
MUST GET RID OF NIXON AND AGNEW AND HAVE A COMPLETE CHANGE OF
GOVERNMENT THIS ELECTION. HE ALSO RIDICULED THE FBI FOR NOT
CAPTURING THE KILLER CONSPIRATORS OF MARTIN LUTHER KING. HE
STATED THAT THE COUNTRY SHOULD REMOVE J. EDGAR HOOVER BECAUSE
HE IS NOT FINDING THE BIG DRUG PUSHERS BUT ONLY GOING AFTER
THE LITTLE MEN.

DANIEL BERRIGAN THEN READ A LETTER FROM HIS BROTHER,
PHILIP, IN REGARD TO PEACE, TURNING THE TRIAL AROUND AND URGING
THE GOVERNMENT TO "UNINDICT" THE HARRISBURG 7. HE COMPARED
BOYD DOUGLAS TO JUDAS AND THE HARRISBURG SEVEN TO JESUS CHRIST.
THE MODERATOR THEN ASKED FOR A COLLECTION TO BE TAKEN TO COVER
THE COST OF THE DEMONSTRATION AND STATED THAT ANY MONEY LEFT OVER

WOULD BE TURNED OVER TO ANGELA DAVIS AND THE HARRISBURG SEVEN.

AT THIS TIME APPROXIMATELY 400 PEOPLE LEFT.

VARIOUS FOLK SINGERS ENTERTAINED WHILE COLLECTION
WAS BEING TAKEN.

PAUL MAYER ALSO ADVISED THAT MADAME BINH, NORTH VIETNAMESE DELEGATION AT PARIS, WOULD CALL BY PHONE AND SPEAK TO THE GROUP.

MAYER READ A STATEMENT FROM THE PEOPLE'S COMMISSION
TO DEMILITARIZE INDUSTRY WHICH CLAIMED RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE
SABOTAGE TO BOMBS AT THE YORK, PA., AMERICAN MACHINE AND
FOUNDRY CO. PLANT. HE READ A LIST OF NAMES VERY QUICKLY AND
INCLUDED HIMSELF AT THE END AS AMONG THOSE RESPONSIBLE. HE THEN
REQUESTED AS MANY INDIVIDUALS AS POSSIBLE TO SIGN THIS STATEMENT
CLAIMING RESPONSIBILITY AND MOVED THROUGH THE CROWD OBTAINING
SIGNATURES. MAYER THEN ANNOUNCED THAT ALL WHO COULD SHOULD GO
TO PROTEST A SPEECH BY MELVIN LAIRD, SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, ON
APR. 7, LOCATION TO BE ANNOUNCED. HE URGED PROTESTORS TO GO TO
TALE UNIVERSITY ON APR. 4 TO PROTEST A SPEECH BY GEN. WILLIAM
WESTMORELAND.

WILLIAM KUNSTLER THEN READ POETRY FROM DANIEL BERRIGAN'S
BOOK AND FROM A NEW VIETNAM POETRY BOOK AND STATED THAT THE

BERRIGAN VIEW COINCIDES WITH HIS.

THE NEXT SPEAKER WAS NGO VINH LONG, VIETNAMESE STUDENT HARVARD, UNIVERSITY. HE SPOKE ON THE ATROCITIES AND TORTURES IN THE VIETNAM WAR. HE STATED THAT HE AND A GROUP OF INDIVIDUALS WOULD TAKE OVER A HALL AT SOUTHERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY ON APR. 27,1972, IN PROTEST AGAINST THE WAR.

AT APPROXIMATELY 4:15 PM THE TRANSATIANTIC PHONE CALL
CAME IN FROM PARIS AND WAS PATCHED THROUGH TO THE PUBLIC ADDRESS
SYSTEM. MADAME BINH AND AN UNIDENTIFIED MALE SPOKE IN BROKEN
ENGLISH ON THE EXCHANGE OF PRISONERS OF WAR AND NIXON'S POLICIES.

ANNOUNCEMENTS WERE THEN MADE TO THE PROTESTORS THAT
THEY SHOULD ATTEND THE ITT STOCKHOLDERS MEETING IN BOSTON, DATE
NOT GIVEN.

ALSO ANNOUNCED AS SCHEDULED WAS A PROTEST AT THE ARMY RESEARCH CENTER, MADISON, WISCONSIN, MAY 15, 1972, AND PLANNED DEMONSTRATIONS BYRPERSONNEL OF THE ARMED FORCES ON ARMED FORCES DAY MAY 20, 1972.

NEXT SPEAKER WAS BEULAH SANDERS, NATIONAL WELFARE RIGHTS ORGANIZATION LEADER, WHO SPOKECON RACISM, POVERTY AND ENDING THE WAR.

DANIEL BANGOR, VVAW OF PENNSYLVANIA, SPOKE IN REGARD

ABOUT THE TRIAL.

RICHARD HAYDEN, AFL-CIO OFFICIAL, FARM WORKERS UNION,
READ A MESSAGE FROM CAESAR CHAVEZ REPRESENTING A STATEMENT IN
REGARD TO THE UNION'S OPPOSITION TO THE REFUBLICAN PARTY'S
STAND ON FARM WORKERS AND OTHER UNION POLICIES.

AN UNKNOWN MALE THEN SPOKE, REPRESENTING THE GAY
LIBERATION FRONT OF WASHINGTON, D.C. THIS INDIVIDUAL WAS VERY
UPSET BECAUSE HIS ORGANIZATION WAS LAST AND STATED THAT THE
GAY PEOPLE SHOULD BECOME MORE BOLD AND AGGRESSIVE AND THAT WE
SHOULD HAVE MORE PEOPLE LIKE THE BERRIGANS.

DEMONSTRATION CONCLUDED AT ABOUT 5:45 PM AND ANNOUNCE-MENTS MADE FOR ALL TO ATTEND SUNRISE SERVICE, CITY ISLAND, HARRISBURG, 6 AM, APR. 2, 1972.
