They were the lucky few who found me first at SOCC while wearing something tangier like I mentioned in the previous Storm Front column.

This month, let's talk about two brand new titles from Wizard Magazine's "2007 Writer to Watch," Christos Gage. Before *Midnighter* and *Apollo* were giving orders in *THE AUTHORITY*, Jackson King and Fahrenheit led the charge in *STORMWATCH* and behind it all was the duly departed Weatherman, Heery Bendix. Well, this October, he's back. Kinda.

When *StormWatch* discovers a hidden lab belonging to Bendix, it seeds both teams rushing headlong to find out what's inside. **THE AUTHORITY: PRIME** pits old friends against each other—and Heery Bendix—is an explosive six-issue mini-series under the ever-watchful eyes of Wildman Christos Gage and Wildboy Darick Robertson.

Gage also lights the fuse on the first issue of *WildStorm: ARMAGEDDON*, hitting shelves in October. Each issue focuses on one WildStorm character visiting an apocalyptic future, but is it too late to stop it? Or is it just a harbinger of things to come? We've got six great artists working on issues of this dark tale with matching covers by the spectacular Mike McKone.

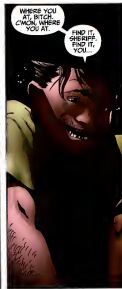

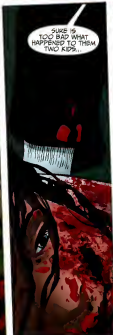
