WRITER WARREN ELLIS DEBUTS THE ALL-NEW JAMES BOND COMIC BOOK SERIES WITH ARTIST JASON MASTERS

Dynamite proudly announces that fan-favorite author Warren Ellis will be writing the James Bond ongoing comic book series. James Bond is scheduled for release in November 2015, featuring interior artwork by Jason Masters (Batman Incorporated). In the series, Bond returns to London after a mission of vengeance in Helsinki, to take up the workload of a fallen 00 Section agent... but something evil is moving through the back streets, and sinister plans are being laid for Bond in Berlin.

SPOTLIGHT ON RED SONJA:

Red Sonja #1, by the creative team of Marguerite Bennett (*Bombshells, A-Force, Angela*) and Aneke (*Legenderry: Red Sonja, Damsels*) and scheduled for release on January 13, 2016, will see its titular heroine return to her homeland of Hyrkania, only to find it changed into an almost unrecognizable landscape. As envisioned by Gail Simone, the new series sends Sonja on a mission of infiltration, sabotage, and assassination when she discovers that her native people have been conscripted into the service of a Nazi-like regime.

SPOTLIGHT ON DEJAH THORIS:

Dejah Thoris, a royal warrior who has served as a major supporting cast member of Dynamite's various Warlord of Mars series as well as the star of several solo Dejah Thoris series, will appear in a new #1 issue this coming February, courtesy of writer Frank J. Barbiere (*Avengers World, Solar: Man of the Atom*). As described by Gail Simone, Dejah Thoris would present a fall from grace for the Martian princess, as she embarks on a self-imposed exile, assuming a new identity and enlisting as a rookie soldier on the farthest, deadliest borders of her Barsoomian civilization.

SPOTLIGHT ON VAMPIRELLA:

Vampirella #1, debuting in March 2016, will feature the writing talents of Kate Leth (*Adventure Time, Bravest Warriors*), and see a return to the character's roots as a horror hostess, as her costumed identity goes public... while privately, she uses her new celebrity status to uncover the links between silver screen killers and a real conspiracy of monsters.

DAVID F. WALKER, THE 2015 GLYPH COMICS AWARD-WINNING AUTHOR, RETURNS TO SHAFT!

This February, critically acclaimed author David F. Walker (DC Comic's *Cyborg*) will continue the legacy of Ernest Tidyman's iconic private detective, John Shaft, in an all-new comic book series, *Shaft: Imitation of Life*, illustrated by Dietrich Smith. The first issue will debut in February 2016 alongside *Shaft's Revenge*, the first Shaft prose novel in 40 years.

Imitation of Life takes place following the events of Walker's 2015 comic book miniseries, *Shaft: A Complicated Man* - a six-part storyline that won a 2015 Glyph Comics Award and was nominated for the Dwayne McDuffie Award for Diversity. After a high-profile case puts him in the headlines, private detective John Shaft searches for something low-profile to keep him out of the spotlight and out of danger... and takes a missing person case that proves to be more difficult than he thought. At the same time, he is hired to be a consultant on a low budget film that may or may not be based on his life, and proves to be as dangerous as any job he's ever had. But when there's danger about, John Shaft won't cop out - even if it means squaring off against sadistic gangsters that want him dead.

"The idea for the new miniseries, *Shaft: Imitation of Life*, is one that's been in my head for a long time, and is something that I'm really excited about," says Walker. "This has been a really fun story to develop."

New series artist Dietrich Smith, whose work previously graced the pages of Dynamite's *Army of Darkness* and *Vampirella*, says, "Of all the great action heroes I watched and imitated as a youngster, Shaft was at the top - a private eye with a chip on his shoulder, an attitude that dared anyone to try him. Having the opportunity to draw the smoothest man alive is something I'm very excited about."

Dynamite advance-solicited the *Shaft's Revenge* prose novel in Diamond Comic Distributors' October Previews catalog, the premiere source of merchandise for the comic book specialty market. *Shaft: Imitation of Life* #1 will be solicited in the upcoming December catalog; both the prose novel and #1 comic book issue correspond to release dates in February 2016. Fans are encouraged to reserve copies of Shaft with their local comic book retailers.

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






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



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







WRITERS KATE LETH AND NANCY A. COLLINS SHARE THEIR THOUGHTS ON DYNAMITE'S NEW MARCH TITLES

KATE LETH, Writer of the Upcoming Vampirella Series

You're taking the reins on Vampirella, an outright icon in horror comics. What are your favorite aspects about this enduring character?

Leth: I love the genre that Vampirella comes from. I'm a fan of classic horror, of B-movies, of monsters and things that go bump in the night. Vampirella's both classic and otherworldly, terrifying and camp. She represents a style we don't see much of anymore, and I'm thrilled to get the chance to try something new with her.

With decades of monster-hunting under her belt, Vampirella has seen threats of all shapes and sizes. What can you tell us about the foe (or foes) she'll face in the new series?

Leth: We're dealing with the long history of horror in Hollywood, all the way back to the first black and white films. We'll get to know an organization that has been turning the wheels and terrorizing productions for decades, led by a woman who's not keen on having a monster hunter in town. We open a bit tongue-in-cheek, but quickly realize there are very real dangers for Vampi in this story.

NANCY A. COLLINS, Writer of the Upcoming Army of Darkness: Furious Road Series

Dynamite's ARMY OF DARKNESS comics have taken Ash to outer space, the virtual reality of the future, the distant past, and to hellish dimensions. Where will your story take Ash, and why did you choose that setting?

Collins: The setting for FURIOUS ROAD is 20 years "from now". Whenever "now" is. The Deadites have managed to finally spread into the world at large and everything has collapsed. We're looking at a post-apocalyptic world (at least in North America), with scattered pockets of humanity holed up against the Army of Darkness. A group of human survivors team up with some of the last surviving monsters — a pack of werewolf bikers, Dracula and his Brides, a witch, Frankenstein's Monster, etc. – to battle the Deadites. The monsters' reason for helping the humans is largely one of enlightened self-interest; they need humanity to survive, and, to be honest, the Deadites don't play well with anyone, even their fellow damned. It's up to them to send the Army of Darkness back to whatever hell they call home — and that means they need the help of the Chosen One, a.k.a. Ashley "Ash" Williams. But it's going to take some convincing. Oh, and did I mention the action is set in Michigan? The setting is a tribute to creator Sam Raimi and actor Bruce Campbell, who are from the Detroit area.

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
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








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
















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

WRITERS PHIL HESTER AND GENEVIEVE VALENTINE SHARE THEIR THOUGHTS ON DYNAMITE'S NEW APRIL TITLES

PHIL HESTER, Writer of the Upcoming Gold Key: Alliance Series When you think of each of the Gold Key characters, what do you feel defines them? Who are these characters?

Hester: I see each of them as an archetype of specific aspect of heroism. Magnus is the quintessential defender. Turok is the epitome of the explorer. Solar is the exemplar of the creator. Outside of that sort of meta perspective, each has a personality that shines through no matter the incarnation. Magnus is consistently upbeat and positive, Turok level-headed and bold, Solar contemplative and aloof. It's fun to have those differing personalities clash as they work toward the same goal.

When you look back at your vast body of writing work, what theme parallels do you find between Gold Key: Alliance and other projects? What will Phil Hester fans be eager to see in the new project?

Hester: I always find some way to make a super hero story cosmic, or at least deeper than a simple punch-up. I have a hard time writing an epic adventure without the protagonist meeting God, or her inner self, or the avatar of some abstract idea. Too many Jim Starlin comics as a kid, I guess! I hope you'll find the sense of action and pacing that can sweep you along like you're reading an old school Marvel book (like my work on *Firebreather* and *Wonder Woman*), but with a distinctly modern sense of humor (like my runs on *Mythic* and *Golly*), and at the same time delivering that deeper message I can't seem to avoid (*The Coffin, The Darkness*).

GENEVIEVE VALENTINE, Writer of the Upcoming Xena: Warrior Princess Series

Xena: Warrior Princess #1 marks a return to adventure for the cult favorite character. What do you see as the essential components that make up a good Xena story?

Valentine: One of the things I love so much about Xena is how many different essential components there are to choose from! It was a show that understood the full range of its adventures, and knew exactly how to set off comedy with drama, or play in a sandbox of mythology and alternate history. But one of my favorite things about Xena has always been that no matter how alternate that history got, or how goofy the comedy, there was a sense of weight and substance from the characters at its center that we could come back to. Aphrodite is amazing comic relief, but her soft spot for Gabrielle gives her dimension; Xena's fight scenes are epic, but we see enough of her past to understand the hard lessons that have gotten her here — as skilled as she is, fighting for the things she fights for now. I think that sense of "anything goes" that still never outstrips the characters is really at the heart of any *Xena* story.

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
