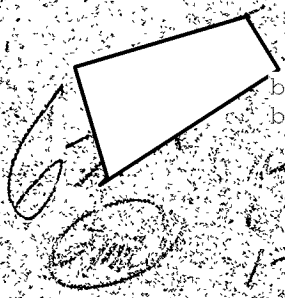

FOR THE INFORMATION OF OFFICES RECEIVING THIS COMMUNICATION, RE CHARLOTTE TELETYPES TO THE BUREAU AND REFERENCED CHARLOTTE TELEPHONE CALL FURNISHED SUFFICIENT INFORMATION UPON WHICH TO BASE FULL DOMESTIC SECURITY INVESTIGATIONS IN REGARD TO A WORKERS VIEWPOINT ORGANIZATION, AKA COMMUNIST WORKERS PARTY OF NORTH CAROLINA AND THE AMERICAN NAZI PARTY OF NORTH CAROLINA. FULL DOMESTIC SECURITY INVESTIGATIONS OF THESE ORGANIZATIONS INSTITUTED NOVEMBER 5, 1979.

SUFFICIENT INFORMATION HAS ALSO BEEN DEVELOPED UPON WHICH TO BASE A FULL DOMESTIC SECURITY INVESTIGATION CONCERNING THE KLAN ORGANIZATION INVOLVED IN CAPTIONED MATTER, INVESTIGATION IS CURRENTLY UNDERTAKEN TO IDENTIFY THE SPECIFIC KLAN ORGANIZATION INVOLVED AND WHEN THIS IS DONE, A FULL DOMESTIC SECURITY INVESTIGATION WILL BE OPENED IN REGARD TO THAT ORGANIZATION.

FOR THE INFORMATION OF RECEIVING OFFICES WHO DID NOT RECEIVE REFERENCED CHARLOTTE TELETYPES, CAPTIONED MATTER BRIEFLY INVOLVES THE FOLLOWING: ON NOVEMBER 3, 1979, THE WORKERS VIEWPOINT

ORGANIZATION (WVO), AN OFFSHOOT OF THE REVOLUTIONARY COMMUNIST PARTY, LED BY [REDACTED] FORMERLY ASSOCIATED WITH THE BLACK PANTHER PARTY, HELD AN ANTI-KLAN DEMONSTRATION IN GREENSBORO, N. C. PREVIOUS TO THIS TIME THE WVO SENT INFLAMMATORY LITERATURE TO THE KLAN CALLING THE DEMONSTRATION A "DEATH TO THE KLAN" RALLY. AT APPROXIMATELY 11:30 A.M., A CARAVAN OF VEHICLES CONTAINING KLAN MEMBERS AND SYMPATHIZERS ARRIVED AT THE SCENE OF THE DEMONSTRATION. THERE WAS SUDDEN AND UNEXPECTED AGGRESSIVE ACTION TAKEN BY THE DEMONSTRATORS AGAINST THE VEHICLES OCCUPIED BY THE KLAN MEMBERS AND GUNFIRE THEREAFTER ERUPTED BETWEEN MEMBERS OF THE WVO AND THE KLAN. FOUR PERSONS WERE KILLED AND TEN WOUNDED. FOURTEEN KLAN MEMBERS WERE SUBSEQUENTLY ARRESTED BY THE GREENSBORO POLICE DEPARTMENT AND CHARGED WITH CONSPIRACY TO MURDER. [REDACTED] WAS ARRESTED FOR INCITING A RIOT AND IS PRESENTLY RELEASED ON BAIL. [REDACTED] AND OTHER MEMBERS OF THE WVO HAVE DECLARED THAT THEY WILL HOLD ANOTHER RALLY ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 11, 1979, IN GREENSBORO, N. C., AND THAT THEY WILL BE ARMED TO PROTECT THEMSELVES. GREENSBORO CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE MAYOR HAVE DECLARED A MORATORIUM ON PARADE PERMITS, BUT THE WVO CLAIMS THEY WILL MARCH ANYWAY.

[REDACTED], PREVIOUSLY DESCRIBED IN REFERENCED TELETYPE, HAS MADE ADDITIONAL ALLEGATIONS IN LOCAL MEDIA COVERAGE. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATIVE DIVISION

This concerns the shooting incident at Greensboro, North Carolina, on 11/3/79, wherein four persons were killed and several persons were wounded, two of which were not expected to live. This incident grew out of a demonstration by Workers Viewpoint Organization (WVO) and their confrontation with suspected members of the Ku Klux Klan (KKK) and of the American Nazi Party (ANP). WVO characterizes itself as a political organ of communist organization which is composed mainly of Asian-Americans. It's guiding philosophy is Marxism-Leninism-Mao Tse-Tung thought.

Attached from Charlotte Office advises fifth victim, Michael Nathan, WVO, expired shortly before Noon (11/5/79). One [redacted] advised she accompanied Hickory, North Carolina, Klan members to demonstration on 11/3/79. She has identified those with whom she traveled and also identified [redacted], Invisible Empire of the KKK, North Carolina, as being present and riding in the car in front of her in the caravan.

[redacted] reporter, WXII TV, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, advised she arrived at the original staging location for the demonstration, but was advised by an unidentified black female to go to a relocation site where the demonstration was to begin. Other news media representatives confirmed information as to relocation site and are of the opinion that the police were not advised.

MURDER IN GREENSBORO

The Klan/Nazis murders in North Carolina make one thing clear: The people of this country cannot stand quiet any longer. You cannot permit this kind of terror any longer.

Such terror must be met with a national movement led by leading elements of the working class, especially the trade unions and civil rights organizations.

This movement must be aimed at turning back the rising tide of violence. The working class must go on the offensive. Trade union organizers and workers fighting for social and economic equality must be allowed their freedom of speech and action.

A blow must be struck against the Klan and Nazis; they must be denied the streets. They must be met with an organized offensive fought on a blow-for-blow basis.

Immediate steps must be taken:

*There is evidence to indicate that some sort of conspiracy exists between the Klan/Nazis and the police; there must be an immediate federal investigation to determine the extent of the conspiracy.

*Further legal action under the Civil Rights Act must be brought against everyone involved in the conspiracy and against the existence of the Klan and the Nazis.

*Throughout the country, individuals and organizations must immediately begin to demand that their elected officials introduce legislation to outlaw the Klan and the Nazis.

People in this country must learn from the rise of the Nazis in Germany. You must put aside your differences and unite to fight these forces. Passivity in the time of crisis means support for the Klan/Nazis.

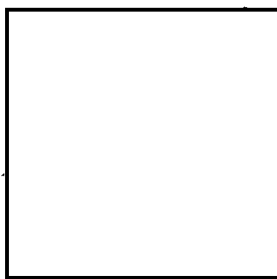
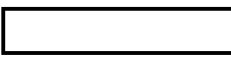
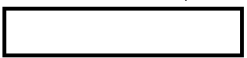
