NOTE :—This Summary is based upon the quarterly returns of total losses, &c., which have been published by Lloyd's Register. It includes, however, several vessels which had not been given up as total losses, or of the loss of which information had not been received, when the returns for the quarters in which they respectively occurred were compiled. On the other hand, a few vessels which, being definitely considered as total losses at the respective dates of compilation, were included in the quarterly returns, have since been floated, repaired, &c., and are accordingly now excluded from the statistics given herein.

A distinguishing feature of the Wreck Returns published by Lloyd's Register is that, except as regards missing vessels, they are compiled strictly according to the dates at which the casualties resulting in total loss actually *occurred*, and not according to the dates at which *reports* of casualties were *received*.
