CD 13 Team,

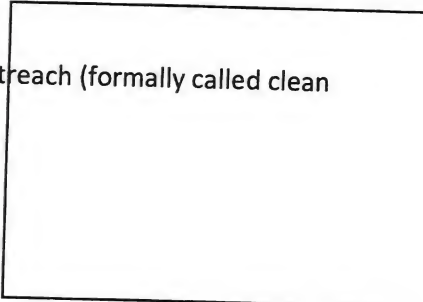
Greetings, this was a busy week in CD1 that included requests, maintenance, and outreach (formally called clean up) as well as general outreach and engagements.

Monday- January 11, 2016

We made direct contact with a total of 12 people, 4 who were new contacts, encouraged clean up of their area, informed them of the maintenance and engagements effort for Wednesday, provided support, offered services, gave out hygiene kits, and passed out trash bags.

- Sunny was well engaged and agreed to meet with us again next week for possible services.
- Matt was very agitated, team backed off but left him trash bags.
- Psych and his encampment is overflowing with trash. Teamed coached him and encouraged him to keep his area clean. He agreed that he would put in the maximum effort to clean up the trash.

Wednesday January 13, 2016

Team participated in the maintenance and engagement, and was requested to come out a second time later in the afternoon to Juanita location. Coordinated with maintenance crew for additional clean up on Friday, due to the trucks being full.
