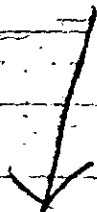

Explanation of why in possession of Gold. Conf. reports refer to minor charges, both of an experimental and permanent nature. Processes for prep. of various type film. Undoubtedly Slack gave them to Gold for transmittal to Sam - anything Slack gave him of this nature was for transmittal to Sam - Can't explain why he still

how them. — Possibilities (Guesse)

① Best one — Slack later got more up-to-date processes which were better than those covered in extreme reports (note that reports dated in mid 30's).

② That Slack was to do some more work on them as explanation of what it was could be given to Sam.

NOTE — Gold never, never discussed any material he was giving Sam, at time of delivery, by taking the stuff out of packages and going over it.

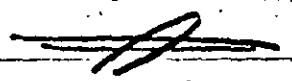

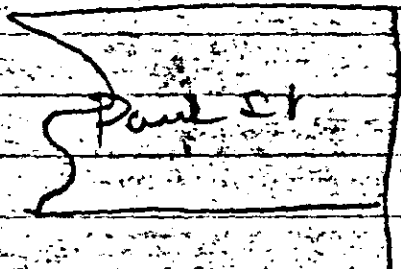
