Memorandum for THE DIRECTOR

"Elliott Linked to TWA in Trans-Atlantic O.K." The article comments upon the Presidential approval recently granted to the Civil Aeronautics Board when that board on July 5, 1945 granted international routes to Pan American Airways, American Export Airlines and Transcontinental and Western Airlines. The newspaper indicates that the issuance of a certificate to Transcontinental Western Airlines had repercussions in the House of Representatives when Representative Faul Shafer of Kichigan issued a statement saying the facts involved should be "explored" because of the association between Brigadier General Elliott Roosevelt and TWA officials.

Representative Shafer is quoted as follows: "I make no direct accusations but I am forced to admit I am suspicious some undue influence was brought to bear to cause the favorable reconsideration of TNA's application to fly the Atlantic routes." After stating that TNA's application was rejected in January last, Nr. Shafer continued that it appeared that the Civil Aeronautics Board had given two "special favors" and was in some manner persuaded to change its previous decision. The newspaper believed that Representative Shafer was referring to a Civil Aeronautics Board Examiner's recommendation that Pan American and American Export Airlines be granted the routes.

The inquiry in connection with subject Myers has disclosed that he has been very friendly with both Brigadier General Elliott Roosevelt and Jack Trys, President of Transcontinental Western Airlines.

SUBJECT'S CONNECTIONS AT HUGHES AIRCRAFT CORPORATION

Since a review of the Los Angeles files indicated that in September, 1944, a Russian military mission was entertained at Hughes Aircraft, Culver City, California, and since it was reflected that in connection with this visit.

The representation of the Russian military mission, and further since the Los Angeles Office records indicated that JOHNEY LEYER had participated in entertaining the Russian mission, was consulted on June 8, 1915, with respect to the official connection of subject with Eughes Aircraft Company.

The inquiry was made in such a way that it related to the Russian military mission.





He explained that the constellation aircraft are being built for post-mar commercial use and are extra large passenger planes. In view of the fact that MPB approval was needed for the contract modification whereby Lockheed would be able to build these planes for other companies than TWA, JOHN MEYER, who was acting for TWA interests and also in the interests of Lockheed, which company was also anxious to have the contract modification effected, contacted JULIUS A. KRUG during the early part of this year in Los Angeles. MEYER showed the constellation plane to KRUG and KRUG took a ride in the constellation, expressed himself as very pleased with the plane, and thereupon gave NFB approval for the contract modification.

According to the modification was legitimately approved by WPB and MEYER did not act in an official capacity for Lockheed at this time nor did he ever act as an authorized agent of Lockheed, according to information received by From RUBERT GRUSS, President of Lockheed.

When the Lockheed-TMA contract change was first proposed, there were several meetings between Lockheed and TMA officials and there were several social functions at which MEYER conducted himself prominently.





Current Activities

On July 5, 1945 Representative Paul W. Later, according to Representative Shafer, Elliott and his wride were flown east by Trye to meet the Roosevelt family.





SHAFER stated that later MEYER went to Hyde Perk where he conferred with the late President Roosevelt. SHAFER pointed out that when ELLIOTT ROOSEVELT and TAYE EMERSON were married, the entire wedding party was flown from California to the Grand Canyon by JAON FRYE, President of TWA.

The same newspaper on July 13, 1945, featured a story on the loans received by ELLIOTT ROOSEVELT and revealed that he was questioned on July 12, 1945 at the Waldorf Towers by Internal Revenue Agents.

It has been noted that the name of HOTARD HUGHES and JOHNNY MEYER have appeared occasionally in local newspaper columns as having been observed in various night clubs in this city. No physical surveillance has been instituted in this case pursuant to Los Angeles tele type dated June 19, 1945.





It was indicated that the treasurer of the company, one FRANK MCDCNALD, was quitting and that McDONIAD was a very valuable individual. It was also learned that THYE and FRYE appeared anxious to replace Charles PERELLE, executive wice-president of Hughes wireraft in charge of production. INTER was particularly insistent that PERMLI be replaced, and discussed an interview of one BUD WILLIES, of Room wire aft, San Diego, who had apparently been interviewed by Lift FRYE as a possible successor to PELLLLI. The general trend of this conversation was to the effect that PINILLI was hampering the operation of Hughes wireraft, at least in the judgment of Subject, and that the hughes aircraft needed a complete shake-up. 

It was learned that subject and the pilot slept in a twin bed in the bedroom of JOE Holl, owner and manager of the Palace Club, who maintains a permanent suite at the River side Hotel, and that HOMAED HUGHES and IVONNE DeCARLO stayed in Room 315.

The hotel records reflect that "MORRIS and party occupied Room 315."

that subject was in telephonic conversation with an unidentified man and that during this conversation subject claimed to be HOMARD HUCHES! manager and said that HUCHES was in the process of selling all of his property with the exception of the Rughes Tool Factory in Houston, Texas. 

It was learned later in the evening that subject and HOWARD HUGHES talked to someone in Los Angelos on a tolephone call, and it was believed that this individual was one CENKIRK, who it is noted in referenced report, is an official of the Hughes Aircraft Company. It was further determined through Source — mat RCARD HUGHES until recently retained a single room at the Riverside Hotel in Reno the year around. It was learned that HUGHES has the reputation at the Riverside Hotel of being very eccentric. He is not known to have brought women with him on his previous occasional trips to Reno. He is known to have registered as HARPY JONES when he stayed at the Riverside Hotel.

Subject, together with HOWARD HUCHES and TVONNE DeCARLO, proceeded to Las Vegas in the early afternoon of September 13, 1945. Subject and HUCHES stayed at the Hotel El Rancho Vegas, but Miss DeCARLO stayed at the Last Frontier Hotel. HUCHES loft word at his hotel that his visit there should receive no publicity.

Despite HOWARD HUCHES' request for no publicity, a newsstory concerning him appeared in the Las Vegas "Morning Tribune" on September 17, 1945. This story indicated JOHN MEYER accompanied HUCHES to

Las Vegas, and that MEYER is his "confident and assistant for many years".

Subject, together with HOMARD HUGHES and TVORME Decario, left in HUGHES' plane from Las Vegas September 16, 1945, reportedly for Los Angeles. Subject was first noted again to be in Los Angeles on September 19, 1945. It was learned through a physical surveillance that subject spent considerable time with HOMARD HUGHES who was staying at the Town House in Los Angeles, except for intervals when subject and HUGHES were out of the city.

It was learned through that subject had gone to the home of THOMAS DOYCE in Santa Barbara with HOMARD HUGHES on September 22, 1945

Following the return of the subject from Palm Springs on September 25, 1945 subject and Highes were together around Los Angeles, HUGHES staying at the Town House, Room 905, under the name J. B. ALEXANDER. On September 29, 1945 subject and HUMARD HUGHES made a trip to San Diego and subject returned alone on the same evening to Los Angeles.

It was learned through Confidential Informant that on October 2, 1945 subject wired one E. HUTCHINS, Assistant Manager, Bancho Vegas Hotel, Las Vegas, Nevada, stating "REMEMBER EDDIE POSITIVELY MO PUBLICITY FOR MYSELF OR ANY MEMBER OF PARTY DUNING STAY. THANKS. REGARDS." It was later observed by physical surveillance that subject, together with HOWARD HUCHES and a woman believed to be YVONNE DeCARLO, left the Metropolitan Airport in HUGHES' private plane, apparently for Las Vegas, Nevada.



"Variety" for October 23, 1945, stated that in addition to the position offered by the MPPA, KRUG had received offers from FLOYD COLUN to become an executive of the Atlas Corporation, and another offer from HUMARD HUGHES to become an executive in charge of foreign operations for TWA.

Connection with Hollywood Columnists

Through the services of it was learned that HARFISON CARROLL, a columnist who writes for the Hearst newspapers, had written an article to the effect that YVONTEYDE LATED and HOWARD HUTHES had been in Canada together. Further it was stated that HUTHES had recently taken DE CARLO to New York City and that MEYER personally called on CARROLL and asked him not to print the story in his column regarding the trip to New York. CARROLL reportedly stated that he did not intend to use the story as the subject was no longer news. MEYER replied that he was delighted to hear of this and that he was sending two cases of Scotch whisky to CARROLL for his cooperation. CARROLL replied that he did not want any of NEYER'S

SCOTCH and that he was not printing the article simply because it was not news. This informant stated that NEYER had contacted practically every columnist in Hollywood and had sent Scotch all over town in order to attempt to make sure that the item would not leak out in the papers.

MEYER'S Activity in HOWARD HUGHES Productions

Through contacts had with it was learned that HOWARD HUGHES had been able to secure the services of SOLAESSERVAN, United artists to handle the release of HOWARD HUGHES' film "The Outlaw"; however, it appeared that some of the terms of the contract were objectionable to IESSER-MAN and considerable difficulty ensued. It was reported that MEYER was working on LESSERVAN in order to iron out the difficulties regarding the contract. It was noted on several occasions that MEYER went to the Beverly Hills Hotel where LESSERYAN was staying, and it was thought that MEYER had made contact with LESSERIAN on these occasions for the purpose of endeavoring to straighten out the difficulties. Subsequently it was determined that LEYER was also endeavoring to secure the services of other men well known in the motion picture industry to handle the release of the film instead of LESSERIAN. One of the individuals whose services have been solicited for the position is HARRY SOULD, of United Artists Pictures in New York City.

Through the same source it was reported that MEYER had been keeping himself somewhat busy during the past three or four weeks endeavoring to make contacts with various noted motion picture actresses in whom it was believed that HOWARD HUGHES had indicated an interest. Among those actresses whom MEYER has been contacting are: DIANA HYNN, JOAE MESLIE, GAIL RUSSELL, JEAT CHAIN, and BARRARA GATES.



Through Confidential Source it was ascertained that METER receives a letter almost daily from the Howard Hughes Aircraft Corporation, Culver City, California; however, no other mail was received at his residence which was considered to be of particular interest to the instant investigation.



This source stated that HOWARD HUGHES had dired at the home of KILS THOLOGARDUND, master of ceremonies at the Florentine Gardens, with YVONIE DE CAPLO.
