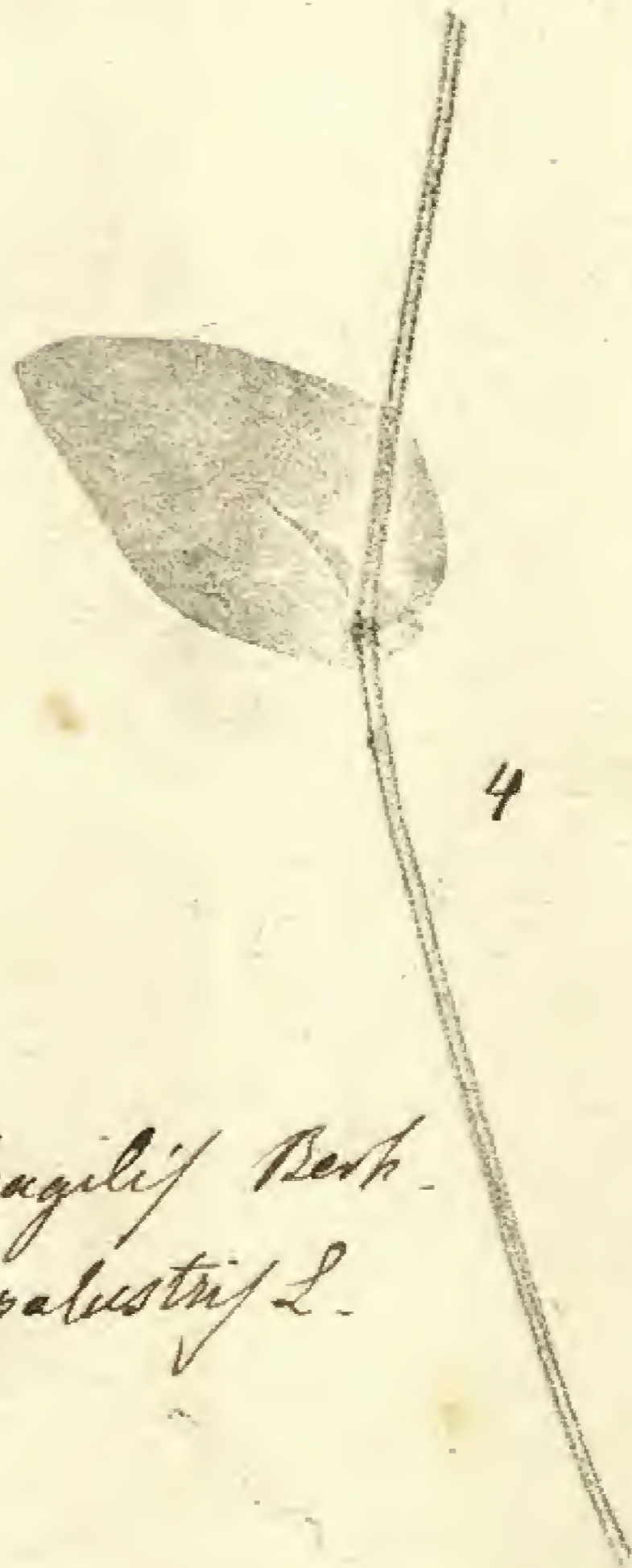

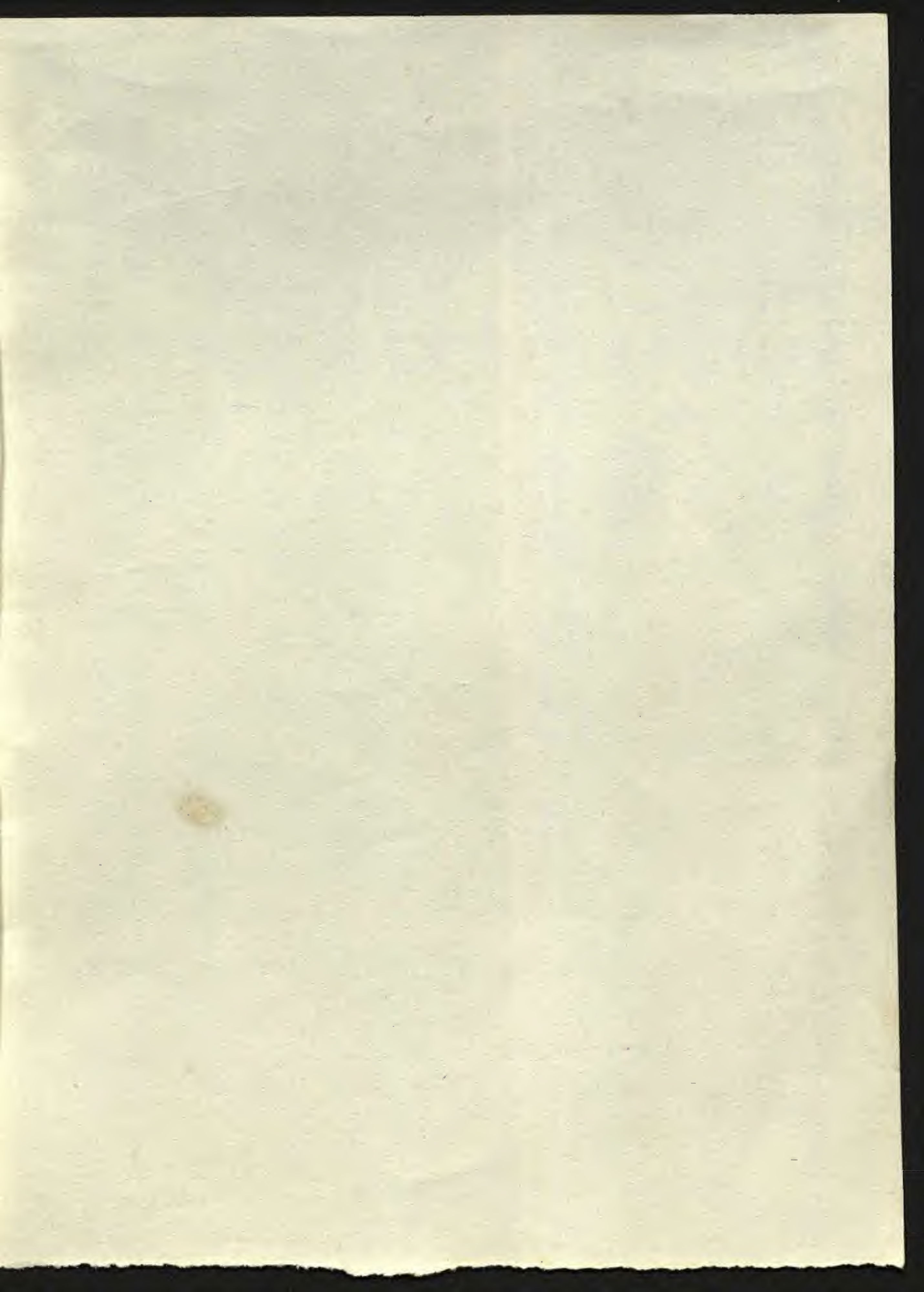


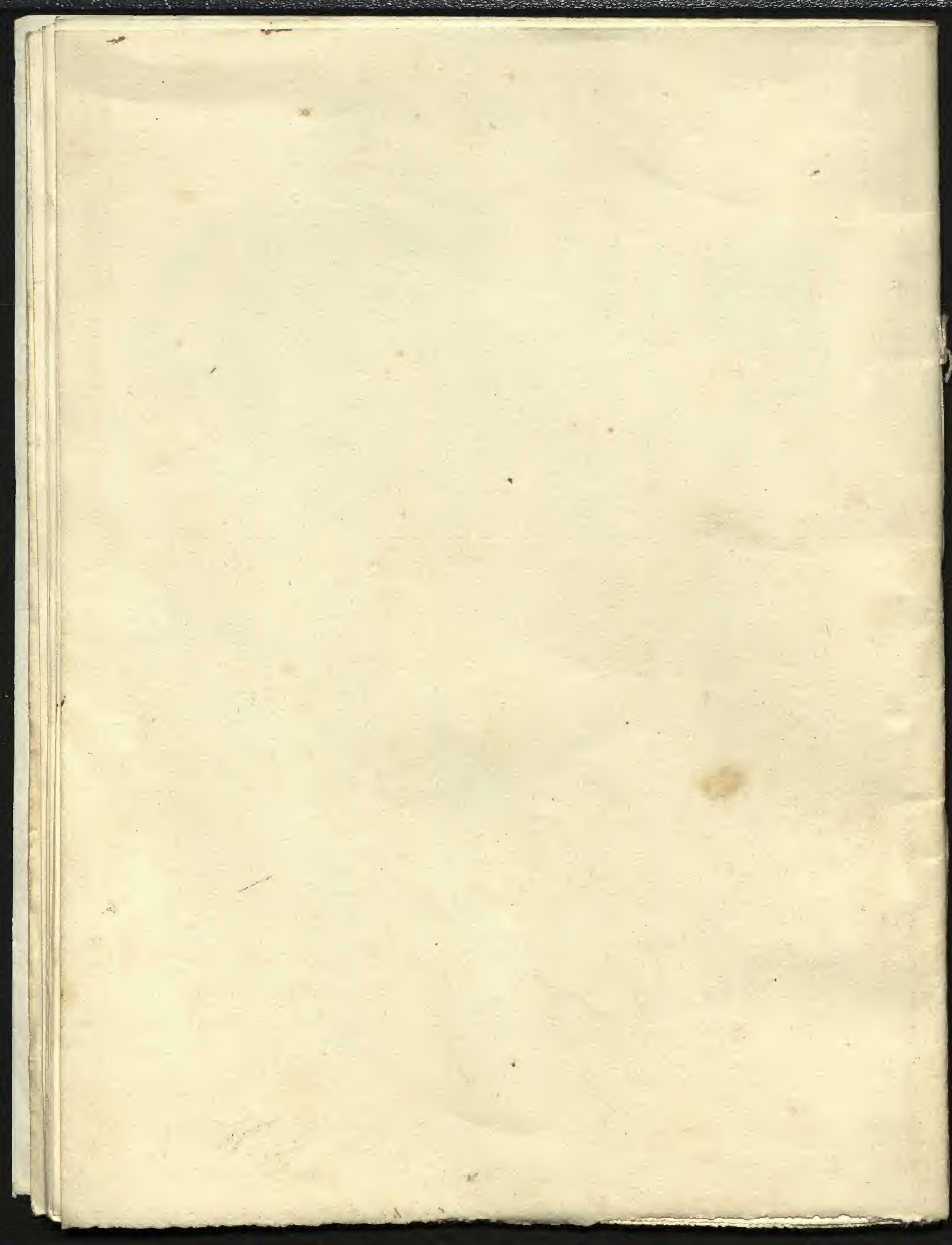
1-2 *Chrysopteryx alternifolium* - (3 *Salvia sclarea*) 4 *Sorbus aria*
 3 *Salvia verticillata* Linn. (Ex specim. in h. bot. viso)

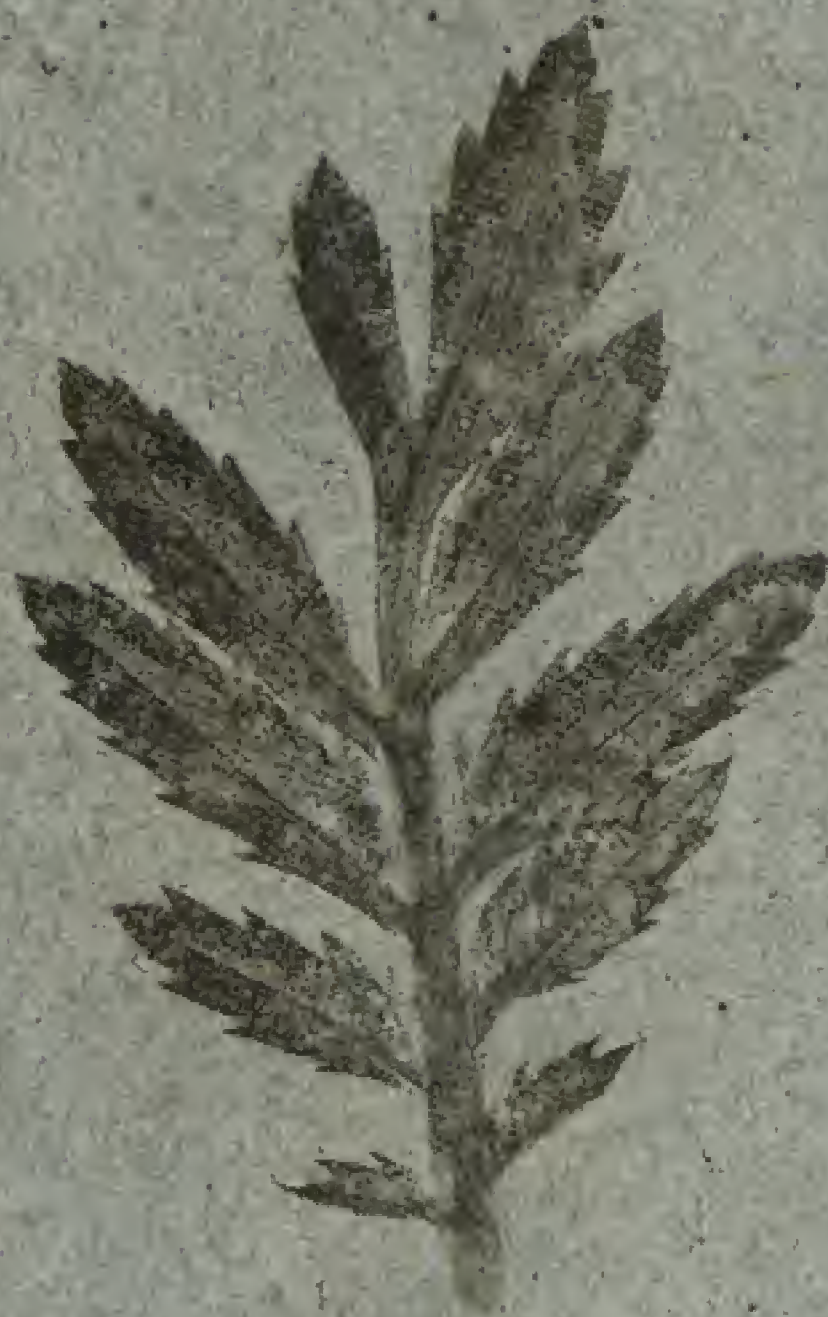

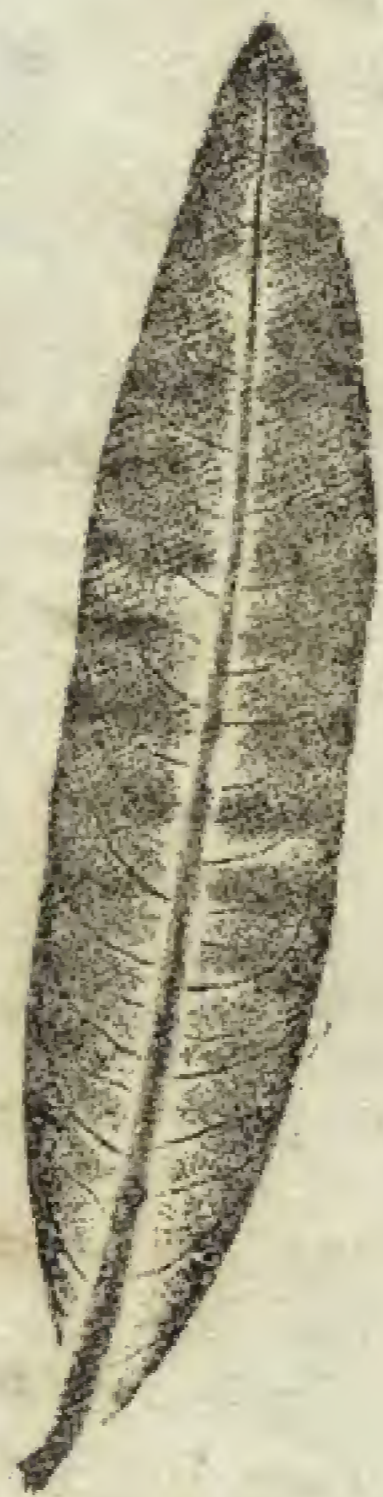

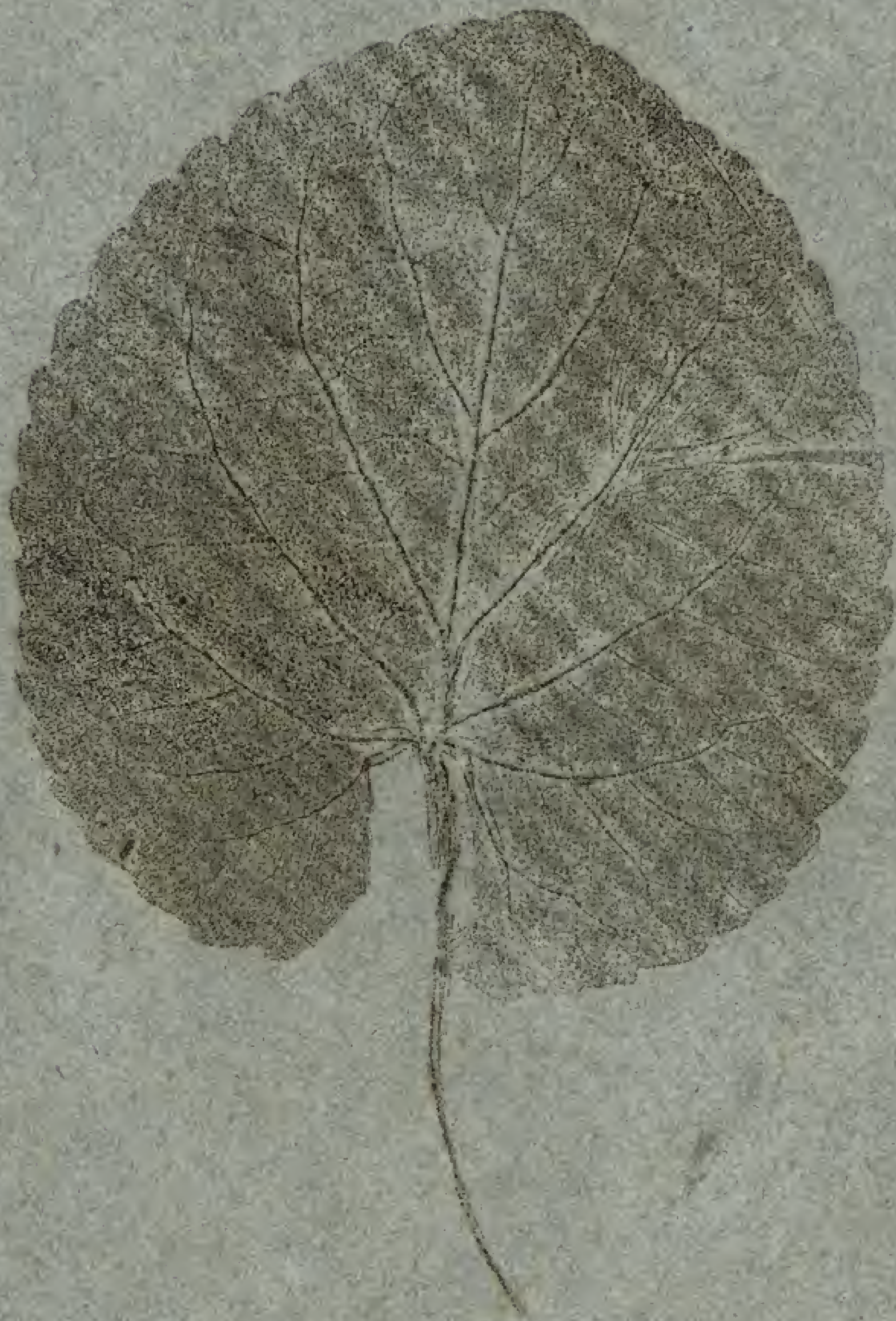
