Madrid Debate Continues Over Draft Objectors

MADRID, July 7 (UPI)—The Spanish Cortes (parliament) today resumed debate of a government bill legalizing the status of conscientious objectors after passing two key paragraphs in a night session.

Articles I and II of the bill passed last night state that a special, unarmed service is to be created within the Spanish armed forces for conscientious objectors and that objectors will have to serve three years—twice the average duration of military service in Spain—in the special branch.

India Reportedly Asks U.S. To Stop All Aid to Pakistan

NEW DELHI, July 7 (AP).—Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and other Indian officials asked the United States today to stop all military and economic aid to Pakistan in an effort to end the civil strife in East Pakistan and secure the return of seven million refugees from India, official Indian sources reported. They said the requests were made to Henry Kissinger, President Nixon's national security adviser, along with a warning that the East Pakistan crisis must be settled quickly. "We can't live with it for a long period," one high official said. "The time factor is of extreme importance."

Uganda Shuts Its Borders To Tanzania

KAMPALA, Uganda, July 7 (Reuters).—The Ugandan government announced tonight that it was closing its borders with Tanzania. At the same time the government declared the Tanzanian Minister for Finance and Administration, John Malecela, persona non grata. A statement issued from the office of President Idi Amin said closure of the borders and the barring of Mr. Malecela were to be effected immediately. President Amin had announced last week that he had postponed a planned visit to Malawi because of security problems on the border with Tanzania.

U. of Miami Medical Class Picks Maimonides, Not Hippocrates

MIAMI, July 7 (AP).—Because the Hippocratic oath bans abortions, the University of Miami's 1971 crop of doctors instead took the oath of Maimonides, which pledges them to "never see in the patient anything but a fellow creature in pain." The oath of Maimonides is shorter and more general in nature. It does not specifically mention abortion, as the Hippocratic oath does. A university official said he considered the Maimonides pledge more in keeping with modern times and free of outdated concepts contained in the oath of Hippocrates. When medical school Dean E.M. Papper gave the students a choice of reciting either of the two oaths at their graduation, the vote was unanimously in favor of the "prayer" composed by Rabbi Moses Ben Maimon, a Spanish Jew who lived from 1135 to 1204, and practiced medicine in Morocco and Egypt.

Zambians Attack French Embassy

LUSAKA, Zambia, July 7 (Reuters).—Zambian students stormed the French Embassy here today during a demonstration to protest France's decision to allow South Africa to build a bridge over the Zambezi river. They broke through the police cordon and began to throw bricks and stones at the building. Two of them scaled a wall and tore down the French flag, which they handed to their comrades, who ripped it to shreds.

Thousands Join Italian Walkouts

Civil Servants, Paper Workers, Busmen Out ROME, July 7 (AP).—Italy's summer strike wave gained new force today as tens of thousands of state workers joined other categories in walkouts throughout the country. The 24-hour nationwide strike of state workers demanding new seniority rules came as thousands of workers of the paper industry started a two-day walkout, the Milan city buses, streetcars and subway stopped for seven hours and Rome hotel workers went into the seventh day of a strike.

A national hotel-worker strike, the fifth in the current tourist season, has been called for July 12, 13 and 14, despite the government's arbitration efforts. The latest hotel strike at the end of last week continued during the weekend for two more days in the big tourist cities and was extended to a seventh day in Rome, where the walkout is scheduled to end tonight.

A 24-hour strike by 4,000 maritime workers in Genoa ended today. The strike, which added to the setback of Italy's most chaotic tourist season in years, had blocked 14 ships and halted the passenger liner Michelangelo's departure for New York.

As a result of Milan's public transportation stoppage, huge traffic jams were reported all over the downtown area. In Milan, personnel of chain stores called for wildcat strikes this week and, in Rome, civil employees in the Ministry of Defense went into the second day of a walkout for more pay.

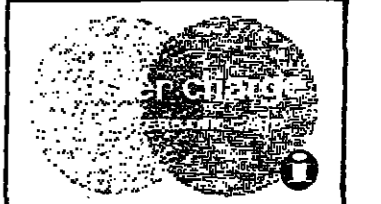
Poet Yevtushenko Criticizes Soviet Literary Hierarchy

MOSCOW, July 7 (UPI).—The sometimes unpopular Soviet poet Yevgeny Yevtushenko, in a speech published today, complained that the literary establishment does not entrust the management of literary affairs to writers of his generation and demanded an end to the recurrence of Stalin-era evils. The speech was made to the quadrennial Congress of Writers, which met in the Kremlin last week. Presumably because of the death of the three Soviet cosmologists, the full texts were not published earlier in the Literaturnaya Gazeta. "My contemporaries," Mr. Yevtushenko, 38, told the 500 delegates, "are at the controls of cosmic ships but the only controls they are not trusted with are our literary magazines."

"Toys of Grown-Ups" "Everybody (those who run the writers union) thinks we still are children and cannot be trusted with the toys of grown-ups, which we may break because of inexperience," he said. As if to confirm Mr. Yevtushenko's complaint, the congress elected the new leadership of the Writers Union—a 226-man board of directors, most of whom are over 60. The union has 7,000 members. Its daily affairs are managed by a 45-man secretariat whose chairman is the 79-year-old novelist Konstantin Fedin. The executive secretary is conservative writer Georgi Markov, 60. Mr. Fedin was so feeble last week that he was unable to deliver the keynote address to the congress, a job done by Mr. Markov.

"Certain Tragic Aspects" Mr. Yevtushenko, who often shocks his Soviet as well as his foreign audiences on his trips abroad, reminded the writers of the painful disclosures in the 1950s, after Stalin's death, of "certain tragic aspects of our past."

U.S. College Student Gored In Pamplona's Bull Running

PAMPLONA, Spain, July 7 (UPI).—An American college student was seriously gored and 15 other persons suffered lesser injuries today in the traditional running of the bulls here in the San Fermín Festival. The injured American is a Brown University student who came here for research on his thesis on Ernest Hemingway, who immortalized the San Fermín Festival in "The Sun Also Rises." A spokesman at the military hospital said William Grickis, 21, of Cheshire, Conn., underwent surgery for goring in his left armpit and back. He said Mr. Grickis's life was not in danger but estimated that he would have to stay at the clinic for two weeks. Mr. Grickis was one of hundreds of youths who took part in the running of the bulls shortly after sunrise. As thousands cheered them on, the six fighting bulls for the afternoon's corrida were released from their corrals on the other side of town to run through barricaded streets to the bullring. Running in front of them were the aficionados. Many were caught and tossed by the bulls, but only Mr. Grickis was seriously hurt. "I heard the bull come up behind me and turned my head," Mr. Grickis said in a telephone interview from his hospital bed. "Then his horn caught me."

Greek Air Hijacker Sentenced in Sweden

STOCKHOLM, July 7 (Reuters).—A 43-year-old Greek doctor, Vasilos Tsironis, was jailed here today for three and a half years for hijacking an Olympic Airways plane from Greece to Albania in August, 1969. He is the second person to be jailed in Sweden for a hijack offense. Under Swedish law, foreigners can be tried for offenses committed abroad. Early last year, the Swedish government approved prosecution of Dr. Tsironis when international action was called for to combat hijacking.

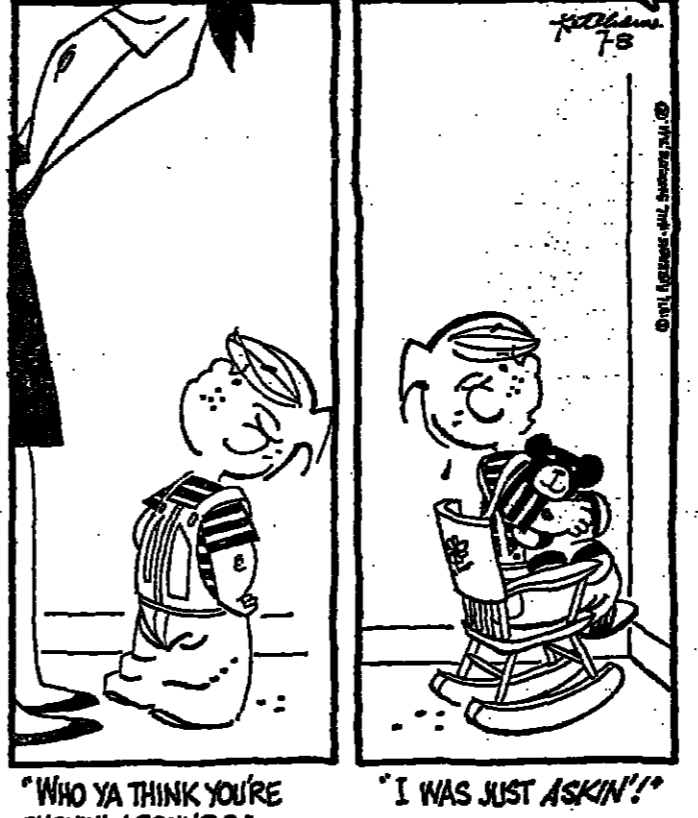

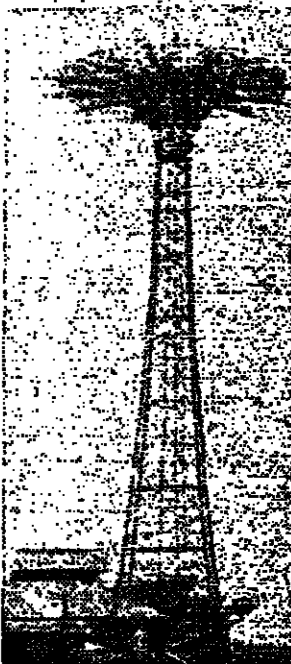
