## In Memory of My Brother MOHAMMAD REZA PAHLAVI

 The Late Shahanshah of Iran

He strove to eradicate poverty，hunger ignorance and disease in his country and beyond．He worked for peace in his region and in the worid．In the 37 years of his reign，Iran was a force for calm and stability in a turbulent region fraught with rebellion，war and rratricide．in world pointics， he preached friendship among nations and counseled peace
He believed that people everywhere were children of the same God and shared in the same
 person wrong．He was a good man．
Here healivetoday，he would rageagainst the atrocities that are dally committed by an oppresso regime in the name of his people．He would also condemn those who unjustly attribute the oppressor＇s barbarism to the oppressed，and this iall to honor he aspir for the future justly proud of its past，and painfully conscious of the burden it carres for the future
To Iranians he would say：Be strong．Do not lose hope Look into your souls．You will know that your futurels inyour own hands．Only you can castighfully yours．Unite and smite the oppressor can recapure ACHRAF PAHLAMI God bless his soul．
