1. Respectfully urge reconsideration decision your #3794.
1777 #6821.

2. Present commitment 50 Norwegians to SCOTCO involves fol-
lowing considerations:

A. Norwegian CO's originally recruited and theater approval
their use secured because our repeated insistence OAS participation
Norwegian operations.

B. Their approval their use Norway secured December and their
inclusion as part of forces available to Allied Command for work in
operation Norwegian Underground eagerly welcomed by Norwegian gov-
ernment and High Command as concrete and substantial OAS American
contribution towards Norwegian liberation.

C. Decision reached January to reduce strength personnel this
purpose by over 1/2 because of priority Far Eastern operations ex-
plained with difficulty on grounds internal reorganization.

D. Strategic personnel now admitted as important part of over-
all plan afforded high SHAW priority for impeding withdrawal German
divisions from Norway. Advance party of 3 scheduled leave tonight and
additional 20 to leave next week February. Target plans being per-
formed for balance. Withdrawal this personnel would throw burden on
British and Norwegians to improvise means of carrying out commitment
scheduled at this time by OAS. Consternation S7 F2 would be alle-
viated only on British side by satisfaction certain quarters at evi-
dence American inability pursue consistent policy.

E. Norwegian Command which has given us enthusiastic coopera-
tion could view withdrawal only as unfriendly or utterly irresponsi-
ble.

F. Last minute withdrawal Norwegian personnel would constitute
repudiation by OAS of our verbal assurances of participation and as-
surance given to (A) British and British representatives G-3 SHAW.

(2) British Commander and American Deputy Commander Norwegian Force, (3) Norwegian High Command, (4) American and British representatives CTF.

3. Finally Norwegian personnel have repeatedly expressed their personal desire service in Norway and final selection these men to remain so this theater made to appreciable extent on representation their commitment forthcoming Norwegian operation. Cancellation operation and implying that for operations at time German collapse would create serious morale problem and certainly factor to be considered.

3. USSTAF has been repeatedly warned difficulties securing personnel for POW project and failure fulfill commitment while extremely embarrassing would be far less so than to go back on Norwegian commitment.

4. Therefore recommend:

A. That SO Personnel fulfill Norwegian commitment.

B. If impossible obtain OG's we will contact SHAEP and USSTAF immediately and explain situation, suggesting that they make available 1 company airborne troops. We in turn will provide instruction, supplies, briefing and small nucleus of Jedburgh type officers. We can probably get together here approximately 6. If this plan is acceptable suggest earmarking from all sources as many Jedburgh type officers as possible for this operation. Have in mind Captains Barata, Pietsch, Dussacq, Lieuts. Lozano, Levitine and Sanchez; and if they have radio training, Sgts. Borada, Klonak and Skokoski, all understood to be in Washington at the present time. Cts. Robert Anstett and Lucien Conain should also be held if available.

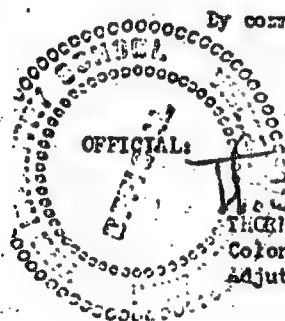
