Marcalinu Malendreras - Left Cuba (Havana) 29 July via Harico. Ho. . Was in Mexico City 10 days and arrived in Hew Urieans Saturday, 10 August.

Prior to the command et government ho worked in Productora do Suparfosfatos (Superphosphaftes Pretors) of Regla. Teas this factory was confiscated and Included in the Consolidado do Fertillsantes (FoLilizer Consolidated) he performed the duties of Assistant to the Cilef in the Pechnelogy Department. Ifs services ended when he resigned a week before his trip. He informed we that the number of Russians has increased considerably and that when it was reported over short wave that a goodly part of them wore returning to their country they were arriving in $\AA$ number larger than tho oe who were leering. Those which are seen in the streets of Havana are as many as the Cubans who also walks on them.
