Following is a translation of a report submitted by AMWUG-1 concerning a shipment of explosives [redacted]

"The Communist Party [redacted] had asked me to send them twenty-five one-quarter pound packages of gelatin explosives. They requested that the explosives be sent [redacted] where they would receive them and take them to [redacted]

'In view of the request, I spoke with [redacted] regarding the shipment itself, as well as the amount. [redacted] answered by telling me to do so.

'During my trip [redacted] (March 1954) I spoke with [redacted] regarding this shipment and he told me that there was no need of my sending the explosives [redacted] as this type of explosive was available in the [redacted] I then told [redacted] that I would answer the request from [redacted]

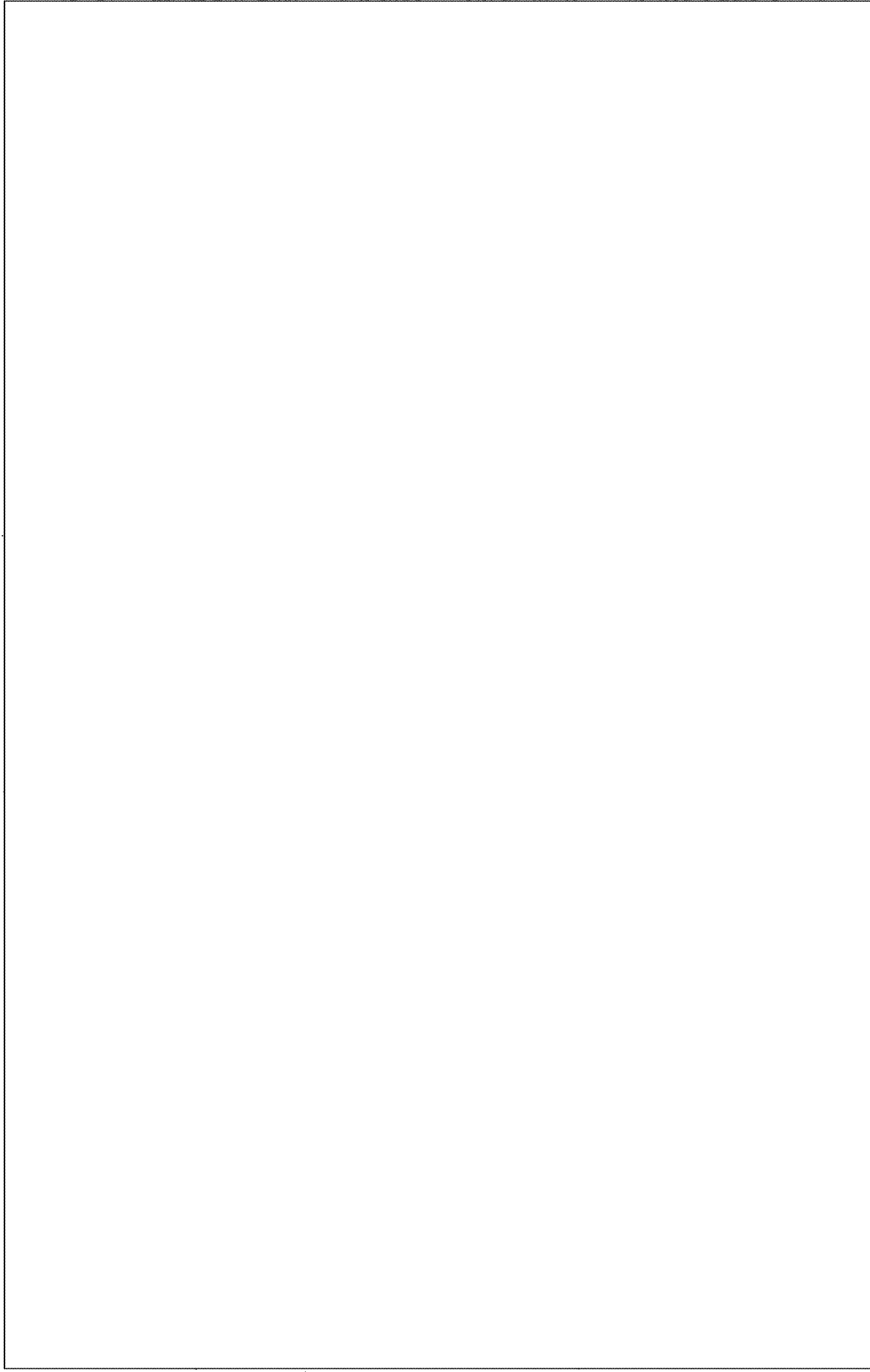
'Upon returning [redacted] I spoke with [redacted] who told me not to send the explosives as the orders now were to send nothing but money due to the recent exposure of the arms shipment [redacted]

SUBJECT : Meeting with LITAMIL-9, 6 January 1964

1. A meeting was held with L-9 from 2000 hours until 2320 hours 6 Jan -- pick-up and drop-off were made by car, the meeting took place at B's home with B's wife working the gate.

2. L-9 was unusually depressed -- had just received a letter from [redacted] indicating that his sister had been forced to leave her work as a result of excessive fatigue and the "never ending round of discussions and study circles" etc. She had not received much sympathy from the [redacted] and her request for 2 months leave [redacted] was denied pending further study. L-9, who is quite fond of his sisters, took this news to heart and it ate away at him and compounded his usual miserable feeling. The first part of the meeting was taken up in a C/O delivered pep talk.

3. L-9 had the following to report:

a. At the evening reception of 2 Jan [redacted] the TASS representative remarked that he believed KHRUSHCHEV did not travel to Cuba to attend the anniversary celebrations because of the revelation of an exile plot to bomb Havana -- revelations which came about as the result of the arrest by the US Coast Guard of some war-like Cubans with bombs in their possession. The TASS man said that he believed that KHRUSHCHEV would show up someday in Havana quite unannounced as did CASTRO in the USSR.

b. [redacted] APARICIO recently remarked to L-9, "Surely they will re-hire her." It is quite clear that APARICIO doesn't want her in his office again and he expressed the wish that if she were to be rehired she would work in the main [redacted] building.

c. In regard to the [redacted] firing, [redacted] who is married to [redacted] sister, said that he had written to [redacted] in her behalf but had received no reply.

d. [redacted] sent a Christmas present [redacted] this year -- it was really a New Year's present, sent 31 Dec. L-9 does not know what it was.

4. L-9 was asked what all the ruckus was at the airport on 5 Jan. This drew a blank. B then said he had heard that a phalanx of [redacted] officers was out there apparently guarding someone who was on his way [redacted] L-9 didn't know anything about it. B remarked that two [redacted] officials were supposedly on the flight [redacted] -- one from the [redacted] At this point, L-9 slapped his forehead and said, "My God, [redacted] I forgot about him." He then related the details of a conversation he had had with [redacted] at the [redacted] 2 Jan -- details sent to HQS separately by cable. (See MEXI 7659). L-9 was not aware that [redacted] had been on the 5 Jan flight -- he described him perfectly. He was not made aware of KUBARK involvement in the alleged "assault" nor was he told anything about [redacted] appearance at TPELIDE.

5. L-9 identified a number of persons appearing in the photos taken [redacted] at the [redacted] 2 Jan. Identifications were noted

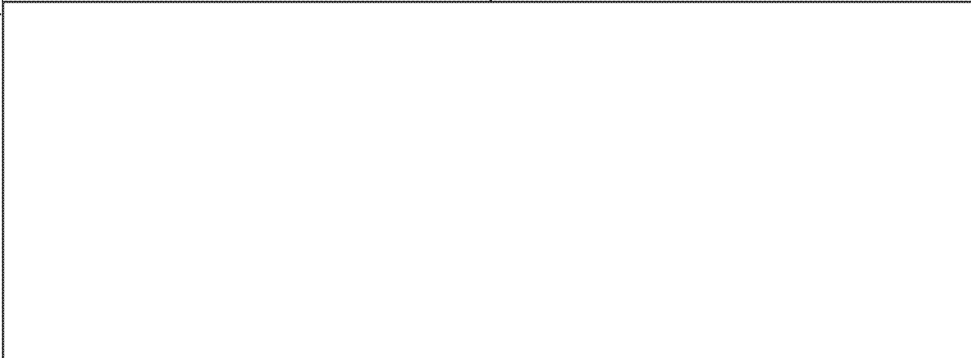

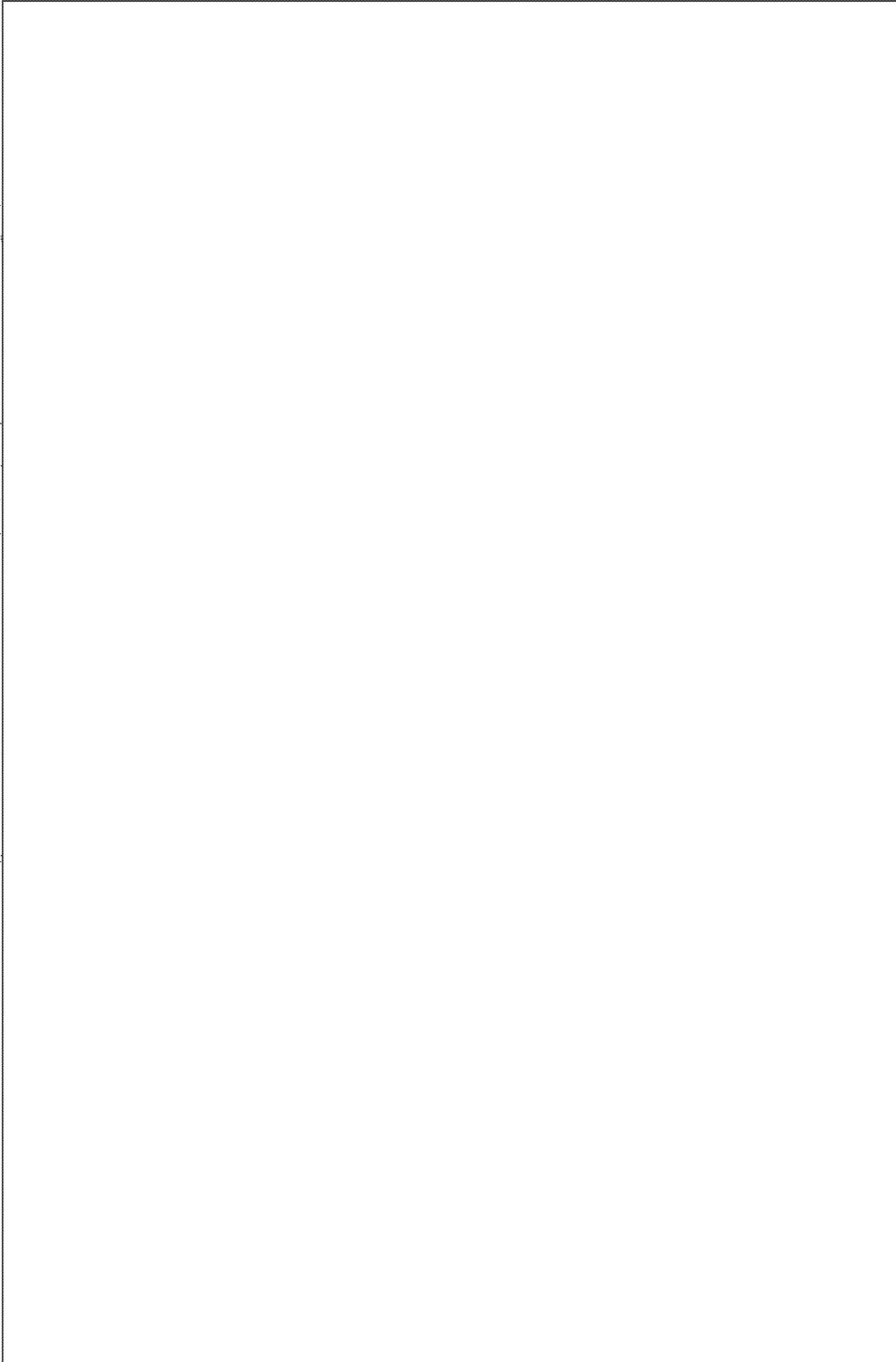
6. L-9 revealed that he had welcomed in the New Year at [redacted] home -- [redacted] invitation. When [redacted] picked him up [redacted] they made a swing by a house [redacted] where [redacted] wanted to drop a couple of bottles off with a friend named Mary [redacted] L-9 tried to remain in the car -- was not dressed for calling -- but [redacted] insisted that he come in. [redacted] was not there but her sister was -- she had just recently arrived [redacted] another [redacted] man and woman were there -- anti-Castro types who were very sad at being away from their homeland -- the man was softly crying -- probably a bit liquored up. [redacted] fit right in -- L-9 says that he is a master at getting along with people, even those on the other side of the political fence. (This tallies with info on file). The [redacted] landlady -- an old crone -- tried to put the make on L-9, really flipped for him, and wanted him to stay but he and [redacted] finally drove off. L-9 does not know who these people are (to be checked out). They then went over to [redacted] place where L-9 joined the family for a [redacted] dinner. [redacted] mother-in-law was there -- she recently came out [redacted] to be with her daughter [redacted] while she has a baby -- due soon. [redacted] appeared soon thereafter and joined in the meal. [redacted] put on some popular and light classical records, working his way from dance music to Tchaikovsky. When a carload of [redacted] people -- [redacted] and wife. [redacted] appeared in front [redacted] quickly took off the music [redacted] the new arrivals were greeted with this as they came in the door. L-9 says that [redacted] is a superb actor and knew just what to do when the [redacted] types showed up.

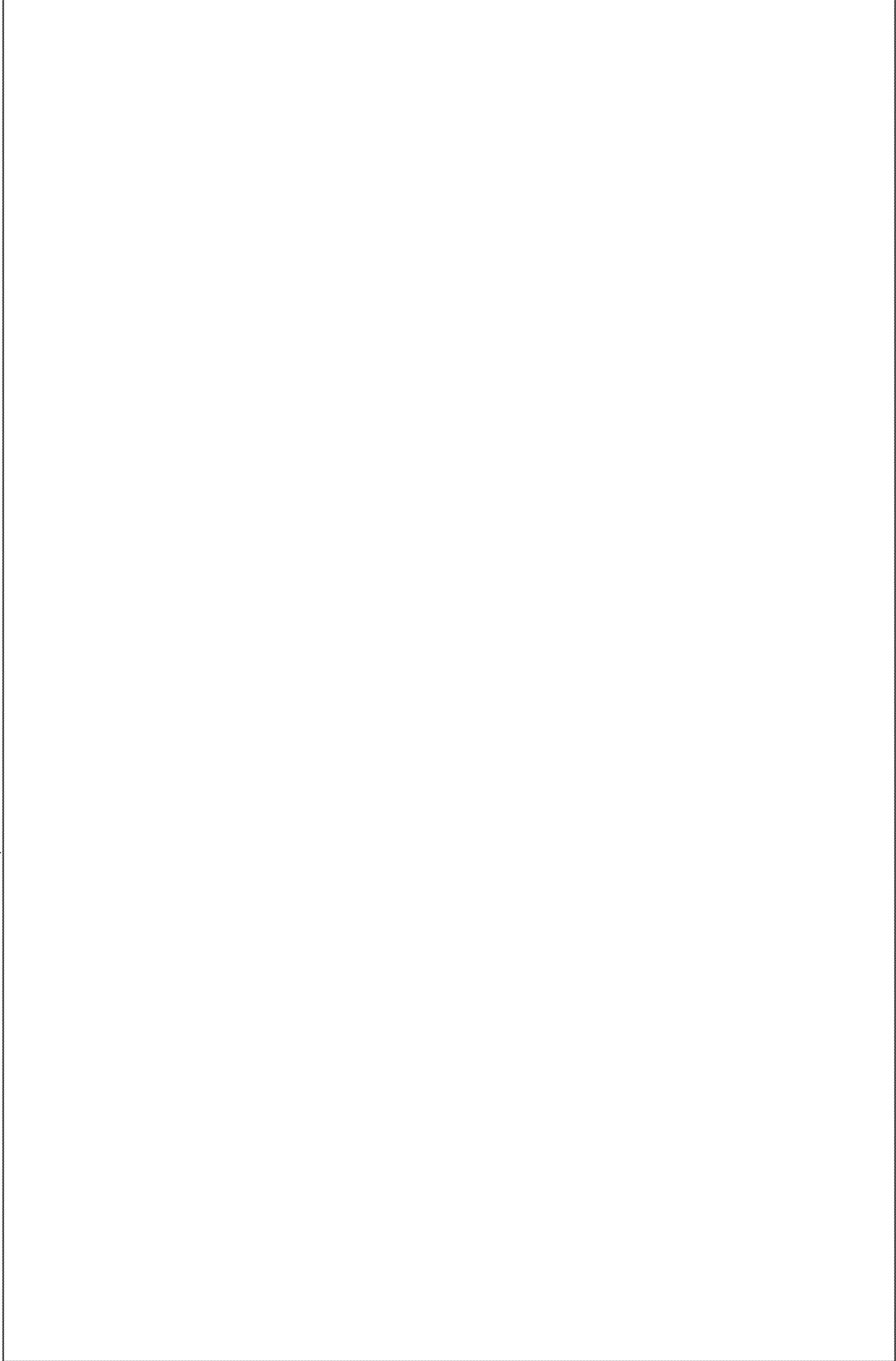
7. In response to questioning L-9 revealed that [redacted] looks upon him [redacted] definitely not a Communist. He says that [redacted] is very self assured, a calm man who cannot be ruffled. He appears to have no complexes about being a Negro. Asked whether he felt there might be any chance that [redacted] would cooperate against CASTRO, L-9 said, "Let us face the fact that many people are becoming more and more convinced that the revolution is here to stay. This man [redacted] is one of them. On the other hand, if he could be "got to" he would be invaluable. He would be a great loss to the [redacted] I would say that the chances are slim but it would probably be worth the effort to try to win him over. He has many friends from all walks of life, many of them among the [redacted] elements."

8. L-9 showed B some documents regarding Cultural plans of the [redacted] which did not seem to merit reporting. He turned over two long lists of persons invited to the 2 Jan receptions.
