4. REPORT OF FINDINGS			
<p>On 5 February 1959, Agency A-M reported that [REDACTED], [REDACTED], received a letter from her mother on 26 January 1959 stating substantially the following:</p> <p>[REDACTED]'s mother sent [REDACTED] a birthday package which was opened by the East German postal authorities. The package contained a few clothing items, a piece of sausage and a can of hash. It is forbidden to send sausage and hash through the mail, therefore the package was returned to [REDACTED]'s mother. The package was very messed up and returned in bad shape. [REDACTED]'s mother received a notice to report to the police station in Langenstein (nca), East Germany. She feels that she is to be charged for trying to ship unauthorized items through the mails.</p> <p>AGENT'S NOTES: There also exists the possibility that the police wish to question [REDACTED]'s mother about [REDACTED]. This also indicated that the police or East German postal authorities are maintaining censorship on mail coming to [REDACTED] from East Germany. An investigation was conducted on [REDACTED] under dossier number GE-011806.</p>
