






































SEEIN' IS BELIEVIN'

THE FLYING CIGAR

In the spring of 1954, some 4,000 citizens of Birmingham, Alabama, watched a very large, cigar-shaped "saucer" hover over the city for a full hour. Forty planes went up and circled it during that sixty minutes. At times the object faded out and then just as suddenly it reappeared again. Called upon for an explanation of the phenomenon the local newspapers alleged it to be a reflection of light from gas-furnaces, or the lights of a small private plane.

CAUGHT BY THE CAMERA

While flying in an airliner, 13,500 feet above the Hardanger-vidde plateau in Norway, during a total eclipse of the sun on July 1, 1954, a photographer took a color film from the window of the cabin, as did two other cameramen. When the pictures were processed, all the photographers were surprised to see in the center, below the solar corona, an oval glowing white disc standing out against the blackness of the sky. This disc had moved rapidly across the skyline into the range of the camera lenses.



FLIGHT ENIGMA

In January, 1954 an extraordinary unknown object was seen high over the beach at St. Kilda, near Melbourne, Australia. The object, like a large sheet of aluminum, rocked from side to side, and flashed in the sunshine. Each flash was accompanied by an enveloping purple halo. It did not seem to give off light of its own, emitted no vapor, and looked like a large silver butterfly. Its speed was computed at 1,800 miles an hour at an altitude of 30,000 feet. Its width was estimated at over 300 feet.

FULL SPEED AHEAD

An English farmer was amazed to see a large saucer travelling behind a jet plane, which it gradually overtook, near Bedford, England. The saucer was discoidal transparent, and flew directly over the jet plane. Its speed was in the vicinity of 1,200 miles per hour. (August, 1954).

DRIFTING ALONG



While walking on a Los Angeles thoroughfare on the evening of October 6, 1955, a California resident noticed three round, white objects — drifting soundlessly from south to north. Each of the craft left vapor trails about 10 feet long, which soon dissolved into thin air. Inasmuch as no tall buildings obstructed her view, Miss Lindquist was able to observe the unidentified flying objects, which remained in full view for several minutes as they approached and pass-

ed. Two of them turned gradually to the east and disappeared, while the other continued north until it also disappeared. The saucers appeared to be in no hurry, and travelled at a pace equivalent to that of a helicopter.

THE MYSTERY SAUCER

On November 8, 1954 a group of 150 spectators in Monza, Italy, watched a mysterious luminous body and two small shadowy objects who wore white pants, grey jerkins, and transparent helmets, as they rested in the middle of a sports stadium. Bricks were thrown but when they struck the saucer, there was no clang. They seemed to have impacted on some soft material. The crowd broke down the gates and rushed the saucer entities, who retreated to the disc. The strange invaders got aboard the disc, and with a whuff and




strange invaders got aboard the disc, and with a whuff and a shrill siren hoot, it rose vertically from the field and vanished at high speed.

HUMAN OR BEAST?

A 12 year old youth residing on a farm at Coldwater, Kansas saw a small man approaching him while he was riding on a tractor. The man then changed his course and ran towards a saucer hovering 5 feet in the air. He jumped in and soon vanished from sight. The saucer was 50 feet wide and lights shone from portholes as it ascended. The man he had seen was dark, wore shiny clothing and had two cylinders on his back. Later the local sheriff, together with the


