How it has been determined that this address exists in Wilkinsburg, Pa., which is located on the Eastern boundary of the city of Pittsburgh. A review of the cross telephone directory reflects that WALTER B. MORTON, JR., resides at this address. Referenced teletypes reflect that WALTER BENSON MORTON, JR., 415 Whitney Avenue, Pittsburgh, Pa., was a passenger in the car belonging to the subjects on April 7, 1951, when this car was involved in an accident on U. S. Highway, Route 30, near Irwin, Pa. Postal Inspector GEORGE EVANS, New Federal Building, Pittsburgh, Pa., advised on July 27, 1951, that MORTON left a forwarding address with the Wilkinsburg, Pa., Post Office effective June 1, 1951, of 1019 Chelton Street, Philadelphia, Pa.

As indicated in referenced teletype of April 14, 1951, MORTON is the subject of a Security Index card in the Pittsburgh Office, Pittsburgh file 100-102080, Bufile 100-371516.
