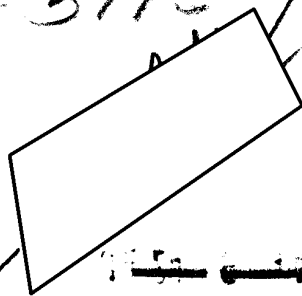

The winning numbers are derived from the weekly drawing of the Puerto Rico National Lottery (PRNL), and are comprised of the last three digits of the 5-digit "Grand Prize" PRNL winning number.

The specimen Q2 adding machine tapes contain figures which correspond with the amounts found on several specimen Q1 wagering slips.

Specimen Q3 bears notations which set forth commissions received by each controller in addition to salaries paid to office personnel. Further notations indicate this operation is split into two groups identified as "CHICAGO" and "SOUTH."

You will be advised separately of the result of fingerprint examination and disposition of submitted material.

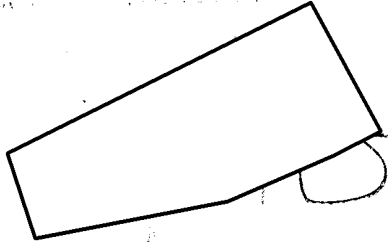

THE CONVERSATIONS THAT WILL BE MONITORED ON AUGUST 13, 1980, AND AUGUST 20, 1980, WILL BE INITIALED BY SOURCE WHILE OCCUPYING ROOM 127 WITH [REDACTED] THESE CONVERSATIONS WILL ATTEMPT TO ILLICIT THE AMOUNTS OF WAGES FOR THE WEEK; THE CONTROL OF KEN ETO AND [REDACTED] OF THE GAMBLING BUSINESS AND ANY OTHER SUBJECTS INVOLVED IN THE OPERATION.

KEN ETO HAS BEEN HANDLING BLACK NUMBERS OPERATIONS AND BOLITA GAMBLING FOR THE CHICAGO MOB SINCE 1956. UNTIL THIS PRESENT INVESTIGATION, THE CHICAGO DIVISION HAS NOT BEEN ABLE TO OBTAIN EVIDENCE OR WITNESSES TO INDICT ETO. WITH

SUCCESSFUL PROSECUTION OF KEN ETO, JOSEPH DI VARCO AND JOSEPH FERRIOLLA, LCN BOSSESS WILL LOSE A SUBSTANTIAL AMOUNT OF REVENUE AND A TRUSTED CONTACT WITH THE LATINO COMMUNITY IN PARTICULAR. THE FBI LABORATORY ESTIMATES THAT THE RECORDS THEY HAVE EXAMINED REPRESENT AN ILLEGAL GAMBLING BUSINESS TAKING \$60,000.00 A WEEK.

THE RECORDING DEVICE TO BE USED IN BOTH INSTANCES WILL BE INSTALLED ON AUGUST 12, 1980. ROOM 125 WILL BE OCCUPIED BY AGENTS AND THE RECORDING DEVICE WILL BE REMOVED AS SOON AS THE SOURCE LEAVES ROOM 127 ON AUGUST 13, 1980, AND WILL NOT BE RE-INSTALLED UNTIL AUGUST 19, 1980, REMOVING THE DEVICE AS SOON AS THE SOURCE LEAVES THE ROOM ON AUGUST 20, 1980.

SOURCE HAS FURNISHED A WRITTEN CONSENT TO USE THE DEVICE AND IS WILLING TO TESTIFY IN COURT. DEVICE WILL ONLY BE USED WHEN CONSENTING SOURCE IS PRESENT.

It was concluded that the adding machine impressions appearing on Q1b, Q1d, Q1e, Q1g, Q1h, Q1k, Q1m, Q1r, Q1s, Q1u, Q1x, Q1z, Q1aa through Q1ad, Q1ah, Q1ai, Q1aj, Q1ak, Q1am, Q1ap, Q1as, Q1au, Q3b, Q3d, Q6a, Q6c, Q6f, Q6g, Q7a, Q11, and Q14 were not prepared on the adding machines designated Q4a and Q4b.

Narrative of Offense:

The investigation was predicated upon informant information and past organized crime investigations in the Chicago Division since 1956. This investigation disclosed that subject, Ken Eto was a close associate of such organized crime figures in Chicago as Vincent Solano, Northside Boss, Joseph Arnold, known LCN member, Joseph DiVarco, known LCN member, and the deceased Ross Prio, former gambling boss for the LCN. Subject Ken Eto, according to informant information and certification by FBI investigation, in case 182-1203, that Ken Eto controlled the numbers and policy operations in the Chicago area for the LCN in Chicago. Informant information as of 1979 stated that Eto was once again handling gambling for the LCN and in particular bolita, which is a number wagering played primarily by the Latino individuals.

In June, 1980, a confidential source was able to supply information that Ken Eto was in fact, running Bolita gambling in the Chicago and the Northwest Indiana areas. This confidential source supplied information implicating [redacted] Chicago and California LCN associate and known cocaine dealer, as the financial backer and partner with Eto in the Bolita gambling business. The confidential source further identified subject [redacted] as the collector and, the tabulator of the bolita wagers, the percentages paid to the runners, and writers of the bolita gambling.

FBI surveillances on several occasions placed Ken Eto and [redacted] at two different locations tabulating bolita wagers on Wednesdays. The confidential source supplied the wagering paraphellia, dating from April, 1980, through August, 1980, and according to FBI Laboratory reports, the illegal gambling business was accepting wagers for approximately \$60,000.00 a week from what was referred to in gambling records as the "northside" and "Indiana."

FBI Laboratory further has identified subjects' latent fingerprints on gambling records seized in the August 20, 1980 search and those records previously were provided by the informant.

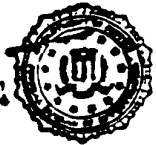

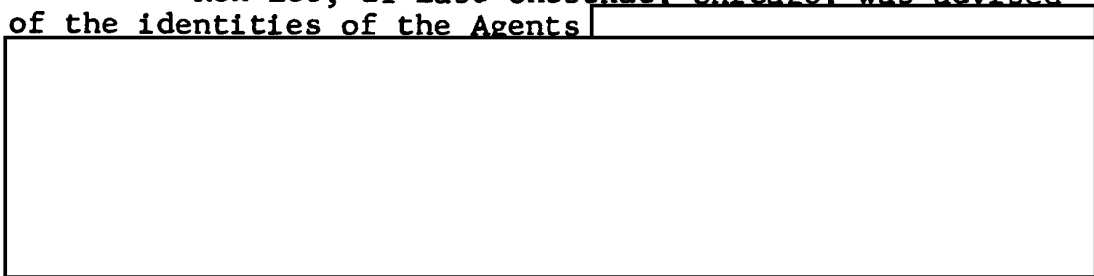

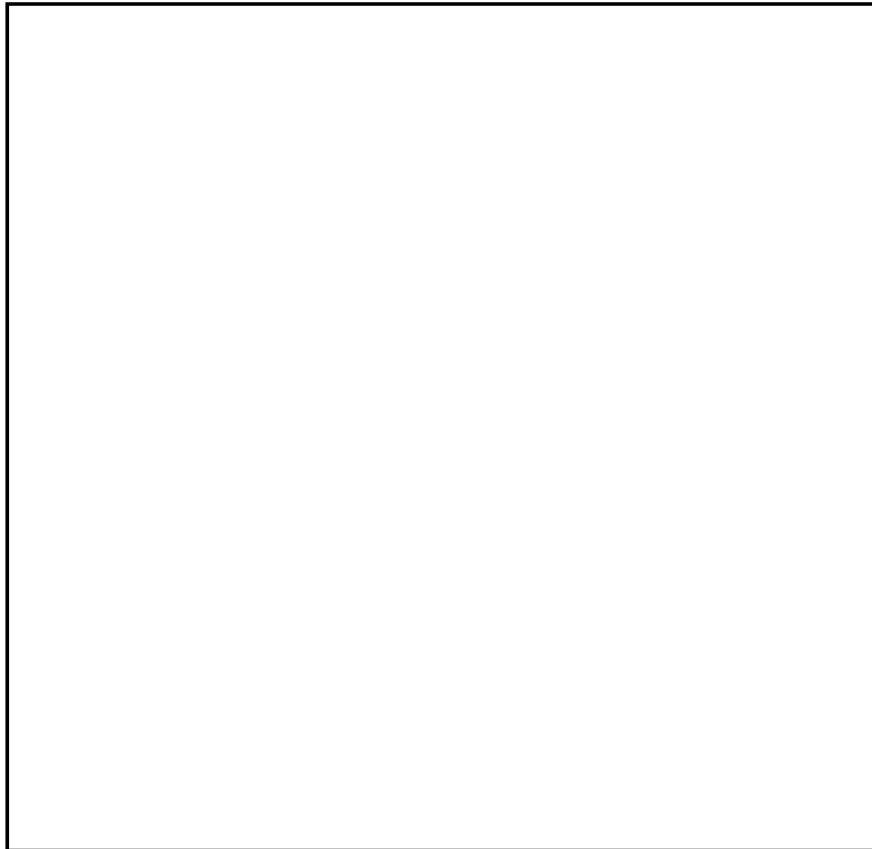
