SUMMARY OF REFERENCES

HEYNEH, H. (MOLA-5081)

SHAMP Card 226878 - HEYNEH, SS Oberwachführer; assistant Grenz Kommissariat Glöbe; believed to have been in Landsberg in April 1945; born about 1910; physical description: thin blond hair, almost bald, long head, full face, looks undernourished.

SHAMP Card 136810 - Heinz HEYNEH, Abwehr member, Funker, transferred from OKW Aussondierungsstelle Stamsdorf to 1st Ukrain in December 1941. Born in Bochum on 18 January 1912, resided at Bochum Langengraben, Kolonnenstrasse 1.

We are inclined to agree, however, that subject may be identical with Werner HEYNEH. Following supplementary traces on Werner HEYNEH: WSM-720, dated 22 December 1949: Werner HEYNEH, born 3 April 1885 in Moers, a German technician with experience in the production of arms and munitions, was recently recruited by the Spanish Government.

WEMA-1221, dated 5 August 1950: Source Quack lunched with a German named HEYNEH who holds a five year contract with IRI as chief of the machinery group of German engineers employed by IRI. HEYNEH has just toured Spain and has inspected over fifty large industrial enterprises. (Headquarters Comment: This HEYNEH is probably identical with Werner HEYNEH)

FRIESE, H. E. (HOLA-5061)

SECRET Card 128218; Heinz FRIESE, Feldwebel in Abwehr; transferred from Nachschub Dienststelle Walli to Trupp 204 in August 1943. FRIESE was born 15 June 1918 in Brauberg. Home address: Residenzstrasse 28, Berlin Reinickendorf/Cst.

WOKA-10168, 11 August 1949; Heinz FRIESE, Antifa graduate of Camp 201 at Yalitsa; released December 1948.

Memo from 12 Berlin Intelligence Staff, SAOR 2, 28 May 1950; One Gustav FRIESE, born circa 1906, tall, slender, included in a list of Germans who are reported to be informants of Allied officers but who are actually working for Kurt Eduard von SCHNITZLER of the R.I.S.

SCHUELER, Ernst (HOLA-5061) No identifiable traces other than: XI-1470, 18 September 1944, Gefreiter Ernst SCHUELER, member of the Abwehr in Moscow; used fieldpost No. 10006 in May 1944.

SOSHOVBE (HOLA-5061) No identifiable traces.
