

KNOCHEN, Helmut

1. 1st Detailed Interrogation Report on Friedrich BERGER, XARZ 4358, 5 July 45  
CSDIC/CMF/SD 38 LONDON X-2 Pts 73, doc 22, folder 1, box 1

Document identifies KNOCHEN, Dr. as SS Standardtenfuhrer, BdS Paris 1943 - August 1944. Removed from office after withdrawal to Fraize. October 1944 degraded and sent to Eastern front as a private for reasons unknown. Said to have been killed in action. Age about 43. About 1.82 m tall, strong build, broad shoulders, oval face, fair hair, clean shaven, sometimes wears glasses.

(cf: CSDIC/CMF/SD 29 para 4 a, where he is said to have been degraded for alleged cowardice in evacuation from Metz, but shortly afterwards rehabilitated and SSDIC/(UK)/SIR/1018).
