That's an iucredible 60\% wins and ouly 40 draws. Dave Grahar won the Top Board gane playing Aostria. No other Oiplonacy tooruaneut bas 50 bigh a percentage of 18 ceater wins.

The top 6 players shared 3180.00 io cash prizes. 1. Vaghn Heppuer with 27.03 points; 2. Dave Loverasu - 27.85 ; 3. Kepia Kozlowski - 22.81; 1. Dape Grabar - 22.45; 5. Mike Maden - 20.86; 6. Briav Larsou - 19.97.
