Youth and the Bright Medusa is composed of eight short stories published in 1920. Four of them (*The Sculptor's Funeral*; *A Death In The Desert*; *A Wagner Matinee*; *Paul's Case*) are re-worked from an earlier collection, *The Troll Garden*, published in 1905. This LibriVox recording contains in addition the three stories (*Flavia and Her Artists*; *The Garden Lodge*; *The Marriage of Phaedra*) from that earlier work omitted in the later book. In other words, all the stories in both books are recorded here. (Summary by David Wales)
