- Cut out the cover insert, on page 1, around the outer perimeter. Do not cut along the center.

The text should appear around the exterior of the folded cover, not the interior.
- 7. Remove the tray from the case.

- 9. Insert the tray, being careful that the title tabs are flat against the case.
- 10. Please appropriately discard this portion and the scrap bits of paper.
