A Brother Minister (believed to be MALCOLM X LITTLE of New York City) told ELIJAH MUHAMMAD he had been trying to get in to one of the churches in Harlem and arrange for a meeting at which MUHAMMAD would appear. MUHAMMAD replied that he thought this was a good idea and added that there were a lot of people there who needed to hear about Islam.

b7c [redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and asked if [redacted] could come to Philadelphia, as they have something very serious for him to handle. [redacted] continued that it involved a brother who is a very innocent-looking 19 year old, who is involved in the most serious kind of trouble that a man can get in. [redacted] continued: It is in all the daily newspapers on the front page. It is reported this brother is involved in taking the lives of several people in the last three or four months. He was arrested five or six days ago and they have been grilling him since then. The brother has been in the Temple in Philadelphia several times but [redacted] does not know him.

b7c MUHAMMAD replied that he did not think it was necessary to waste money for transportation now that the brother has been arrested. MUHAMMAD asked [redacted] to send him all of the newspaper clippings.

b7c [redacted] reported that [redacted] had been in Philadelphia last night and had spoken to them. [redacted] stated they had had a total attendance of 268, including 59 first-timers and 40 to take forms. MUHAMMAD asked if any of them ever returned. [redacted] reported that last night they had 42 who had returned.

b7c [redacted] asked MUHAMMAD for an interview, stating it would be a question-and-answer deal which would be printed in "True" Magazine, just as MUHAMMAD states. [redacted] it would not be an editorial-type article, but would deal with the goals of the NOI. MUHAMMAD gave approval for an interview at 3:00 p.m., October 3.

b7c ^{10/3/63} [redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD. MUHAMMAD stated he could not permit his ministers to go and speak to the MGT class unless they write to him first, saying what they want to talk about. MUHAMMAD stated he was trying to make his women pure and did not want any men associating with the class.

the town and there was nothing negative. He added he hasn't gotten anything negative from "Satan" or anyone. He added that they had covered the factories when they were getting out and everything was pleasant.

MALCOLM stated he is to speak to some of the "principal" leaders tonight which would include civic, political, religious and social representatives. He said "you know [redacted] is prominent here"

[redacted] He stated it is his intention to get [redacted] to come out and occupy a seat of honor on Sunday.

[redacted] stated that [redacted] had just arrived. MALCOLM asked if [redacted] was going to be up at Flint on Sunday and [redacted] stated he did not know. MALCOLM asked [redacted] to tell [redacted] he hopes he can see him.

[redacted] was in contact with ELIJAH MUHAMMAD and discussed the possibility of getting Minister MALCOLM (LITTLE) to speak to a group of about 150 non-originals on the campus there. ELIJAH MUHAMMAD agreed that the publicity might be good. [redacted] stated many of the students even though they came from the Chicago area, seemed to be unaware of all of the present day problems and injustices. ELIJAH MUHAMMAD questioned the appearance of MALCOLM LITTLE and [redacted] would prepare a report on the situation and submit it in a week or so.

He said Minister MALCOLM would be on the radio at Grand Rapids and Ann Arbor and Detroit, Michigan, and ELIJAH MUHAMMAD stated that would be enough.

Powell And Mr. X Blackjack Bunche

Dr. Ralph Bunche strongly criticized Rep. Adam Powell and Black Muslim leader Malcolm X as "learners" of a "black form of the racial virus," in an address last week, and was bitterly attacked by the two in comments regarding the UN Undersecretary.

"I am very happy to hear anything from Dr. Bunche on the race question. I want to welcome you back into the ranks of the Negro race," Powell declared in a statement to this newspaper. "We hadn't heard anything from him since we helped fight to get his son into the Forest Hills Tennis Club."

Powell had been attacked, he declared. "Dr. Bunche is saying just what he has to say in order to keep his job. When the white man gave him the job, which the white man gave him, runs out, Dr. Bunche will then become Ralph X."

Both Powell and Minister Malcolm X criticized Bunche for attacking Malcolm X, who, along with

Mississippi to make his attacks. "Anytime a Negro goes to Mississippi and wastes his time, energy and breath to attack other Negroes, instead of the white man, he is not a wise warrior," the Muslim leader said.

Dr. Bunche, made his comments in an address at the Negro Tougaloo Southern Christian College in Jackson where his theme was that the social revolution of integration was in the interests of Negroes and whites alike.

After criticizing the segregationist Governors Barnett of Mississippi and Wallace of Alabama, Dr. Bunche warned that extremists on either side were harmful.

He brands him racist.

Expressing amazement at Powell's recent criticisms of the NAACP and other civil rights groups which advocated inter-racial action, Bunche said, "I

always find it difficult to understand how a Negro, like the white supremacists, can espouse separation of the races, even for different reasons.

"I regard Powell's attacks not only as stupid and irresponsible, but as revoltingly racist.

"I reject racists and racism, whoever and wherever they are, and whatever their color, as poisonous and vicious, as evidenced by the infamous so-called White Citizens Councils. I deplore Negroes embracing, as the Black Muslims and Adam Powell have done, a black form of the racist virus."

Later in his address, Bunche said, "I want no one, Malcolm X or anyone else, to tell me to give up this fight because equality is unattainable and to look elsewhere, in some mythical, fanciful state of black men, for my salvation. I say that is surrender and escapism and I want none of it," Bunche added.
