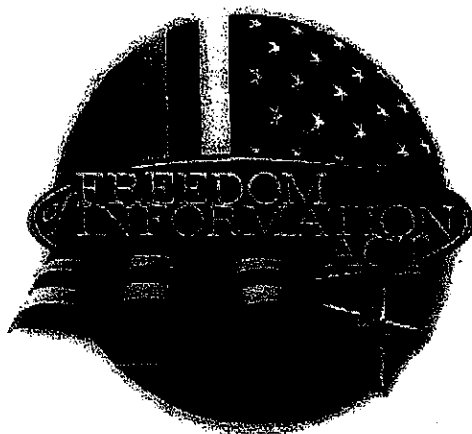

MALCOLM'S PLANS IRK MUSLIMS HERE

He is Denounced as His
Return is Awaited

The New York representatives of Elijah Muhammad's Black Muslim movement are awaiting with concern the return of Malcolm X from Mecca, Saudi Arabia, where the defector was endorsed by the World Muslim Council.

Henry X and Joseph X, the New York representatives of Elijah Muhammad's movement, have denounced Malcolm as a "self-serving hypocrite consumed by a passion for personal power" over America's 20 million Negroes.

In a recent letter from Mecca to a New York friend, Malcolm said he would open an official Muslim Center in New York with the support of the World Muslim Council. The council, he wrote, had promised to send certified teachers, and to provide 15 scholarships for Americans to study at the Islam University in Medina, Saudi Arabia.

The World Muslim Council, founded in 1962, is the supreme religious body in the Muslim World, and is governed by a constituent body of 23 leading scholars from the major Muslim countries. Its headquarters is in Mecca.

Would Halt Attacks

Reflecting the movement's concern over Malcolm's return, Henry X and Joseph X said: "We only want Malcolm to stop attacking Elijah Muhammad, as he did from Mecca when he called him a religious faker. If he doesn't, we will fight him as hard as he fights us."

They said Malcolm's personal reputation was based on a strong supporting movement that enabled him to speak with authority.

"Now that this support has been removed," they said, speaking of the Black Muslims, "we shall see how successful he will be. He now stands alone. We are convinced he will fail because his success depended on the strong support we gave him."

At the same time they confirmed that Elijah Muhammad's son, Wallace, had defected to join forces with Malcolm.

Henry X and Joseph X said they had worked under Malcolm's orders for 12 years while he was building up the Black Muslim movement, which he succeeded finally in projecting onto the national scene.

3-Year Economic Plan

Henry X is assistant minister to James X of Newark, who was appointed by Elijah Muhammad to take over the New York Mosque when Malcolm broke with him last winter. Joseph X is Elijah Muhammad's appointed administrator for the New York area.

Henry X and Joseph X said Elijah Muhammad was launching a three-year economic program to improve the lot of the American Negroes. This program consists of a savings plan that would create funds to purchase farm land, food storage warehouses, and businesses.

They said the movement had established a Muslim Chamber of Commerce that now had about 100 small businessmen as members.

The two said that Malcolm, while giving public lip service to Elijah Muhammad's orders, had constantly ignored instructions and used his "undeniable oratorical and organizing talents" to gain a personal national reputation.

They said it was Malcolm who injected the political concept of "black nationalism" into the Black Muslim movement which they said was essentially religious in nature when Malcolm became a member.

"Malcolm abandoned the religion to become a political sociologist," Henry X charged.

The two said their movement was gaining strength all over the country.

On September 30, 1964, a confidential source with whom there has been insufficient contact to determine reliability, furnished the following information:

On September 28, 1964, a member of the MMI was overheard remarking that when Malcolm X broke with the NOI he formed his own militant group known as the MMI. When the MMI failed to attract a large Negro following and when the Police and FBI "moved in" on it, Malcolm X decided to get into something less militant. Consequently, he formed the OAAU hoping to attract more followers and to get the Police and the FBI off his back. According to this source the MMI member stated that the OAAU was just a front for the MMI.

Source also advised that this MMI member further remarked that Malcolm X is currently in Africa contacting various African governments and representatives of various other governments in Africa, such as the Chinese Communists, in an effort to get money for the OAAU. This money will then pass through the OAAU to the MMI where it cannot be taxed since the MMI is a religious group.

Other sources familiar with MMI and OAAU activity were contacted during September and October, 1964, but they could furnish no information confirming the above information.

Malcolm X and the Red Chinese

CAIRO—Malcolm X, whom the Chinese Communists call the "chairman of the Afro-American unity organization," spent a considerable amount of his time in the presence of international Communist propagandists here.

Not only did he endorse the rioting back home, but he publicly called for retaliation against the white community. He said the time had come to meet "violence with violence; an eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth."

He prepared a series of inflammatory anti-U.S. documents here on the pretext of presenting them to the recent meeting of the Organization of African Unity, and it was reported across the world that he attended the conference. This is nonsense. He did not get near the parley. He was not accredited to it.

Malcolm X was not at any of the conference sessions. I was informed that it "is ridiculous" and "undignified" to think for a moment that anyone such as Malcolm X would be heard by the African counterpart of the Organization of American States.

Malcolm X's activity here was strictly a propaganda operation which he set up at the Hotel Semiramis, where some newsmen gathered. He made certain that his violent anti-U.S. diatribes were put in the hands of the Chinese Communist correspondents planted here by the New China News Agency.

★

But when Malcolm X wanted to be with his pro-Communist friends he came over to the Hotel Omar Khayam, a former palace. I vouch for this personally. I was there when he met Mrs. Shirley Graham DuBois, widow of the late Dr. W. E. DuBois, in the lobby. When the aged Dr. DuBois died recently, he was a member of the Communist Party, U.S.A., and had switched his citizenship to Ghana.

The Hotel Omar Khayam was also the headquarters of the violently anti-U.S., pro-Communist Ghanaian delegation to the African States' conference. On Thursday, July 18 Malcolm X and his frequent companion, Mrs. DuBois, met for hours in the garden restaurant of the hotel.

Mrs. DuBois and her late husband spent much time in Peking. They were frequent guests of Mao Tse-tung. Dr. DuBois delivered many anti-U.S. speeches which were broadcast across the world by the powerful Chinese mainland radio.

Mrs. DuBois has long been active in world Communist circles. Her background is important here to show the strange inter-weaving of characters now attempting to infiltrate and agitate the Negro communities of the U.S.

★

Mrs. DuBois knew the Castro brothers, Fidel and Raoul, in Mexico as far back as the late '40s. She now is associated with the pro-Communist "Freedomways," a publication allegedly devoted to the Negroes.

In the past few years she has been a prolific writer in defense of the pro-Communist dictatorial state of Ghana.

Intelligence agents of several countries now are eager to learn just how Black Nationalist leader Malcolm X made contact with such Communist activists as Mrs. DuBois. Of considerable interest is the source of Malcolm X's funds now that the Muslims under Elijah Muhammed have declared war on him.

Malcolm X has been making expensive and extensive trips across Africa. I ran into his trail in several cities—especially in Ibadan, Nigeria, where he delivered speeches so anti-U.S., so incendiary, that they could be printed only on asbestos.

It is also being noticed that the Chinese Communist broadcasts have been featuring him and his splinter sect. Why?

Malcolm X Warns Police Of Tactics, Says Harlem Negroes Are Armed

CAIRO, Egypt (NPI) — Black nationalist leader Malcolm X declared here last week that Negroes in New York's Harlem district are the best armed Negroes in the world, and warned that there could be a racial explosion unless the police change their tactics in dealing with them.

Malcolm X, attending the summit conference of African leaders here, advocated recently that Negroes, in the South in particular, arm themselves against attacks by racists.

Commenting on news of the Harlem riots, Malcolm X indirectly blamed the scare tactics, used by the police, on Commissioner Michael Murphy. He said:

"I am surprised that the trouble has been contained to the degree it has. Until two years ago, New York City used wiser methods than any other city to deal with

racial problems.

"But under police Commissioner Murphy, for some reason, tactics have changed. Now it is a case of outright scare tactics. This won't work because the Negro is not afraid. If the tactics are not changed, this could escalate into something very, very serious."

Alluding to Negroes being armed, Malcolm X said:

"There are probably more armed Negroes in Harlem than in any spot on earth. If the people who are armed got involved in this, you can bet they'll really have something on their hands."

After drawing a 90-day suspension for ridiculing the assassination of President John F. Kennedy, Malcolm X left the Black Muslim organization headed by "The Honorable" Elijah Muhammad a few months ago to found his own Muslim Mosque, Inc., group.

Civil rights leaders across the nation reacted coldly today to a plea to curtail mass demonstrations until after Election Day.

In Pittsburgh, Cleveland, Philadelphia and elsewhere, the broad sentiment was that whatever civil rights progress the Negroes have made has come through their relentless marches, sit-ins, mass picketings and other demonstrations, and that now is no time to stop.

In Cairo, the sharpest criticism of all came from Black Nationalist Leader Malcolm X, who snapped: "I'd die before I'd tell Negroes to restrain themselves."

He repeated the ancient Biblical demand, "an eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth, a life for a life!"

"Negroes should stand on their rights even if it costs them their lives," Malcolm declared. "But they should not die without taking a life."

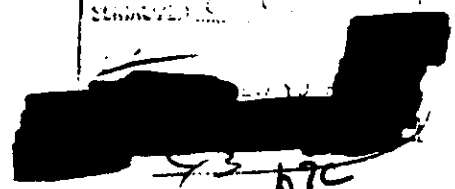

annual conference of the 34-nation Organization of African Unity, but is considering flying to New York and holding a mass rally of defiance here Saturday.

'SUMMIT' CALL

The call for a "bread curtailment, if not a total moratorium" of mass demonstrations until after Election Day went out from a "summit meeting" here yesterday of the nation's top civil rights leaders.

The meeting was urged by Roy Wilkins, executive secretary of the NAACP to meet the challenge of the Goldwater candidacy. It brought together Mr. Wilkins, the Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King Jr.; James Farmer, national director of the CORE; Whitne Young, executive director of the National Urban League; John Lewis, chairman of the Student Non-Violent Coordinating Committee, and A. Philip Randolph, chairman of the Negro American Labor Council.

Their statement, issued last night after a "summit meeting," said in part:

"We believe that racism has been injected into the campaign by the Goldwater forces."

Urging a shift in tactics, they called for the curtailment in mass remonstrations and more emphasis on getting more Negroes registered to vote.

WILKIN'S DISCLAIMERS

Mr. Wilkins took pains to make it clear that the "summit" statement should not be interpreted as an endorsement of President Johnson's candidacy.

He also said in answer to a question that the action had not been taken in order to reduce the so-called "white backlash," described as the resentment of whites reacting to mass demonstrations by Negroes.

A spot check by the Associated Press indicated that sev-

eral civil rights leaders on the local level intend to go ahead with demonstrations when they when they feel they are required to get results.

Jesse Gray, leader of the Harlem rent strikes, said: "we'll continue to have demonstrations in Harlem in spite of what Wilkins says."

Mr. Gray's Community Council on Housing is under court injunction forbidding further demonstrations.

OLD BIGOTRY

Stanley Branche, head of the Committee for Freedom Now in Chester Pa., near Philadelphia, said: "the only way we get this far is because of our demonstrations. Everyone's running scared of the white backlash. To me it's nothing but the same old dirty bigotry and dirty prejudice."

At a rally of 150 persons last night he called for pickets to march at a paper company today to urge more jobs for Negroes. He has also scheduled a street march tomorrow to protest alleged police brutality.

In the past, Mr. Branche has led several demonstrations in Chester, some of which resulted in violence.

James McCoy, executive board member of the Pittsburgh branch of the NAACP, said demonstrations would not be staged "unless a situation arises which would require direct action in the form of a demonstration."

LOCAL NEEDS

J. A. Babsby, president of the Pine Bluff Movement in Little Rock, Ark., an affiliate of SNCC, and CORE officials in Tulsa, Okla., said there might be demonstrations if negotiations in those cities break down.

Mr. Babsby said: "We will be guided on the local situation rather than by decisions reached on the national level."

A spokesman for the NAACP said a previously announced march and rally at the Demo-

cratic national convention next month in Atlantic City, N.J., will be held, but will not be "any kind of alienating demonstration."

Miss Ruth Turner, executive secretary of CORE's Cleveland chapter, said the "summit" statement "will not alter our plans" for what she called "a meeting" today on the city hall steps to protest alleged police brutality.

Mr. Farmer and Mr. Lewis, concurred in the statement, but withheld their signatures pending meetings of their steering committees next month.

AWAIT WORD

CORE officials in Omaha, Neb., St. Louis, Mo., and Columbus, Ohio, said they would await official word from headquarters.

The summit statement was issued after a two-hour conference at the NAACP headquarters, 20 W. 40th st.

Mr. Wilkins sent out a call for the meeting last Thursday, shortly after the rioting and looting in Harlem and in the Bedford-Stuyvesant section of Brooklyn.

Two days later rioting and looting broke out in Rochester.

The statement described the Republican national platform as a "states rights" platform authored by "the Goldwater forces."

b7c [redacted] said that she was upset about the fact that Secretary of State DEAN RUSK was going to have a conference with those "Uncle Tom" Negroes about Africa. She listed them as MARTIN LUTHER KING, [redacted] BAYARD RUSTIN, and stated that these people had not ever been in Africa. [redacted] said that the name of the conference was the American Negro Citizens Role in Pursuit of a More Effective US Policy in Africa. [redacted] said that RUSK would tell them what the line was and what they should say about Africa.

They said that there was no basis for the story concerning RUSTIN talking about the dynamite.

[redacted] contacted [redacted] and said that the girl from the Print Shop testified today at the hearing and everything went "okay". [redacted] added that a boy was held as a material witness and that he is now out on \$1,000 bail. [redacted] added that this individual cannot go back to South Carolina because of this and it is a real hardship on him. 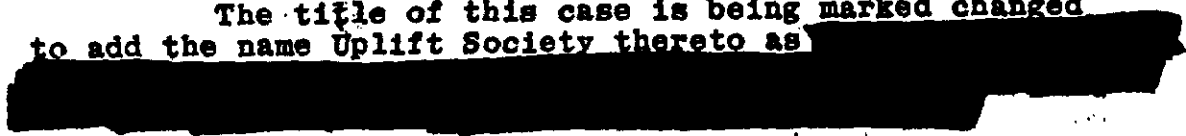
